

# SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 1<sup>ST</sup> WARD

FOR WEEK OF 10/11/2021

## **Battery (x2) — 10/11/2021 — 5:34 p.m. MacNeal Hospital (3249 Oak Park Ave)**

Units responded to a call of a large group (10-20 people) fighting in front of MacNeal Hospital. Upon arrival, officers discovered that MacNeal Security had one male and one female subject in custody. MacNeal security related that the subjects had just been released from the ER and were causing a disturbance to the other patients and their families. Berwyn Police Officers advised that the two subjects move away from the other patients waiting in the ER and they became aggressive. The male subject pushed the Berwyn Police Officer and was taken into custody peacefully. Immediately after, the female subject approached a Berwyn Police Officer and pushed them. She was also taken into custody peacefully.



## **Aggravated Battery — 10/12/2021 — 7:08 p.m. The Garage (3202 S. Grove Ave)**

Units responded to the front of The Garage (3202 S Grove Avenue) for a battery victim who was now on the ground unconscious. Upon arrival, officers learned that the victim had been in the bar approximately an hour prior to the incident and left. A male subject with a mask was hanging around the outdoor seating area and was asked by staff if they could help him at which time the victim walked past the front of the business. The subject with the mask walked directly to the victim and punched him in the face, knocking him out. The subject then fled from the scene in a grey vehicle. Initial assessment of the victim by paramedics indicated possible serious head injury. At the hospital the victim became belligerent and uncooperative with detectives.

# SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 4<sup>TH</sup> WARD

## **Attempted Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking — 10/12/2021 Dunkin Donuts (6601 Cermak Rd.) — 11:18p.m.**

Berwyn Police Officers were dispatched to Dunkin Donuts (6601 W. Cermak Road) for an Attempted Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking. Upon arrival, officers learned that the victim was parked in the parking lot adjacent to the drive-thru. The victim related that she observed a silver SUV occupied by two male black subjects at the drive-thru window which proceeded to park in the alley directly behind Dunkin Donuts. The victim stated that one of the subjects exited the SUV and approached her as she was seated in her vehicle. The subject pointed a black handgun at her and demanded her vehicle. The victim related that she immediately reversed her vehicle out of the parking lot and was able to safely escape onto the street.

## **Shots Fired — 10/17/2021 27<sup>th</sup> Street/ Harvey — 12:15p.m.**

Berwyn dispatch received a call of shots fired near the 2600 block of Highland/Harvey. Upon arrival, the caller shared video surveillance from their home with Berwyn Police. Upon viewing the video, officers observed a red and white conversion van with a ladder on the back. The video also shows the van traveling westbound and stop on 27<sup>th</sup> street near the mouth of the Highland/Harvey alley. The offender exited the van faced westbound and fired several shots. A canvass of the area recovered (4) 22 caliber spent shell casings near and around the mouth of 27<sup>th</sup> and Highland/Harvey alley. No property damage or victim were located. A check of the surrounding hospitals for possible victim was met with negative results.



## Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking — 10/12/2021 — 11:32p.m. Berwyn Pumping Station (19<sup>th</sup> Street/Harvey)

Berwyn Police Officers were dispatched to World's Largest Laundromat (6246 W. Cermak Rd) for a report of an Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking. The victim related that while attempting to enter his job at the Berwyn Pumping Station (19<sup>th</sup> Street/Harvey) a male black subject ran up and pointed a handgun at his head. The offender demanded the victim hand over his belongings and to empty his pockets. The offender took the victim's belongings and his vehicle and then both vehicles fled southbound on Harvey Ave. Berwyn Police related the information regarding the victim's stolen vehicle over ISPERN (Illinois State Police Emergency Radio Network). Berwyn Police, while participating in a carjacking mission investigation with other agencies including Chicago and the State Police, were able to successfully track and locate the victim's vehicle in the area of LaSalle/Huron in Chicago. Responding officers located the victim's vehicle, and recovered it, apprehended a suspect who was in possession of a loaded firearm, and recovered proceeds belonging to the victim.



## **Criminal Trespass to Motor Vehicle — 10/15/2021** **19<sup>th</sup> Street/Wisconsin — 10:52 p.m.**

Units responded to a call of a subject pulling on car door handles in the area of 19<sup>th</sup> Street/ Wisconsin Ave. The reporting witness described the subject as a Male Hispanic in his late 20's, thin build, 5'6"-5'7", with short dark hair wearing a blue shirt and blue pants. Responding units spoke to the witness and it was determined that two vehicles were entered. Contact was made with the vehicle owners and nothing appeared missing from the vehicles. A check of the area for the subject was met with negative results.

## **Attempted Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking — 10/16/2021** **Tony's Grocery Store (7111 W. Cermak Rd) — 1:06p.m.**

Units responded to a call of an attempted auto theft in the parking lot of Tony's Grocery store at Cermak Plaza. Upon arrival, police officers met with the victim who related that two male black subjects approached him at his vehicle, pointed a gun at him and told him to give them the keys to the car. The victim further related that he told the male subjects that the keys were in the vehicle and he exited the driver side door. The victim stated that after telling the offenders that the key was in the vehicle he then ran away north through the lot and away from the offenders but that he still had the key FOB to the vehicle in his pocket as he ran. The victim related that he ran for a bit towards other patrons and when he turned back around, the two male subjects were gone but his vehicle was still there. The victim described both offenders as male blacks, 5'10", approximately 16-18 years old, wearing black hooded sweatshirts and blue surgical masks. The offenders fled eastbound through the parking lot in a silver colored sedan.

# SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 7<sup>TH</sup> WARD

## **Attempted Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking — 10/16/2021 Cermak Rd/Kenilworth — 1:13p.m.**

Units responded to a call of an attempted auto theft at Cermak/Kenilworth. Upon arrival, police officers met with the victims who related that they had just entered the vehicle when two male black subjects approached their vehicle. The victim related that one of the offenders grasped the driver side door where the victim was sitting before the driver side door was able to close. The victim stated that the offender pointed a black in color handgun in her face and stated "get out". The victims exited the vehicle and ran into the south Cermak alley and called the police. The victim related she observed the offenders then get out of her vehicle and into the offending vehicle that was parked facing northbound in the 2200 block of Kenilworth, next to hers. The victim related she then observed the offending vehicle travel northbound on the 2100 block of Kenilworth. The description of the offenders and their vehicle matched that of the incident that occurred just minutes before at Cermak Plaza.
