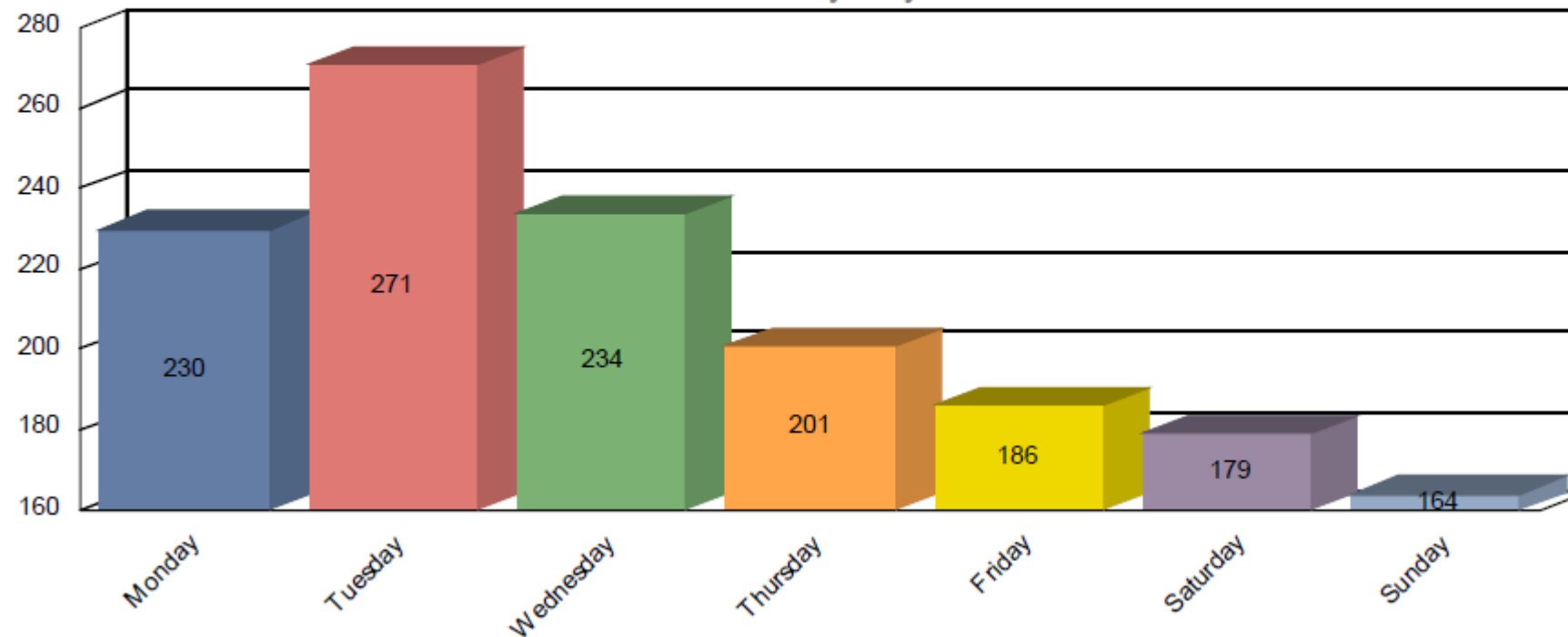

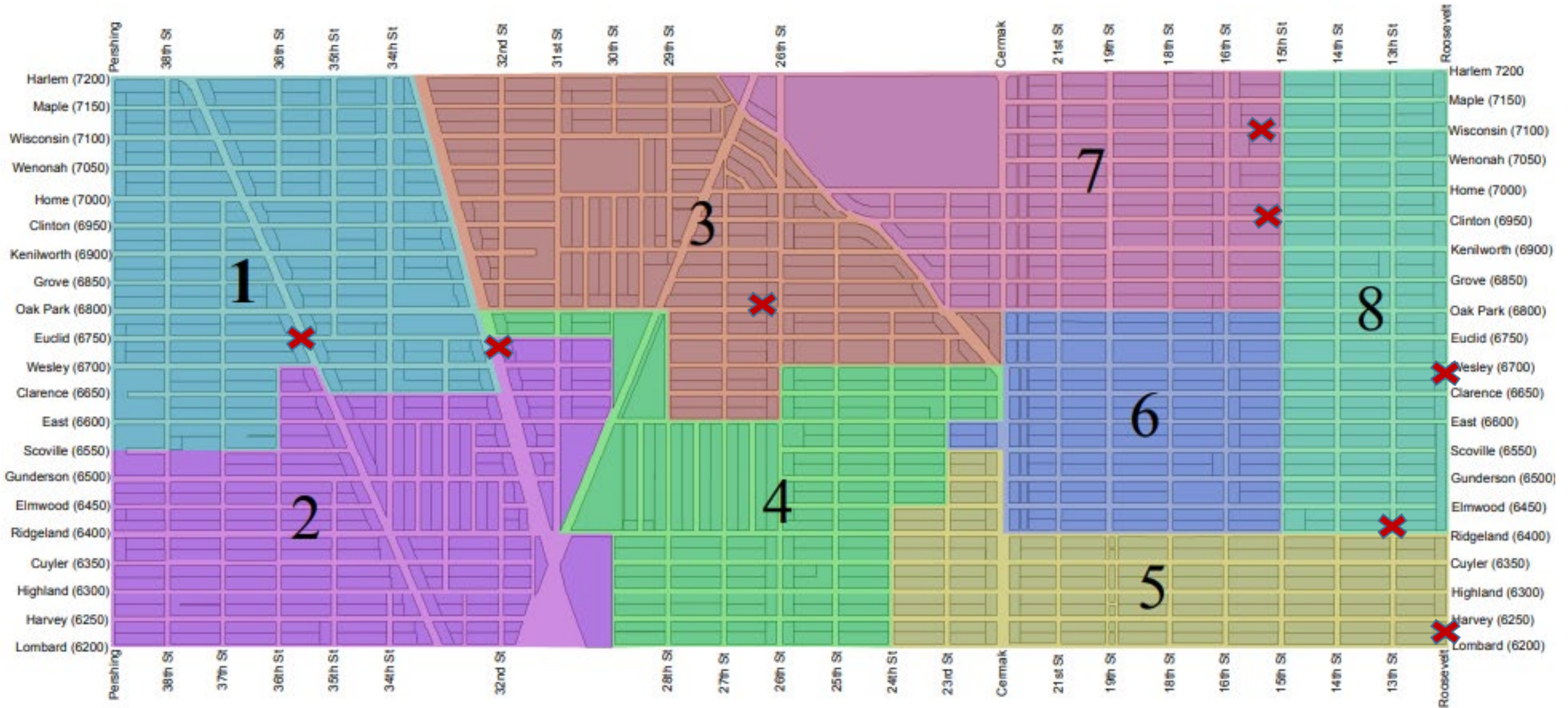

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 1ST WARD

FOR WEEK OF 10/16/2023

Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon (Class X Felony) — 10/17/2023 Euclid Ave./Ogden Ave. — 6:20p.m.

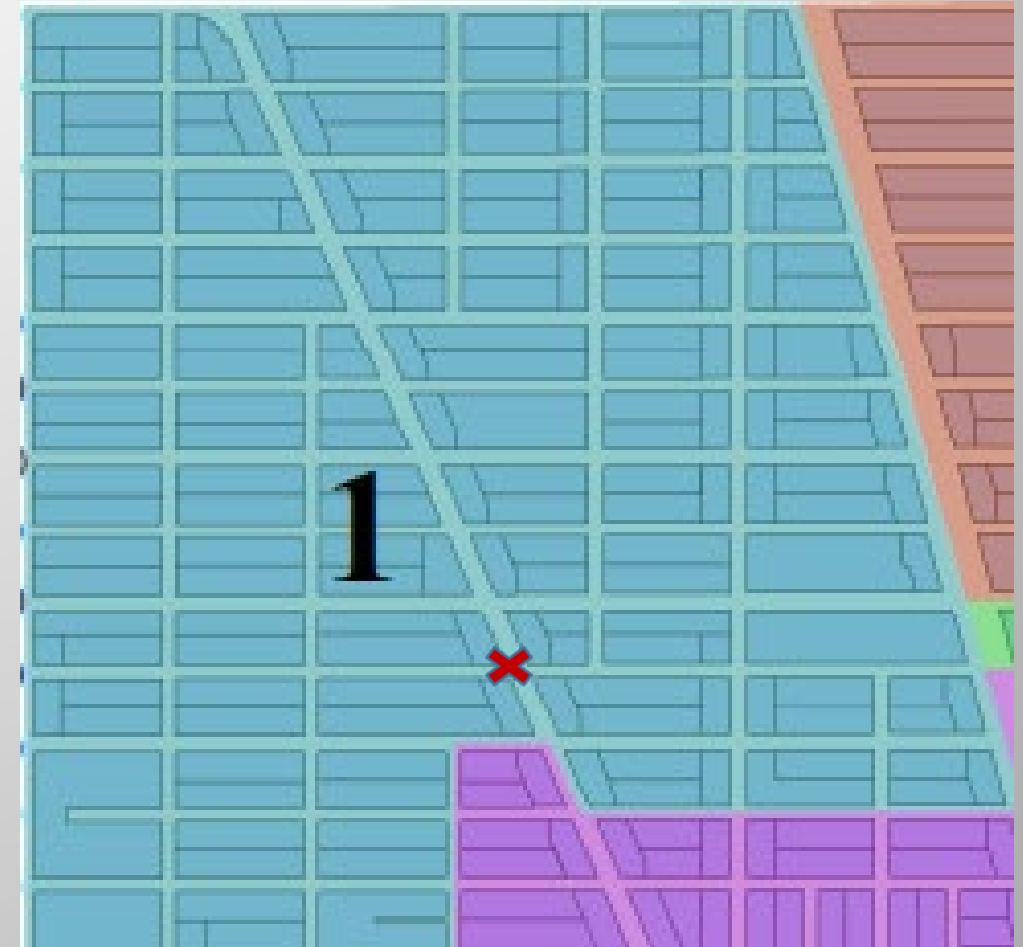
While patrolling the area, officers attempted to conduct a traffic stop at Euclid Ave/37th Street, however, the offending vehicle continued to travel at a high rate of speed before ultimately coming to a stop at Ogden Avenue. Responding officers made contact with the occupants of the vehicle and could smell a strong odor of fresh cannabis emanating from the inside of the vehicle. The front passenger (Passenger #1) was asked to step outside and complied. At this time, the rear passenger (Passenger #2) began moving around the backseat of the vehicle and disobeyed verbal commands to stop moving and lunged from the backseat into the front seat. Said subject exited the vehicle with a firearm in his hand and attempted to flee on foot but was immediately captured by officers and placed into custody. Said subject threw the firearm which was recovered by officers approximately 20 feet away from where the subject was placed into custody. A search of the vehicle was conducted which revealed a backpack in the rear passenger compartment which contained two (2) bags of a green leafy substance, suspect Cannabis approximately totaling 240g, one (1) small plastic bag containing a white chunky substance, suspect Cocaine totaling 4.6g, and a digital scale. All three (3) subjects were transported to the Berwyn Police Department for processing. Upon further investigation it was learned that Passenger #2 is currently on Electronic Monitoring. The driver was subsequently issued traffic citations and released. Passenger #1 was charged with one (1) count Class A Misdemeanor Resisting/Obstructing a Peace Officer. Passenger #2 was charged with the following:

- One (1) count Class X Felony Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon – Possession of a Machine Gun
- One (1) count Class 4 Felony Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon-Possession of a firearm
- One (1) count Class 4 Felony Aggravated Resisting
- One (1) count Class 1 Felony Possession of a Controlled Substance (Cocaine) with Intent to Manufacture/Deliver
- One (1) count Class 4 Felony Possession of a Controlled Substance (Cocaine)
- One (1) count Class 3 Felony Possession of Cannabis with Intent to Manufacture/Deliver
- One (1) count Class 4 Felony Possession of Cannabis
- One (1) count Class A Misdemeanor Unlawful Use of a Weapon – Possession of an Un-serialized firearm

Case closed by arrest.

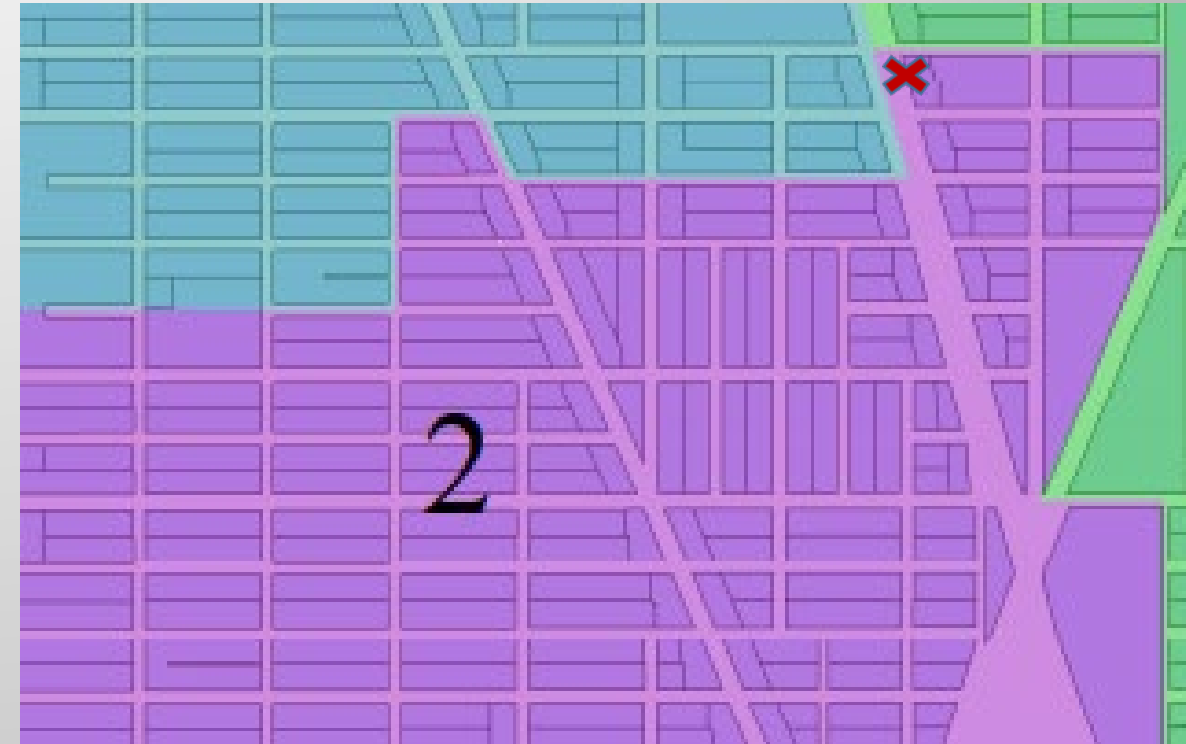

Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon (Juvenile) — 10/22/2023 6700 block of Stanley — 1:56a.m.

Berwyn Police Officer conducted a traffic stop on the 6700 block of Stanley. Upon making contact with the driver, the officer learned that the driver was a male juvenile that did not possess a valid Driver's License. The vehicle was also occupied by one (1) female juvenile in the front passenger seat. While speaking with the driver, the officer observed open alcohol in plain sight inside of the vehicle. A search of the vehicle further revealed a loaded handgun. Both juveniles were transported to the Berwyn Police Department. The female juvenile was released to a legal guardian/parent. The male juvenile was placed into custody and subsequently charged with Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon (Person Under 21). Case closed by arrest.

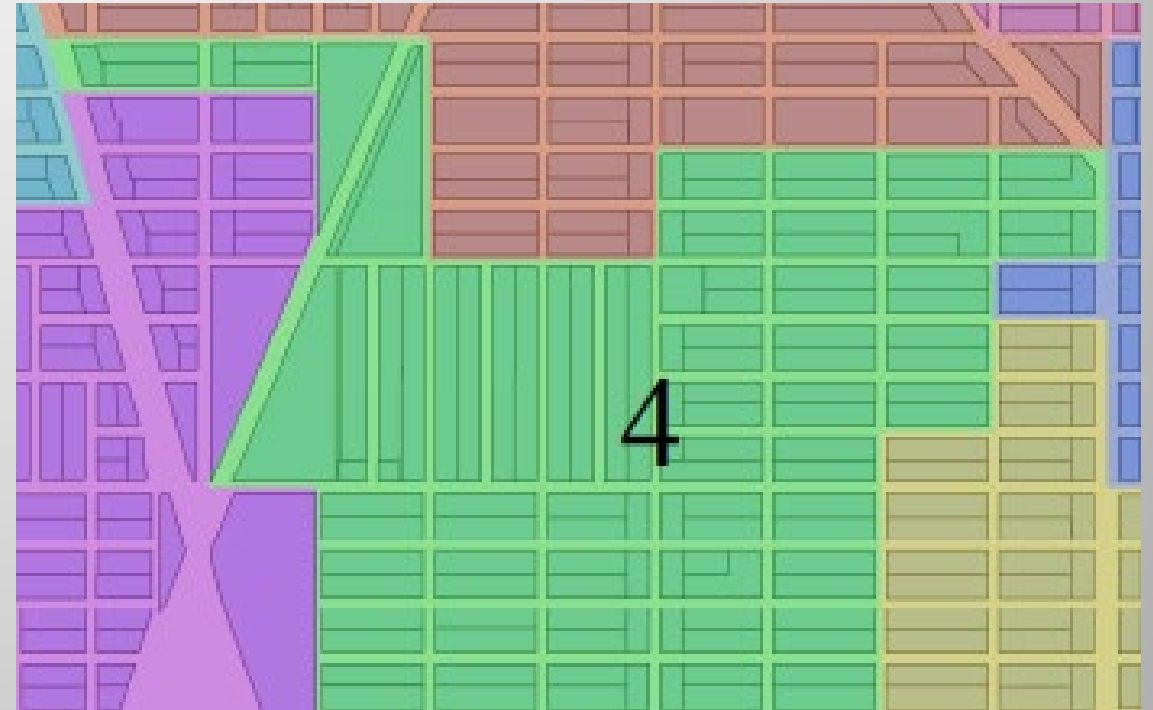

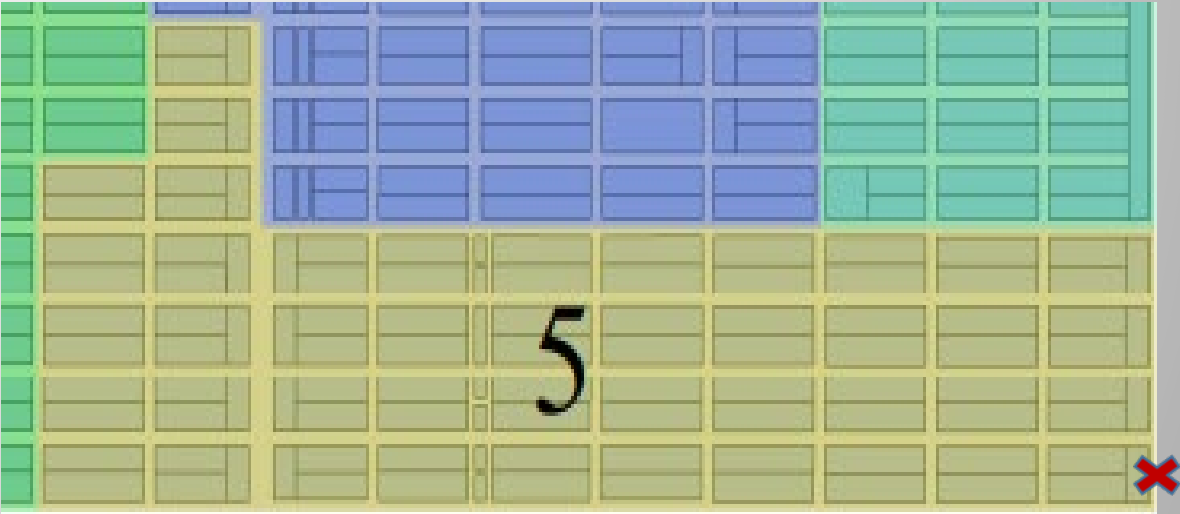

Armed Robbery — 10/22/2023
6200 block of Roosevelt — 4:06a.m.

While officers were on scene for an Armed Robbery incident on the 6600 block of Roosevelt, Berwyn Dispatch received another call of an Armed Robbery that had just occurred on the 6200 block of Roosevelt. The victim advised Berwyn Dispatch that he and his friends had just been robbed at gunpoint by three (3) Male Black subjects. Responding officers met with the victims who related the three (3) Male Black subjects exited a black in color SUV, displayed firearms, and demanded the victims' property. The offenders were last seen traveling Westbound on Roosevelt Road. The victims provided officers with a license plate information that matched the offending vehicle involved in the Armed Robbery incident on the 6600 block of Roosevelt. It was later learned that a vehicle, matching the same description as the offending vehicle involved in both Armed Robbery incidents in Berwyn on this date, was also involved in incidents in Cicero and Oak Park that same day. This investigation is ongoing.

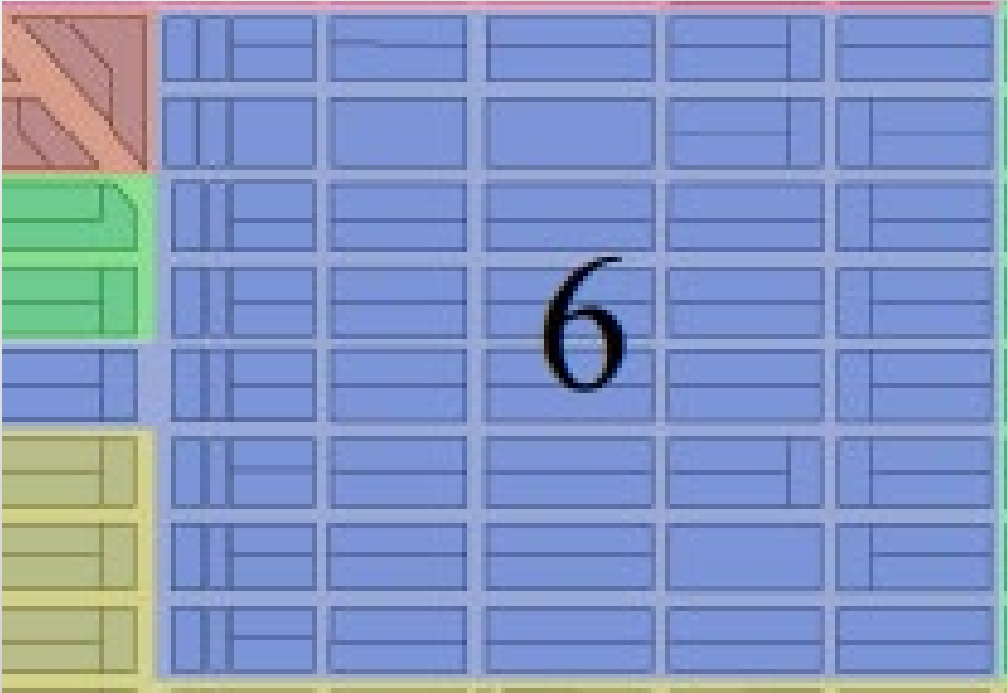

Stolen Auto — 10/17/2023

1500 block of Wisconsin Ave. — 11:02a.m.

The victim reported her vehicle stolen from the 1500 block of Wisconsin Ave. The victim related that she parked her vehicle the previous night and when she returned today the vehicle was missing. Officers observed broken glass on the ground in the space with the victim related her vehicle was previously parked. The vehicle was entered into LEADS as stolen. This investigation is ongoing.

Stolen Auto/Fleeing & Alluding — 10/21/2023

1500 block of Clinton Ave. — 4:28a.m.

Units responded to the 1500 block of Clinton Ave. for a call of at least two (2) subjects standing next to a vehicle with guns. Upon arrival, responding officers observed a black in color sedan (no license plates) and a white in color sedan flee Southbound on Clinton and then Eastbound on 16th Street. Officers ultimately terminated the pursuit of said vehicles around Roosevelt Rd. where both vehicles continued Northbound into Oak Park. Upon returning to the scene, officers learned that the white in color sedan was just stolen. Officers observed broken glass on the street where the vehicle was parked. Said vehicle was entered into LEADS as stolen. This investigation is ongoing.

Robbery/Attempted Unlawful Vehicular Invasion — 10/16/2023 13th Street/Ridgeland Ave. — 9:33p.m.

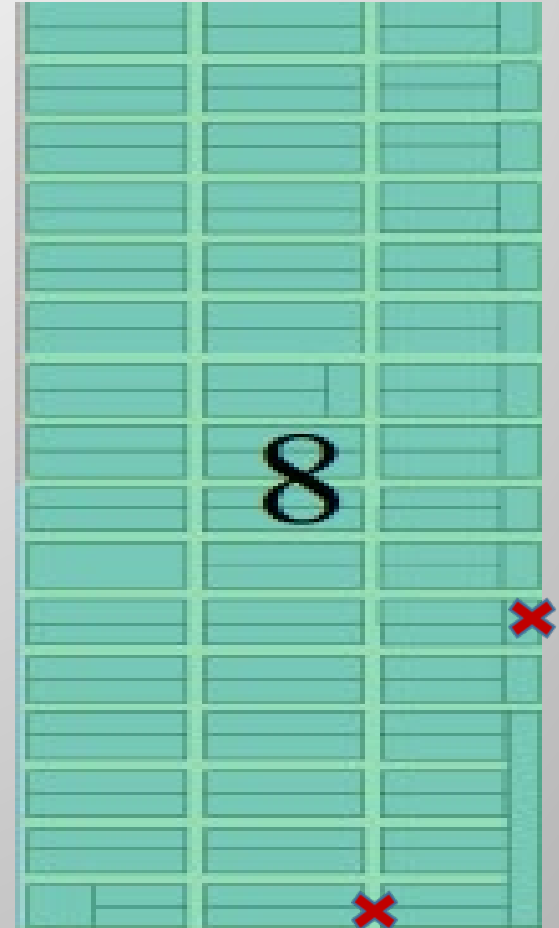
Officers responded to call of an attempted vehicular hijacking that had just occurred in the area of 13th Street/Ridgeland Ave. Upon arrival, officers met with the female victim who related she was an Uber Driver and was making a food delivery. The victim further related that she exited the vehicle and upon making contact with the customer he took her car keys out of her hand and attempted to enter her vehicle. The victim described the offender as a Male Black subject wearing a black coat with a fur hood, all black clothing, and skinny build. The offender then fled the scene on foot. Responding officers canvassed the area and located a male subject matching the given description on the 6300 block of Roosevelt Rd. Following a short foot pursuit, officers placed the subject in custody. The offender was subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Robbery and one (1) felony count of Attempted Unlawful Vehicular Invasion. Case closed by arrest.

Armed Robbery — 10/22/2023 DiNico's Pizza Parking Lot (6627 W. Roosevelt) — 4:06a.m.

Units responded to the report of an armed robbery in the parking lot of DiNico's Pizza. Upon arrival, officers learned that three (3) Male Black subjects exited a black in color SUV with guns and approached a couple sitting in a car in the lot and attempted to open the door. As this was happening, an employee of Dinico's exited the restaurant. The male subjects turned their attention towards her as she attempted to run away. The offenders then pointed their guns in the face of the employee and demanded her property. The boyfriend of the female victim (employee) witnessed the incident and drove his vehicle into the front driver's side of the offenders' vehicle which subsequently disabled it. The three (3) offenders fled on foot Southbound on Clarence from Roosevelt. Berwyn Police towed the offending vehicle to the Berwyn Police Department pending a search warrant and further investigation. This investigation is ongoing.

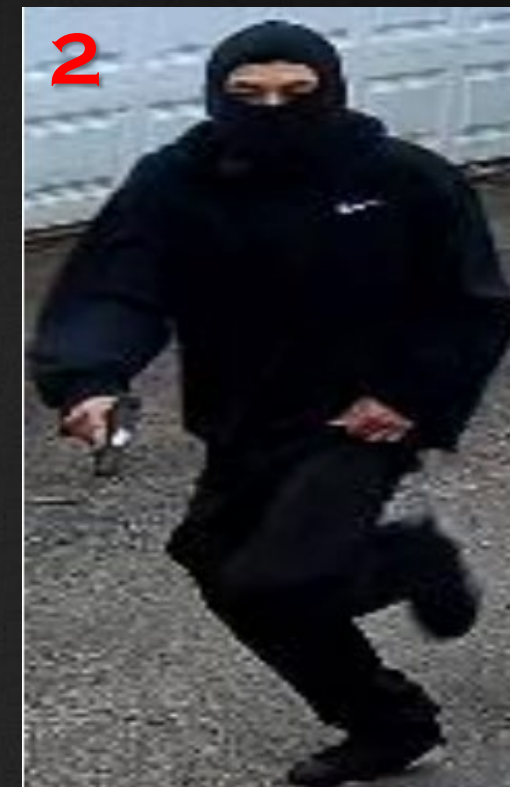

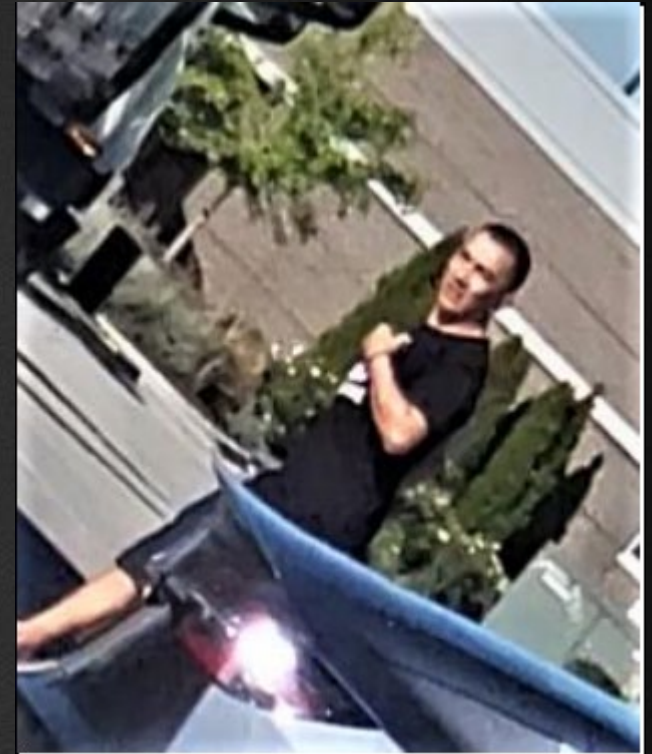
