Violation Order of Protection (x7)/Possession of a Firearm with Defaced Serial #/Aggravated Use of Weapon-Firearm 6600 block of 31st Street — 12/20/2023 – 10:10a.m.

Officers traveled to Chicago to conduct surveillance for an offender in reference to multiple violations of an order of protection. Officers located and conducted an investigative stop on a vehicle registered to the offender. Upon making contact with the driver, officers confirmed it was in fact the offender they were searching for. Officers placed said subject in custody without incident. Officers also observed a clear knotted plastic baggie containing a white powder-like substance (suspect cocaine) in plain-view inside of the vehicle as well as a handgun wedged between the driver's seat and center console facing barrel up within plain-view. The offender was transported to the Berwyn Police Department and subsequently charged accordingly. Case closed by arrest.






#### SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 3<sup>RD</sup> WARD

#### Criminal Trespass to Vehicle — 12/18/2023 1600 block of East Ave – 4:12a.m.

Units responded to the report of two (2) unknown subjects that were observed making entry into a white in color work van parked on the 1600 block of East Ave. The caller further advised that the two (2) subjects ran from the scene prior to police arrival. Responding officers conducted a check of the area which revealed one (1) Male Black subject observed under an SUV parked inside of a nearby yard. Said subject then fled Northbound on foot hopping several fences. The subject was last seen running Eastbound on 18th Street from the Scoville/East Ave. alley. Additional checks for the subject were met with negative results. Said subject was described as a Male Black, 5'10" and approximately 150lbs. wearing an all black track suit. Officers made contact with the vehicle owner who related that his van sustained damage to the door but no items were missing. This investigation is ongoing.

### Criminal Damage to Property — 12/23/2023 6700 block of Vacin Fairway – 11:31p.m.

Officers responded to the 6700 block of the Vacin Fairway in regards to a report of several parked vehicles with the tires slashed. Officers met with two (2) of the vehicle owners who advised that their cars were parked around 7:00p.m. on 12/22/2023 and they found the tires slashed when they returned. Two (2) reports were documented on three (3) involved vehicles. Officers observed two (2) additional damaged vehicles but were unable to locate the owners. This investigation is ongoing.


