





Suspicious Persons — 2/07/2024 3700 block of Harvey – 12:43a.m.

Units responded to the 3700 block of Harvey for an unknown male subject observed on residential surveillance camera attempting to open the front door. Upon arrival, responding officers observed the offender being detained by the homeowner outside of the residence. It was ascertained that the subject was at the wrong house on that block. The male subject was subsequently transported to Mac Neal Hospital for an evaluation. The homeowner did not wish to sign a complaint.

Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer (x5)/Aggravated Resisting Police Officer — 2/10/2024 Ridgeland Ave/Ogden Ave – 2:07a.m.

Officers conducted a traffic stop at Ridgeland Ave/OgdenAve. Upon making contact with the driver, officers observed open alcoholic beverage containers in plain view inside the vehicle. It was determined that the driver had a revoked driver's license and the passenger had an active warrant. The driver was placed in custody without incident. The passenger, however, resisted arrest and became physical with the officers. The passenger bit an officer, kicked multiple officers, and kicked the door of the squad car several times. Both subjects were transported to the Berwyn Police Department and subsequently charged accordingly. Case closed by arrest.


Attempted Stolen Auto — 2/09/2024 1600 block of Highland – 2:41a.m.




