

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 1ST WARD

FOR WEEK OF 7/19/2021

Armed Robbery — 07/19/2021 — 6838 Windsor

Officers responded to 6838 Windsor, JC Stacks Bar, for a call of an armed robbery. The victim told responding officers he closed up for the evening and took garbage out to the dumpsters in the rear of the business. When the victim got to the rear entrance a male voice called out to him and when he turned around he saw a male subject in a black mask and wearing a black hoodie pointing a gun at him. The offender told him to go into the basement where he made the victim take off his shirt, pants, and shoes and also made the victim give him his wallet, phone, and Rolex watch. The offender then demanded that the victim open the safe in the basement where the offender took \$7,000 USC and a 10 karat bracelet.

The offender then made the victim go into the cooler in the basement and locked him in there. The victim escaped by kicking dry wall out and crawling out of the hole. Officers did observe the dry wall that the victim stated he kicked out (away from the cooler) actually in the cooler. The victim then observed the surveillance system receiver box missing from his desk, his clothes he took off were missing, and the wire cable outside of the business (in the rear) that handles the surveillance system was cut.

The victim could not provide a further description on the offender or if any other person/vehicle was involved. T-Mobile would not ping the victim's phone. An evidence technician processed the scene with negative results. Cameras were noted in the surrounding area. A search of the dumpsters in the nearby alleys for anything of evidentiary value was met with negative results.

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 1ST WARD

FOR WEEK OF 7/19/2021

Disorderly Conduct/Criminal Trespass to Property 07/20/2021 — 3249 S. Oak Park Ave.

Officers responded to a call for a male subject causing a disturbance on the 2nd floor (Maternity Ward) of Mac Neal Hospital (3249 S Oak Park Ave). Upon arrival, units observed a male Hispanic (identified as the subject in question) walking southbound from Mac Neal ambulance parking area, followed by Mac Neal Security personnel. Mac Neal Hospital's Head Security Officer related that they wished to sign complaints for assault and criminal trespass. Officers attempted to communicate with the subject, who continued to yell, was observed to be sweating profusely, and crying. Subject was uncooperative and continually refused to stop and talk directly with the police officers. The subject continued to walk away from officers, while yelling at them, ending up on the 3400 block of Euclid Ave. Additional units were requested to contain the subject who continued exhibiting unpredictable violent behavior.

Police officers were successful in surrounding the subject, who eventually gave up and put his hands behind his back for cuffing without the need for any use of force to gain compliance over the subject. Subject was placed into a squad car for transport, at which time he began slamming his head against the divider in the squad. Subject was transported to the Mac Neal Emergency Room, due to him trying to harm himself and stated violent behavior that may be attributed to unknown controlled substance(s). Assigned Supervisors advised BPD Dispatch to alert the Mac Neal Emergency Room of the above. Assigned police officers provided a watch over the subject, pending hospital treatment.

The offender was found to have an extensive criminal history. Upon the offender's discharge from the Mac Neal Emergency Room, he was transported to the Berwyn Police Department for charges. The offender was processed and charged with one count Disorderly Conduct and one Count of Criminal Trespass to Property.

Disturbance — 07/23/2021 — 3117 Oak Park Ave.

Units responded to a report of a large fight/argument involving 40-50 people outside of Heritage Funeral Home (3117 Oak Park Ave.). Upon arrival, officers observed a large attendance of gang members. There was no active fight, however, it was learned that there was an argument between some of the family/friends. Officers learned that the unwanted people dispersed and the family/business continued with their services and visitation. No security hired for the event. The patrons eventually departed around 9:30p.m. from the parking lot. Officers confirmed that the funeral services were being held for a documented gang member.

Strong Arm Robbery — 07/22/2021 — Cermak/Lombard


A delayed, third party report was received of a robbery that occurred between 2:00p.m.-3:00p.m. in the area of Cermak/Lombard. The family member of the victim described the offender as a male Hispanic with light complexion wearing a white T-shirt and black hat. The caller stated that the offender was riding a bicycle when they rode passed the victim and ripped a chain off of their neck. No injury was reported by the complainant.

Armed Robbery — 07/22/2021 — Cermak/Highland

A couple leaving Canton 8 (6312 Cermak Rd) entered their vehicle which was parked in the diagonal spots next to the World's Largest Laundromat when they were approached by 2 male subjects. The victims described the subjects as Hispanic, wearing masks and dark colored clothing. The victims related that both offenders displayed handguns demanding everything from both the male and female victims. The offenders took the victims I-phones, money, debit and credit cards, bracelets from both, and the male victim's FOID card. The offenders then demanded the male open the trunk at which time they took the male victim's 10 MM Kimber handgun in its case and a case of 9mm ammo. The victims drove to 16th and Lombard where they waived down a Community Service Officer who called it in. The male victim claimed he had a FOID, however, LEADS showed no record. No I.D. was made due to the offenders wearing masks. Berwyn Dispatch advised that Cicero PD had a similar robbery that it happened around the same time at 23rd/Laramie with what they described as 2 male Hispanic offenders driving a grey colored vehicle.



Units responded to a rollover accident in the 2300 block of Ridgeland. Vehicle was traveling north bound on Ridgeland when it struck a parked vehicle causing the offending vehicle to rollover on its roof. The second parked vehicle was pushed into two additional vehicles. The driver and passenger were transported to Mac Neal Hospital for precautionary evaluations. Then driver was charged with DUI and Driving While Revoked.



Aggravated Assault with a Firearm — 07/20/2021 1800 block of Oak Park Ave.

Officers responded to the 1800 block of Oak Park Avenue where our victim stated that a black male pulled a handgun out on him. The victim stated he observed a black male (approximately 35-40 years of age) with dreadlocks, wearing a red hat and shorts and a black female were drinking outside of a royal blue Impala in front of a residents on the 1800 block of Oak Park Avenue. The victim then observed the male and female walk down his gangway into his backyard. The victim went outside and then saw the male and female subjects having intercourse in his backyard and he told them to leave. The offenders went back down the gangway towards the Impala and the victim followed. When the victim got to the front he saw the male reaching into the Impala. The male offender then displayed a handgun and told the victim to get back inside or he would kill him. The victim told responding officers that the male did not directly point the handgun at him. The male offender then got into the Impala and went southbound on Oak Park and then west on Cermak. The female offender then ran east across Oak Park where the victim was unsure if she went into an apartment building or down a gangway. Cameras were noted in the area.

Damage to City Property — 07/22/2021 Cermak/Maple Ave

Units were dispatched for an accident in which an unknown driver, who fled the scene, of a silver Chevy Silverado took out a light pole in the median of Cermak at Maple which ended up blocking the westbound lanes. The light pole has the Maple Ave sign attached. The vehicle was towed and impounded.
