

Burglary to Garage/Aggravated Assault — 12/12/2023 3500 block of Euclid – 3:46a.m.

Berwyn Dispatch received several calls of a suspicious vehicle in the alley of the 3500 block of Wesley Ave. Reporting parties related to dispatch that they observed multiple unknown subjects enter a garage. The offending vehicle fled prior to officer arrival. Responding officers met with a female homeowner who stated while leaving for work, her husband observed unknown subjects removing items from their garage. The male victim yelled out at which time a Male White subject pointed a handgun in his direction. The victim then ran into his house and advised his wife to call the police. There were no reported injuries. The victim's reported tools and other miscellaneous items missing from the garage. This investigation is ongoing.


Shots Fired — 12/16/2023 3400 block of Highland – 3:00a.m.


SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 3RD WARD

Aggravated Battery — 12/16/2023 Tipsy's Tap (6802 W. 26th Street) – 2:17a.m.

It was learned that the victim was involved in a verbal altercation inside the bar and upon exiting the bar a male subject struck him in the face. The victim then fell to the ground and hit his head. BFD arrived on scene and transported the victim to Mac Neal Hospital for treatment. The offender left the scene prior to officer arrival. This investigation is ongoing.

Catalytic Converter Theft — 12/13/2023 2400 block of Elmwood – 7:07a.m.

Officer responded to the 2400 block of Elmwood for a report of a Catalytic Converter theft. The caller related that a black in color sedan double parked next to a silver in color VW GTI and two (2) unknown Male Black subjects wearing all black clothing and face coverings, utilizing a car jack and reciprocating saw, removed the Catalytic Converter of the VW. The offenders fled in an unknown direction prior to officer arrival. This investigation is ongoing.

Criminal Damage to Property/Attempted Auto Theft (Juveniles) 2500 block of Highland — 12/14/2023 – 9:10p.m.

Officers responded to the 2500 block of Highland for a report of four (4) male juvenile subjects attempting to break into a vehicle. Responding officers made contact with the victim who related a neighbor alerted her to the damage that was just done to her vehicle. Officers observed the driver's side window was broken on the victim's vehicle (Kia). During the time of this call, officers received reports of four (4) male subjects (matching the same description) on the 2700 block of Cuyler entering yards and possibly attempting to enter a garage. Officers located all four (4) juveniles and placed them into custody without incident. Said subjects were positively identified by witnesses and subsequently charged accordingly. Case closed by arrest.






SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 7TH WARD


