





SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 2ND WARD

FOR WEEK OF 11/27/2023

Aggravated Use of a Weapon- Firearm — 11/28/2023 Ogden Ave/East Ave — 2:24p.m.

Officers attempted to curb a vehicle for a traffic stop, however, said vehicle failed to stop and continued to travel Eastbound on Ogden Ave. The offending vehicle ultimately came to a stop at 28th Street/Austin (Cicero). Upon making contact with the driver, officers learned that the male subject did not possess a valid driver's license. A search of the vehicle revealed a firearm next to the driver's seat. The male subject did not possess a valid FOID or CCL. The subject was subsequently taken into custody without incident and transported to the Berwyn Police Department where he was charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Use of a Weapon-Firearm and one (1) felony count of Aggravated Driving While License Revoked. Case closed by arrest.






SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 3RD WARD

Criminal Damage to Property (Attempted Auto Theft) — 12/03/2023 6900 block of Stanley Ave. — 2:03a.m.


SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 5TH WARD

Armed Robbery — 11/30/2023 Minute Man Gas Station (1546 S. Lombard Ave.) — 9:03p.m.

Officers responded to a report of an Armed Robbery at the Minute Man Gas Station. Responding officers learned that a Male Black subject wearing a Black in color hoodie, surgical mask, and green gloves, entered the gas station and approached the two (2) clerks while implying he had a handgun in his waistband. The unknown offender left with approximately \$4,000 and fled on foot Northbound in the 1500 block of Harvey/Lombard alley. Officers canvassed the area for the offenders and were met with negative results. This investigation is ongoing.






SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 6TH WARD

Battery/Disturbance — 12/02/2023 La Aduana (6736 W. Cermak) — 3:05p.m.

Officers responded to La Aduana in reference to a disturbance in the rear of the business. Upon arrival, officers observed an intoxicated female subject batter the owner of the business, who wished to sign a criminal complaint. Said female subject was taken into custody without incident. During the time of this incident, an unruly, intoxicated male subject was escorted out of the bar by staff and advised not to return. Said male subject refused to leave at which time he was taken into custody without incident. Both subjects were subsequently charged accordingly. Case closed by arrest.





SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 7TH WARD

Battery/Disturbance — 11/27/2023 16th Street/Oak Park Ave. — 12:33a.m.

Berwyn dispatch received numerous calls of a group of males fighting outside in the area of 16th Street/Oak Park Ave. Upon arrival, officers met with a male victim on scene who was uncooperative. The victim left the scene on foot. Pursuant to investigation, officers learned that the fight stemmed from an argument that occurred amongst patrons of Striker Lanes. The offenders left the scene prior to police arrival.

Aggravated Battery — 11/27/2023 2100 block of Oak Park Ave. — 1:04a.m.

Berwyn dispatch received a call of a disturbance amongst tenants where a threat was made with a gun. Responding officers met with the victim who related that a physical altercation ensued in the hallway outside of the victim's apartment during which the offender also threatened the victim with a gun. The victim sustained several injuries from the fight and was transported to MacNeal Hospital for treatment. Officers located the offender outside of his apartment and took him into custody without incident. The victims signed complaint refusals and the male subject was subsequently released without charges. Case closed.

Armed Robbery/Retail Theft — 11/27/2023 Ma Smoke Shop (2140 S. Oak Park Ave.) — 1:04a.m.

Officers responded to Ma Smoke Shop after an employee recognized a subject standing near the store, who she identified as the same subject from an armed robbery that occurred on 12/01/23. Upon arrival, officers observed said male subject flee on a bicycle Northbound on the 2100 Block of the Oak Park Ave/Euclid alley. The fleeing subject was apprehended and taken into custody without incident. The subject was positively identified on scene by the smoke shop employee and it was later learned that the offender was also in possession of proceeds from a Retail Theft, that had just occurred from Old Navy (Cermak Plaza). The offender was subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Robbery and one (1) misdemeanor count of Retail Theft. Case closed by arrest.






