





Stolen Auto — 2/19/2024 Jack's Rental (6642 W. 26th Street) – 9:17a.m.

Officer's responded to Jack's Rental for a report of a rental vehicle that was stolen overnight. Responding officers met with a staff member of Jack's Rental who shared surveillance video with the officers. While reviewing the video, officers learned that at approximately 1:44a.m. two (2) subjects broke into the Penske key drop box and took one of the Penske rental vehicles. (Note: A second set of keys was also taken from the drop box however, the vehicle was not taken.) The vehicle was entered into LEADS as stolen. This investigation is ongoing.

Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer (Juvenile) — 2/20/2024 26th Street/Home Ave. – 3:26p.m.

Officers received information of a possible gang related fight to occur after Morton West High School was dismissed for the day. Officers observed a group of male juveniles loitering near the corners of 26th Street/Home Ave. Officers made contact with the group and instructed the juveniles to disperse at which time the juveniles announced their gang affiliation and shouted obscenities at the officer. In an attempt to detain the juveniles, one (1) of the subjects pushed one (1) of the officers. Said juvenile was taken into custody without further incident and transported to the Berwyn Police Department where he was subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer. Case closed by arrest.

Disturbance — 2/23/2024 Parking Lot (2550 S. Oak Park Ave.) – 1:03a.m.

While patrolling the area, an officer observed numerous subjects yelling at each other in the parking lot of 2550 S. Oak Park Ave. and requested additional units to the scene for assistance. Two (2) female subjects engaged in a physical altercation. Responding officers separated the two (2) subjects and cleared the scene. None of the subjects on scene were cooperative.


Reckless Discharge of a Firearm — 2/25/2024 30th Place/Kenilworth Ave. – 6:02a.m.

Fight/Brawl — 2/25/2024 Tipsy's Tap (6802 W. 26th Street) – 6:58p.m.

Officers responded to Tipsy's Tap for a report of a large group (approximately 30 people) fighting inside the bar. Upon arrival, officers learned that the fight inside of the bar had ended and numerous groups of people had left the bar in various directions. This investigation is ongoing.




Catalytic Converter Theft — 2/19/2024 1500 block of Scoville Ave. — 9:05a.m.

Officers responded to the 1500 block of Scoville for a report of a stolen Catalytic Converter. Responding officers made contact with the victim who related they parked their vehicle overnight and when they returned this morning they discovered the Catalytic Converter was missing from their vehicle. This investigation is ongoing.

Theft — 2/19/2024 Bank of America (6400 W. Cermak Rd.0 – 9:48a.m.

Officers responded to Bank of America for a report of theft. Responding officers met with the female victim who stated on 2/17/2024 she was at Bank of America attempting to make a withdrawal from an ATM when she discovered something was obstructing the card slot. The victim further related that an unknown Male Hispanic subject appeared and offered to help her. Said subject took possession of her card and showed her the scan feature on the ATM machine and asked the victim for her pin number. The victim completed her withdrawal and the male subject returned a card to her. The victim further related that a few days later she noticed withdrawals from her bank account that she did not authorize. The victim then realized that the subject who assisted her at the ATM did not return her bank card, instead, he gave her a different card. The offender is described as Male Hispanic, 5'6"-5'8,' medium build, wearing a mask. The victim reported approximately \$200 withdrawn (without her consent) from her account. This investigation is ongoing.






SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 6TH WARD

Armed Robbery — 2/21/2024 2100 block of Oak Park Ave. – 10:20p.m.

Officers responded to a report of a male subject who had been pepper sprayed on the 2100 block of Oak Park Ave. Responding officers made contact with the victim who related he had been pepper sprayed by an unknown Female Black subject who also took his blue in color canvas bag. The victim further related that he also felt a few sharp pains to his back. Officers met with a witness who identified the offender as a resident in a nearby apartment building and related that the offender pepper sprayed and shot the victim with a pellet gun. The victim later became uncooperative with the investigation and indicated he no longer wished to sign a complaint and the case was subsequently closed.


