



### SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 1<sup>ST</sup> WARD

#### FOR WEEK OF 3/06/2023

Reckless Discharge of a Firearm — 3/08/2023 3400 block of Harlem Ave. — 11:04a.m.

Officers responded to the 3400 block of Harlem for a report of a man with a gun. The reporting party/witness related that he observed a Male Black subject (wearing flannel and a grey jacket), standing in the rear of the building. Said subject was observed brandishing a rifle and fired several shots in the air. Upon arrival, officers surrounded the building, made entry and cleared the building with negative results on locating an offender. A canvass of the building revealed 4 (four) spent casings in the alley next to a dumpster where the offender was observed by the witness. This investigation is ongoing.





### SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 2<sup>ND</sup> WARD

#### FOR WEEK OF 3/06/2023

### Accident- Hit & Run/DUI/Possession of a Controlled Substance Ridgeland/37<sup>th</sup> Street — 3/06/2023 — 2:30a.m.

Officers responded to the area of Ridgeland/37<sup>th</sup> Street in regards to a Black colored SUV dragging something under the vehicle. Officers located the vehicle in the area with heavy right front-end damage and conducted a traffic stop. Officers observed, in plain sight inside the vehicle, 4 (four) grams of Cocaine and 1 (one) bottle of open alcohol. The driver and passenger were taken into custody and transported to the Berwyn Police Department. A canvas of the area revealed two parked vehicles that were struck by the offending vehicle (3400 block of Highland and 3700 block of Elmwood). The driver was subsequently charged with 1 (one) felony DUI and 1 (one) felony count of Possession of a Controlled Substance. Case closed by arrest.





### SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 3<sup>RD</sup> WARD

### Stolen Motor Vehicle (Kia) (Juvenile) — 3/07/2023 6900 block of 29<sup>th</sup> Place — 3:58p.m.

Officers responded to the 6900 block of 29th Place for a report of a stolen vehicle (Kia). Upon arrival, officers spoke with the owner/victim who related that she parked her vehicle in the driveway at approximately 3:40p.m. that same day and upon returning to the driveway approximately 18 minutes later she discovered the vehicle was missing. Officers conducted a check of the area for the vehicle but were met with negative results.

The vehicle was entered into LEADS as stolen. Approximately 4 minutes later, officers received notification via FLOCK that the stolen vehicle was traveling near the area of 23<sup>rd</sup>/Home Ave entering Cermak Plaza. Officers immediately conducted a search for the vehicle and located the vehicle at North Riverside Mall. Additional units converged to said location and a traffic stop was initiated. The stolen vehicle was occupied by one sole occupant who was the driver. The vehicle fled from the traffic stop and a short pursuit ensued. The stolen vehicle was involved in a traffic crash at the 1700 block of 1<sup>st</sup> Ave. (Maywood) where the driver then fled on foot. Following a foot pursuit the offender was taken into custody.

The owner of the vehicle gave officers consent to search the vehicle. A search of the vehicle revealed a bolt cutter, screw driver, USB cable, and a face mask in the trunk which the owner related was not theirs. The offender was identified as a Juvenile and transported to Loyola Hospital as a precaution. Case closed by arrest.


Stolen Motor Vehicle (Kia) — 3/07/2023 1200 block of Harvey — 11:21a.m.

The victim presented at the BPD front desk to report his vehicle (Kia) stolen. The vehicle was located by an outside agency on 3/09/2023. This investigation is ongoing.

Officers responded to the 1200 block of Harvey for a report of a stolen auto. Upon arrival, officers met with the victim/owner who advised that he just observed 2 (two) subjects steal his vehicle (not a Hijacking) and then fled Eastbound Roosevelt from Harvey. The victim further related that he had an Apple Air Tag inside the vehicle and was able to track it to Chicago. Chicago Police Department 8<sup>th</sup> District was notified. A short time later, CPD called and advised that they recovered the vehicle unoccupied. CPD contacted the vehicle owner to claim their vehicle.






### SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 6<sup>TH</sup> WARD

### Stolen Motor Vehicle — 3/06/2023 2100 block of Kenilworth — 8:31p.m.

Officers responded to a call of a stolen vehicle (Hyundai) on the 1800 block of Scoville. Upon arrival, officers met with the owner/victim who stated his vehicle was stolen from his driveway. Officers located broken glass on the ground from the passenger side door window. The vehicle was entered into LEADS as stolen. This investigation is ongoing.

### Possession of a Controlled Substance — 3/07/2023 7100 block of Cermak — 1:15p.m.

Berwyn Police Officers conducted a proactive traffic stop on a vehicle with fraudulent registration. The officers made contact with the vehicle, which had 4 (four) occupants, and advised the driver (male subject) the reason for the stop. The driver was subsequently taken into custody. A search of the vehicle revealed a plastic bag with 0.6 grams of Cocaine, several bottles of Promethazine Hydrochloride, fraudulent Driver's License and vehicle registration, and 1 (one) handgun. One of the passengers claimed ownership of the handgun and was confirmed to have a valid CCL. The driver was transported to the Berwyn Police Department and charged with 1 (one) felony count for Possession of a Fraudulent Identification Card, 1 (one) felony count for Use of Unauthorized Registration Plates, and 2(two) felony counts for Possession of a Controlled Substance. Case closed by arrest.

### Attempted Motor Vehicle Theft (Kia) — 3/09/2023 1500 block of Kenilworth — 3:24a.m.

The reporting party/victim called Berwyn Police to report that she just found an unknown male subject inside her vehicle (Kia) which was parked in front of her address. The victim related that she approached her vehicle at which time the subject (wearing a red hoodie) exited the vehicle and ran towards a small black in color sedan parked nearby waiting. The offending vehicle left the area in an unknown direction. Upon arrival, responding officers observed the rear window of the victim's vehicle was shattered and entry was made. This investigation is ongoing.





### SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 7<sup>TH</sup> WARD

### Brawl/Aggravated Battery — 3/10/2023 Five Guys (7150 W. Cermak) — 4:14p.m.

Officers responded to the rear parking lot of the Five Guys and Chipotle restaurants for a large physical disturbance. Upon arrival, officers did not locate any active disturbance at that time. Officers learned that a female juvenile subject was sprayed in the face by an OC spray like substance during the disturbance. BFD was summoned to the scene for medical evaluation of the juvenile. Witnesses reported the father of another involved female juvenile as the offender who sprayed the OC spray. This investigation is ongoing.

### Aggravated Battery of a Police Officer — 3/11/2023 1600 block of Clinton — 1:19a.m.

Officers responded to the 1600 block of Clinton for a report of a domestic-related fight outside involving two male subjects. Upon arrival, officers made contact with the two subjects fighting in front of that location. While officers were attempting to separate the two subjects, one of the males punched an officer in the chest and then proceeded to push the officer multiple times. Additional officers arrived on scene for assistance. Both subjects were taken into custody and transported to the Berwyn Police Department for processing. "Subject 1" was charged with Domestic Battery. "Subject 2" was charged with 1 (one) felony count of Aggravated Battery of a Police Officer. Case closed by arrest.

### Criminal Damage to Property/Unlawful Use of a Weapon/Theft of Service El Nuevo Vallarta (6801 W. Cermak) — 3/12/2023 — 8:36p.m.

Officers responded to El Nuevo Vallarta for a report of customers refusing to pay their bill. While in route, dispatch advised that a White Male subject and Black Female subject were fighting with security inside the establishment. The male subject fled from the location prior to the arrival of police but the female subject remained on scene. Responding Officers located the male subject in the parking lot and detained the subject. Security confirmed the male subject as the offender and he was subsequently taken into custody. While fighting with security, the male subject broke a glass entry door. (Management estimated the value of the damage to be \$1,000+) Officers identified the female subject and placed her in custody for investigation.

It was learned that one of the security guards utilized a Conducted Energy Device during the incident. Said security guard did not have a FOID and was taken into custody.

Further investigation revealed that the female subject did not have any involvement with the fight or the criminal damage; she was issued a LO citation for Theft and released from the station. The security guard was charged with 1 (one) misdemeanor count of Unlawful Use of a Weapon. The male subject was charged with 1 (one) felony count of Criminal Damage to Property and 1(one) misdemeanor count of Battery. Case closed by arrest.


Strong Armed Robbery — 3/06/2023 1800 block of Scoville — 2:18p.m.
