

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 2ND WARD

FOR WEEK OF 7/05/2021

Shots Fired (Assist Other Agency Report) 07/07/2021 — 33rd Street and Lombard

Multiple calls of shots fired in the 3300 block of Lombard Avenue. Multiple vehicles were shooting at each other and one male subject was shot in the right leg on the Cicero side of Lombard Avenue while entering his vehicle, which was parked in Cicero. Shell casings were located along the driver's side of the vehicle as well as the front passenger side. Witnesses stated that there were three vehicles involved. While on scene, Cicero units were involved in a foot chase, several units joined the foot pursuit and the subject was taken into custody on the 3300 block of Harvey Avenue. Berwyn Central Dispatch contacted local hospitals and located the gunshot victim at Loyola Hospital. Detectives responded to gather additional information. After reviewing the facts, it was determined to be a Cicero case and the Cicero Police Department is currently conducting the investigation.

Multiple Vehicle Accident/Hit and Run — 07/08/2021 3200 block of Ridgeland

Berwyn received a call of a hit and run accident where 3 parked vehicles were struck. The caller reported that the subject's vehicle was last seen East bound on Ogden. Shortly after the accident was reported a vehicle matching the same description was located at Ridgeland & Park with heavy front end damage and unable to drive. Driver of the vehicle was arrested and charged with Aggravated Driving While License is Revoked.

Shots Fired/Man with a Gun/Barricade Subject 07/08/2021 — Cermak & Highland

Berwyn Units responded to Cermak & Highland in regards to a call of shots fired/man with a gun. Upon arrival Berwyn units spoke with the 4 victims who related that subject was standing at Highland/Cermak facing South and fired 3 shots at the victims. The victims described the subject as a Male/Hispanic, wearing a white shirt & baseball cap, and had numerous tattoos. The victims further related that they believed he may have entered an apartment building on the 2100 block of Highland. A canvass of the area revealed two spent shell casings near and around the entrance of that same apartment building.

Additional units arrived on scene and began an interior search of the building. While additional units were conducting an interior search, exterior officers heard a gunshot that appeared to be coming from overhead. Interior units also heard a gunshot and then observed a male subject, matching the description provided by the victims, open the door of an apartment and quickly shut it. The subject did this several times. Interior units took up a position in the hallway.

Exterior units observed a male, matching the description provided by the victims, look out a second floor window. Exterior officers then took up a perimeter and observed a black in color handgun on the exterior of the window sill. An ILEAS (Illinois Law Enforcement Alarm System) called out was made along with NIPAS (Northern Illinois Police Alarm System) team and an interior and a secondary perimeter was established. After numerous attempts of contacting the subject in the apartment, first by Berwyn officers then by NIPAS team, the subject exited and was taken into custody by NIPAS without incident.


Battery to Police Officer-Use of Force/Criminal Trespass/Battery 07/05/2021 — 15th Street and Elmwood

Officers responded to the 1500 block of Elmwood for a call of a disturbance. Officers arrived on scene and discovered that the offenders entered the backyard and started to fight with residents in the backyard. The residents of the property do not know the two male subjects. The subjects approached both officers making threats of physical violence along with physical posturing as if they were going to attack the officers. "Subject A" shortly after pushed one of the officers in an attempt for him and the other subject to get past the officers to continue to try and fight the residents of the property. One of the officers then deployed his Oleoresin Capsicum (OC) spray on the offenders to halt their physical aggression and take them into custody. "Subject A" was then taken into custody without further incident while "Subject B" fled the scene but was captured and taken into custody shortly after.

Berwyn Fire Department was called to the scene and conducted a wash out of the eyes of both offenders as well as the officers. Both subjects went to MacNeal Hospital for further washing out. Shortly after they were released from the hospital and transported back to the Berwyn Police Department without incident.

Vehicular Hijacking — 07/08/2021 **6400 block of 18th Street**


Victim is a delivery driver who was making a delivery to the 6400 block of 18th street when he was approached by 2 male subjects. The offenders asked victim for money and his car keys. At which time one of the offenders struck victim on the side of his face with his fist and entered his vehicle. Said offender then fled Northbound on Gunderson in victim's vehicle. Second offender fled on foot Southbound on Elmwood. Victim's phone and wallet were inside of vehicle. Victim attempted to locate his phone through find my I-Phone which was unsuccessful. ISPERN (Illinois State Police Emergency Radio Network) flash message was broadcasted.

Offenders are described as 2 male blacks, mid 20's, wearing dark clothing and face masks. One offender had an Adidas logo on his face mask.

Berwyn Dispatch later received communication from Illinois State Police District Chicago that the victim's vehicle was located abandoned East bound I-290 at Independence Blvd.

Unlawful Discharge of a Firearm — 7/05/2021 1800 block of Clinton

Units responded to a report of a found projectile/bullet in the side gangway. The scene was photographed and the projectile was recovered. No casings or additional projectiles were found in the area. No other damage was noted in the immediate area.

The Assigned Units canvased the area and documented residential addresses that contained surveillance cameras / doorbells.

Red dried bloody animal paw-prints were found on the sidewalk area leading North about half a block. It is unknown at this time if said paw prints are associated with the projectile.
