

Retail Theft /Stolen Auto — 9/27/2022

Walgreens (6800 W. Ogden Ave.) — 5:55a.m.

Police officers responded to Walgreens (6800 W. Ogden Ave) for a theft of beer. The caller advised that the offenders were two Male Hispanics who fled Southbound on Oak Park Ave. in an Orange colored vehicle. The vehicle came back stolen out of Chicago. This investigation is ongoing.

Luring of a Minor — 9/28/2022

6900 block of 30th Place — 4:37p.m.

Officers responded to the 6900 block of 30th Place for a call of a male subject luring a child. Upon arrival, the caller stated her 12 year old step-daughter was walking when an unknown White Male subject driving a Black colored SUV pulled up next to the juvenile and asked her if she wanted to sit in the car with him. The said male subject flashed money towards the juvenile in an attempt to entice her to enter the SUV. The victim described the male subject as skinny build, brown hair with little hints of gray, full beard, and wearing black glasses. The juvenile did not enter the SUV and the male subject did not exit the SUV in an attempt to grab the juvenile. Incident turned over to Youth Investigations.

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 4TH WARD

FOR WEEK OF 9/26/2022

Battery — 9/29/2022

YMCA (2947 S. Oak Park Ave.) — 11:09a.m.

Officers were dispatched to the YMCA in regards to a male subject who made inappropriate advances on a female subject. Upon arrival of officers, the female victim related that the male subject initiated a conversation with her and then proceeded to make unwanted physical contact with her. The victim advised she wished to pursue criminal charges against the offender. The offender was taken into custody and subsequently charged with Battery. Case closed by arrest.

Aggravated Battery with a Firearm — 10/01/2022

V Bar (2717 Ridgeland) — 2:59a.m.

Police Officers responded to V Bar for a male subject inside who had suffered a gunshot injury. Upon arrival, officers met with the victim who related that he had been shot in the leg while walking to his car after exiting V Bar. The victim further related that he heard a male voice, coming from a red colored vehicle near the intersection of Ridgeland/27th Street, shout at him followed by 4-5 gunshots, and then ultimately fled the scene. The victim was subsequently transported to Mac Neal Hospital for non-life threatening injuries.

A canvass of the area revealed one spent round which was recovered from inside a parked vehicle on Ridgeland. While on scene, officers were approached by a male subject who stated he believed he may have been the actual target of the incident which was likely gang related. This investigation is ongoing.

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 5TH WARD



Accident-Pedestrian — 9/26/2022

6200 block of Cermak — 4:26p.m.

Officers were dispatched to the 6200 block of Cermak for a call of a 2 year old child that was struck by a vehicle. Upon arrival, officers observed a female subject holding her two year old daughter in her arms on the sidewalk outside of the Rosin EyeCare. The two year old was bleeding extensively from the mouth and had a missing tooth as a result of being hit by the vehicle. The two year old was transported to Loyola by the Berwyn FD for treatment. The victim's mother related that she and her family were walking across Cermak Road when cars in both lanes of Eastbound traffic stopped to let them walk across. A black colored sedan, driven by a Male Hispanic with long hair, drove around the stopped vehicles into the diagonal parking spaces adjacent to Cermak and subsequently struck the child. The child's father then attempted to get the driver of the offending vehicle to stop, however, the offender left the scene and continued Eastbound on Cermak. The victim's father injured his hand during the incident and was transferred to Mac Neal Hospital for treatment. Berwyn Police located the offender in Cicero and took him into custody without incident. The offender was later positively identified as the driver in a show up and subsequently charged with Class 4 Felony – *Leaving the Scene of an Accident Involving an Injury to a Pedestrian*. Case closed by arrest.

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 6TH WARD



Possession of Stolen Motor Vehicle x3/ Battery/ Motor Vehicle Accident — 10/02/2022 16th Street/Scoville — 5:46p.m.

Officers responded to a motor vehicle accident at 16th Street/Scoville where multiple individuals exited one of the involved vehicles and got into other vehicles or left the area on foot. While on scene, two black male subjects from one vehicle punched the female driver of the other vehicle involved in the accident. The male subject's vehicle along with two of the getaway vehicles were all found to be stolen vehicles with broken windows and peeled steering columns (Note: Vehicles makes were Kia and Hyundai).

Shortly after Berwyn dispatch received another call at 18th Street/Gunderson reporting that multiple people exited the Hyundai SUV with weapons and piled into the KIA Sportage. Witnesses further related that the offenders fled the area in the KIA Sportage and proceeded to the 1400 block of Gunderson where approximately 10-12 people exited the vehicle and fled the area. Responding officers successfully took 6 of the offenders into custody without incident. The offenders were later positively identified by the victim. A search of the three stolen cars and the area around the 3 scenes were met with negative results for weapons. All six people taken into custody are Juveniles. Incident turned over to Youth Investigations and all 6 Juvenile offenders were subsequently charged.

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 7TH WARD

FOR WEEK OF 9/26/2022

Motor Vehicle Theft — 9/30/2022

Cermak/Harlem — 6:52p.m.

Officers were dispatched to Cermak/Harlem for report of a motor vehicle theft. Upon arrival, officers spoke with the victim who related that she was involved in an auto accident at 25th Street/Harlem (North Riverside) and while attempting to exchange information with the offending vehicle the Driver and two occupants became aggressive with her. The driver and occupants of the offending vehicle were all described as Juvenile, Female subjects. The victim further related that she was in fear of receiving a battery and therefore got back into her vehicle and left the scene. After the accident, the victim stopped exited her vehicle, in the middle of stopped traffic at Harlem/Cermak, to notify a North Riverside Officer who was nearby that she wished to make a report. After speaking with the officer the victim discovered that her vehicle was missing. The victim was still in possession of the key fob at the time the vehicle was stolen. Later that night the stolen vehicle was located by Berwyn Police on the 2700 block of Grove. The owner was notified and recovered her vehicle. The victim (vehicle owner) related that several items appeared to be missing from inside the vehicle. This investigation is ongoing.




