



## Armed Robbery — 1/17/2024 Walgreens (6800 W. Ogden Ave.) – 7:32p.m.

Officers responded to Walgreens (6800 W. Ogden Ave.) for a report of an Armed Robbery in progress at the store. Upon arrival, responding officers learned that the robbery crew was being surveilled by the NORTAF (Northern Regional Major Crimes) Task Force and all three (3) offenders were taken into custody by the Task Force members. The offenders were turned over to Berwyn Detectives for further investigation. One (1) subject was released without charges and two (2) offenders were subsequently charged accordingly. Case closed by arrest.

## Disturbance — 1/21/2024 Junior's Bar (7011 W. Ogden Ave.) – 2:35a.m.

While patrolling the area, officers were flagged down by patrons of Junior's Bar who advised there was a fight inside the bar. Upon entering the bar, the responding officers observed two (2) female subjects verbally arguing and one of the subjects pushed the other. The aggressor was subsequently escorted outside the bar by Junior's Security. The other female subject immediately left the scene. Officers remained on scene while Junior's staff cleared the bar and closed early for the night. A check for any additional victims was met with negative results.

# Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon — 1/20/2024 35<sup>th</sup> Street/Oak Park Ave. – 4:10p.m.

Officers conducted a traffic stop at 35<sup>th</sup> Street/Oak Park Ave. Upon making contact with the driver, the officer could smell cannabis emanating from the vehicle. Officers also observed, in plain view, a rolled up "joint" containing green plant-like substance on top of a cup. The officer asked the driver to step outside the vehicle and a subsequent search of the vehicle was conducted which revealed a loaded firearm in the rear pocket of the passenger seat and a small box containing multiple pills. The driver was taken into custody and transported to the Berwyn Police Department where he was subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon. Case closed by arrest.
