




SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 1ST WARD

FOR WEEK OF 6/26/2023

Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer — 7/01/2023 Windsor Coin Laundry (6926 Windsor) — 2:36p.m.

Officers responded to Windsor Coin Laundry for a report of a battery that occurred amongst two patrons inside of the establishment. Responding officers met with the victim who positively identified a female subject outside as the offender. Officers approached said female subject and informed her she was being placed into custody. The offender immediately began resisting arrest and bit the left forearm of one of the arresting officers. Officers transported the offender to the Berwyn Police Department where officers learned that she had an active Warrant out of Rockford. The offender was subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer. Case closed by arrest.





Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon/Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Felon/Resisting a Police Officer Euclid Ave/25th Street — 6/27/2023 — 4:38p.m.

Berwyn Tactical Officers observed a male subject walking Northbound on the 2500 block of Oak Park Avenue. Officers positively identified said subject as a subject wanted by the Berwyn Police Department with probable cause for arrest. Officers activated their lights and ordered the male subject to stop at which time the subject disobeyed verbal commands and began to flee on foot Eastbound on 25th Street. After a short foot pursuit, officers stopped the subject and placed him in custody. While placing the subject in custody, the subject displayed a firearm in his waistband. Officers recovered the loaded firearm and confirmed that said subject did not have a valid FOID or CCL. The subject was transported to the Berwyn Police Department and subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon, one (1) felony count of Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Felon, and one (1) class A Misdemeanor of Resisting a Police Officer. Case closed by arrest.

Reckless Discharge of a Firearm — 6/27/2023 3100 block of Kenilworth — 11:24p.m.

Officers responded to the 3100 block of Kenilworth in reference to a report of one (1) shot fired. Responding officers met with the witness involved (Juvenile) who positively identified the offender on scene as a neighbor. The offender was subsequently taken into custody and transported to the Berwyn Police Department. Officers conducted a canvass of the area which revealed one (1) spent shell casing. No injuries or damage to property were reported. After further investigation, the offender was charged with one (1) felony count of Reckless Discharge of a Firearm. Case closed by arrest.

Officers stopped a Juvenile subject for a curfew violation. A custodial search of the juvenile's backpack revealed Psychedelic Mushrooms, Cannabis, THC cartridges, and Tobacco. The subject was transported to the Berwyn Police Department. The juvenile subject was arrested and subsequently released to his father.







SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 7TH WARD

Burglary to Motor Vehicle/Criminal Trespass to Vehicle x2 1500 block of Home Ave — 6/27/2023 — 4:26a.m.

Officers responded to the 1500 block of Harlem in reference to a vehicle that was burglarized overnight. Officers met with the victim/owner of the vehicle who stated he left his vehicle unlocked and discovered items missing when he returned to the vehicle. The victim further related that he observed an unknown male subject on his video surveillance enter his vehicle and rummage through it. A canvass of the area revealed two (2) other vehicles on the block were also entered. Officers made contact with the owner of the second vehicle who related he left his vehicle unlocked but did not report anything missing. Officers were unable to make contact with the owner of the third vehicle. This investigation is ongoing.

Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon/Unlawful Delivery of Cannabis/Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer — 6/27/2023 Grove/19th Street — 5:53p.m.

Officers observed a male subject walking on the 1900 block of Kenilworth approach the front door of a residence, execute a hand-to-hand transaction, and then continue walking. Officers further observed said subject adjusting his waistband in a manner that is consistent with attempting to adjust a concealed firearm. Officers subsequently exited their squad and attempted to conduct a street stop on the male subject. The subject actively resisted and officers subsequently conducted an emergency takedown on said subject. (Note: During the altercation, the subject struck one of the officers in the face with a closed fist causing a small bloody laceration and struck a second officer in the head.) Officers conducted a search of the subject and recovered an un-holstered loaded handoun from the subject's pants. Officers also recovered eleven (11) individually packaged plastic bags containing a green plant-like substance suspect Cannabis, inside of the subject's bag. Officers confirmed the subject has a valid FOID but no CCL. The subject was subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of each of the following: Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon (on the public way); Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon (in violation of controlled substance act); Unlawful Delivery of Cannabis; Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer; Aggravated Resisting a Peace Officer; Resisting/Obstructing a Peace Officer; Unlawful Possession of Cannabis. Case closed by arrest.






SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 8TH WARD
