



Shots Fired — 1/24/2022 Cermak/Scoville (area) — 4:07 a.m.

Berwyn dispatch received 3 separate calls of shots fired from 2200 block of Scoville, 2300 block of Elmwood and 2300 block of Scoville. Berwyn units checked in and around said areas which were met with negative results for locating any spent shell casing or damage.

Impersonation of a Police Officer Investigation — 1/26/2022 2200 block Ridgeland — 7:55 p.m.


Berwyn Police initially received a walk-in complaint in regards to a police officer. However, after speaking to the complainant, it was determined that the person alleging to be a police officer did not work for our department. The victim related that at approximately 7:30p.m. they received a knock at the door from a male black subject with a silver star hanging around his neck. The subject asked for the homeowner by name and proceeded to tell him he had to go to the police department but would not explain why. The victim became concerned and did not cooperate, eventually closing the door on the subject as the subject tried to hold it open.

The subject continued to knock stating that the victim was "obstructing the law" but the victim refused to open the door again. At 7:55 p.m. the subject contacted the victim's wife via cell phone advising her husband to open the door. The victims did not open the door and related that they were also unsure of how his wife's number was obtained.

The wife stated that she observed a black 4-door sedan with tinted windows parked and running by a fire hydrant near their residence.

The victims described the subject as a male black, approximately 5'9, medium to heavy build. Subject appeared to have facial hair underneath his blue face mask and had short black hair. He appeared to be in his mid-30's wearing a black coat, black t-shirt and jeans with no identifying markings. They further related the silver star that the subject wore around his neck appeared to be faded. The victims related they have no current legal issues with anyone and are unsure of why they were approached.



Disturbance/Shot Fired — 1/28/2022 6200 block Cermak — 4:56 a.m.

Berwyn Police received a call of one shot fired from a concerned citizen. Upon arrival, units observed three subjects outside on the 6200 block of Cermak. Two of the subjects, upon observing BPD, went into the building and locked the door. The remaining subject was bleeding from the head and EMS was requested to the scene. The male subject stated that he got involved in a family fight and was struck in the head by an unknown subject with an unknown object causing the injury to his head. The male subject stated that there was no gun shots inside the apartment. All attempts to make contact with any subjects within the building were met with negative results. Berwyn central located a contact number for the building landlord and attempted contact but were only able to leave a voicemail. The injured subject was transported to Mac Neal Hospital for further treatment of his head wound. Units spoke with the subject again at the hospital who advised that he did not want any police assistance; he became uncooperative and would not offer any further information.

Contact was made with the female caller who wished to remain anonymous who stated that she heard what she thought was a gunshot however she did not know what a gunshot sounded like. While on scene animal control was summoned for a loose pit bull. While waiting for animal control to arrive on scene a male subject was observed exiting said address and a street stop was conducted. The male subject was identified and stated that there was a gang party going on in the apartment. The male subject was uncooperative and stated that he was not a snitch but he would admit to 1 ½ gun shots. He stated that when he heard the shots he left the scene.



Shots Fired/Aggravated Unlawful Discharge of Firearm 1/29/2022 1600 block Ridgeland — 3:11 a.m.

Resident of 1600 Ridgeland Ave called reporting an unknown object just came through her window and into the wall. Upon arrival the victim allowed officers into the residence and directed them to a bedroom located on the north side of the residence along 16th street where she was sleeping in the bed when an unknown object came through the window and into the bedroom wall. Upon further inspection, a bedroom window on the North side of the residence was found to have damage consistent with being struck by a projectile which went through the upper left portion of the window, mini blinds/curtain, and into the bedroom wall.

The security guard for Berwyn Tap Room stated that he was in the doorway of the business when he heard 3 shots which sounded like they came from the West of the business near Ridgeland Ave, however, he did not see anybody from his location. 3 spent casings were located in the intersection of the Northbound lane of Ridgeland Ave at 16th street. Canvas of the area for any additional property damage was conducted but with negative results. All subjects in the residence were accounted for and no injuries reported.

Residential Burglary — 1/24/2022 1500 block East Avenue — 1:00a.m.


Victim reported his apartment burglarized by two unknown offenders. The victim described the offenders as follows: Offender 1: male subject wearing a blue in color hoody and a black in color mask, heavy build. Offender 2: male subject, thin build, black 'Champion' hoody, black face mask. The victim related that the offenders made entry through a window. The victim was not at home during the incident but related that they observed this burglary through their security system. Officers spoke with the victim's relative on scene. It is unknown what items, if any were taken. Officers observed 131 grams of Cannabis that was subsequently recovered. Both the victim and his relative denied ownership.

Aggravated Vehicular Hijacking — 1/27/2022 1600 block Euclid Avenue — 3:57 a.m.

Dispatch received a call from a male victim stating that his vehicle had been taken by 2 male black subjects, 1 displaying a hand gun. The offenders exited a white SUV occupied by 3 other females and approached the victim. The vehicles were last seen Northbound Euclid. ISPERN message was sent out.

A short time later Berwyn Central received a call from the brother of the victim who stated that he located the vehicle in Cicero and called the Cicero PD. The vehicle was towed to the Berwyn Police Department for processing.

Reckless Discharge of a Firearm — 1/29/2022 1800 block Euclid — 3:30p.m.


Units were dispatched in reference to a tenant observing a bullet hole in her floor, in which the bullet struck her television, ricocheted off the ceiling before landing on the floor. The spent projectile was photographed and recovered. Contact was made with the first floor apartment and upon making contact, officers observed a bullet hole in the ceiling. The tenants denied knowledge of what occurred and allowed access to the bedroom to retrieve and inspect a 9mm handgun; the handgun was recovered. No one was taken into custody based on the facts known at this time and the totality of circumstances; it is unknown at this time who fired the gun and if this was the gun that was used.

Strong Arm Robbery — 1/29/2022 1500 block Ridgeland — 7:00p.m.

Victim was selling an i-Pad via Facebook Marketplace. The victim found a buyer and arranged for the sale to occur in front of the victim's home. The buyer, a female black subject, came as a passenger in a silver sedan driven by a male black subject, with a child in the rear seat of the vehicle. The victim met the female offender at the passenger side of the car. The female offender turned over money to the victim which she immediately knew to be counterfeit. When confronted, the female passenger grabbed the counterfeit money and the i-Pad. The vehicle drove off as the victim and her mother attempted to hold onto the i-Pad. The victim eventually lost her grip and was run over by the rear tire of the vehicle. The i-Pad was wiped clean by the victim prior to the sale so it could not be tracked. The victim related she was experiencing leg pain and swelling.

Victim was transported to MacNeal Hospital for treatment. The offenders' silver sedan was last seen travelling Southbound down Ridgeland. Investigation to continue.





SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 7TH WARD

Retail Theft/Aggravated Resisting Arrest — 1/26/2022 Walgreens (7113 W. Cermak) — 10:28 a.m.

While patrolling near Walgreens, an unidentified reporting party, pulled up next to the officer and reported that she just observed a retail theft take place. She stated that she observed a Male White offender, wearing a dark jacket, black hat, walk out of Walgreens with a basket containing a large amount of merchandise without paying for it. The offender was last observed walking Northbound near the bank located at 7100 Cermak Rd.

The responding officer provided the information to Berwyn central, and began checking the area for any obvious offender. A short time later, the officer observed a male subject crouching behind some garbage cans in the 2100 block of Wenonah alley. The officer observed the male subject to be in possession of a Walgreens roller basket, and a box containing merchandise. The subject was in the process of transferring some of the merchandise to a black backpack. The officer exited the marked squad to conduct an investigative stop. The subject began to walk in the opposite direction, and the officer gave him a lawful order to stop, but he did not comply. The subject began to flee but was successfully apprehended by the officer and advised that he was under arrest. Additional units arrived on scene to assist as the subject was resisting arrest.

Once the subject was taken into custody, a custodial search was conducted and he was found to be in possession of numerous boxes of unopened medication / merchandise, drug paraphernalia, cellular telephones, and tools that are consistent with burglary tools.






