



Criminal Damage to Property/Attempted Auto Theft — 12/12/2022 Kenilworth/Riverside Dr. — 12:54a.m.

Officers responded to a call of subjects breaking into a vehicle at Kenilworth/Riverside Drive. Upon arrival, officers located a silver Hyundai with a broken right rear window. Officers also observed a USB charging wire laying on the center console. According to the witness/caller, the offenders fled in a silver colored sedan Northbound on Kenilworth. No further description of the offenders or their vehicle was reported. The vehicle owner was notified. This investigation is ongoing.

Criminal Damage to Property/Attempted Auto Theft — 12/12/2022 2600 block of Clinton — 1:01a.m.

While checking the area of the previous attempted auto theft, officers located another Hyundai on the 2600 block of Clinton Ave. with a broken rear window and the rear door wide open. The owner was notified and the incident was documented. This investigation is ongoing.





SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 4TH WARD

Aggravated Fleeing/Eluding — 12/17/2022 Clarence/25th Street — 3:49a.m.

Officers attempted to make a traffic stop, however, the offending vehicle failed to stop. A brief pursuit began during which the offending vehicle committed several traffic violations. Due to the road conditions, the officer self-terminated the pursuit. A short time later, the officer observed said vehicle at 18th Street/East and made another attempt to conduct a traffic stop and the offending vehicle fled a second time. The pursuit was terminated almost immediately. While checking the license plate of the offending vehicle, officers discovered that said vehicle had been involved in a previous incident in Berwyn in which the driver/offender fled from the police. Officers later discovered said vehicle parked (unoccupied) on the 3700 block of Wesley. The offending vehicle was subsequently towed and impounded. This investigation is ongoing.






SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 5TH WARD

Vehicular Hijacking — 12/14/2022 6200 block of Cermak — 12:35a.m.

Officers responded to a call of a vehicular hijacking on the 6200 block of Cermak (vacin). The victim related that they were loading laundry into their vehicle which was running with the keys inside when it was taken by force; no weapon was displayed or implied and the victim was not injured. The victim described the offender as a Male Hispanic, approximately 25 years old, wearing all black with a gray face mask. This investigation is ongoing.





Armed Habitual Criminal — 12/18/2022 Cermak/Oak Park Ave. — 3:42a.m.

While on patrol, officers observed a vehicle pass them on Oak Park Ave. at a high rate of speed. Officers then conducted a U-turn at which time the offending vehicle extinguished their lights, and turned into the alley. Officers pulled up behind said vehicle at which time the driver exited the vehicle and attempted to throw a handgun over the garage at that location. Officers recovered one handgun from the scene. The subject does not have a valid FOID/CCL. The subject was subsequently taken into custody without incident. Officers observed what appeared to be a bullet hole through the back window as well as a bullet hole in the rear fender of the vehicle. The vehicle was impounded and the subject transported to the station. A criminal history inquiry for the offender revealed him to have an extensive criminal history including 2 prior convictions for weapons offenses, 6 prior convictions for dangerous drugs, and 3 charges for homicide. The offender was charged with 1 felony count for Armed Habitual Criminal. Case closed by arrest.


Shots Fired/Aggravated Assault — 12/12/2022 Shell Gas Station (6405 W. Roosevelt Rd.) — 2:27p.m.

Officers responded to the Shell Gas Station (6405 Roosevelt) for a call of shots fired. Upon arrival officers made contact with a male subject who related he stood inside the gas station when an unknown Black Male subject fired two rounds at him from the entrance. The male subject was not struck by gunfire and stated he did not want medical assistance. Officers recovered two shell casings right outside the door to the entranceway and a projectile from the door. The witness further related that the offender then got into a black sedan and fled Westbound on Roosevelt and then South on East Avenue. This incident is currently under investigation.

Aggravated Discharge of Firearm — 12/18/2022 Distro Music (6815 W. Roosevelt) — 2:03a.m.

Berwyn Police officers, assisted by the Oak Park and Forest Park Police Departments, responded to Distro Music in regards to a disturbance. As officers arrived on scene they heard gun shots in the immediate area from what appeared to be patrons leaving Distro Music. The scene was chaotic with large groups of people exiting, yelling and running in all directions. Upon gaining control of the scene it was determined that two individuals were struck by gunfire. Those same two individuals were transported to an area hospital with non-life threatening injuries. A canvass of the area revealed several spent shell casings along Roosevelt Rd. Officers also recovered one firearm from the scene. Several individuals were detained pending further investigation. One subject has subsequently been arrested and charged with one felony count of Aggravated Discharge of a Firearm. This is an isolated incident that began and stemmed from patrons of Distro Music. This investigation is ongoing.






SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 8TH WARD
