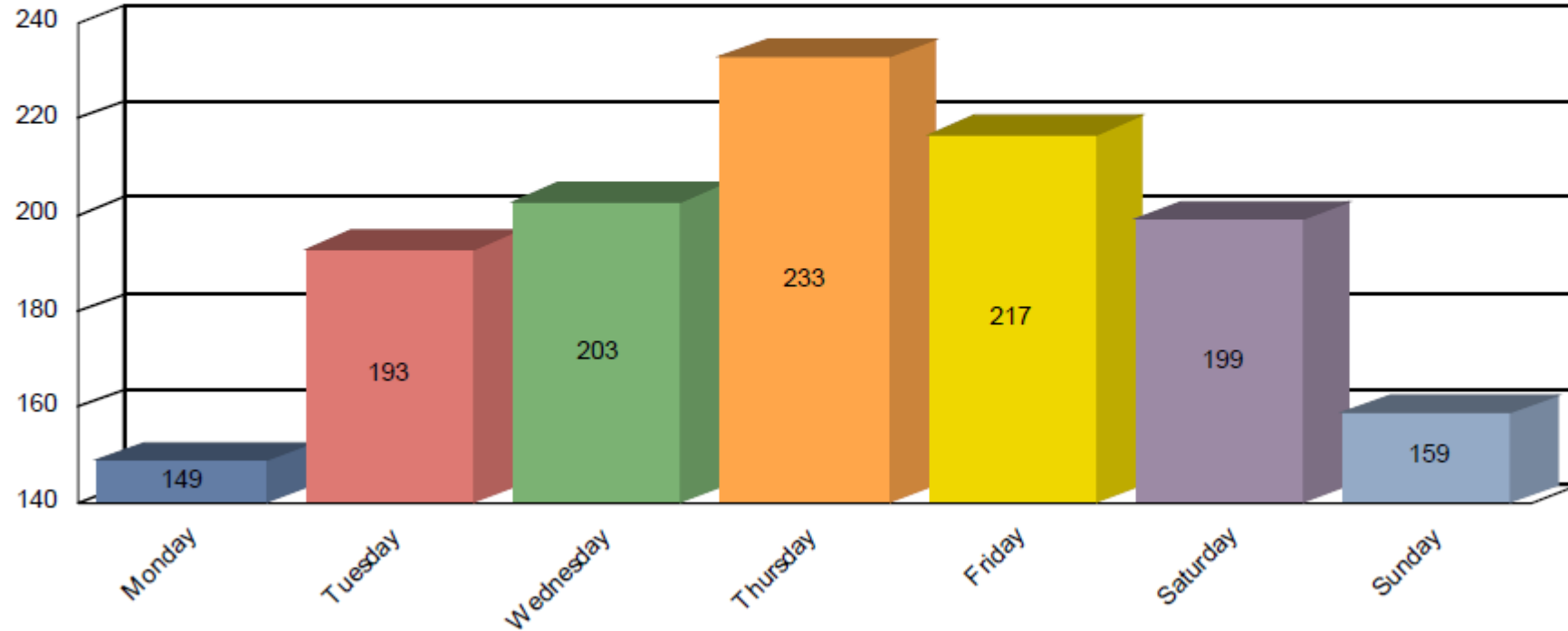

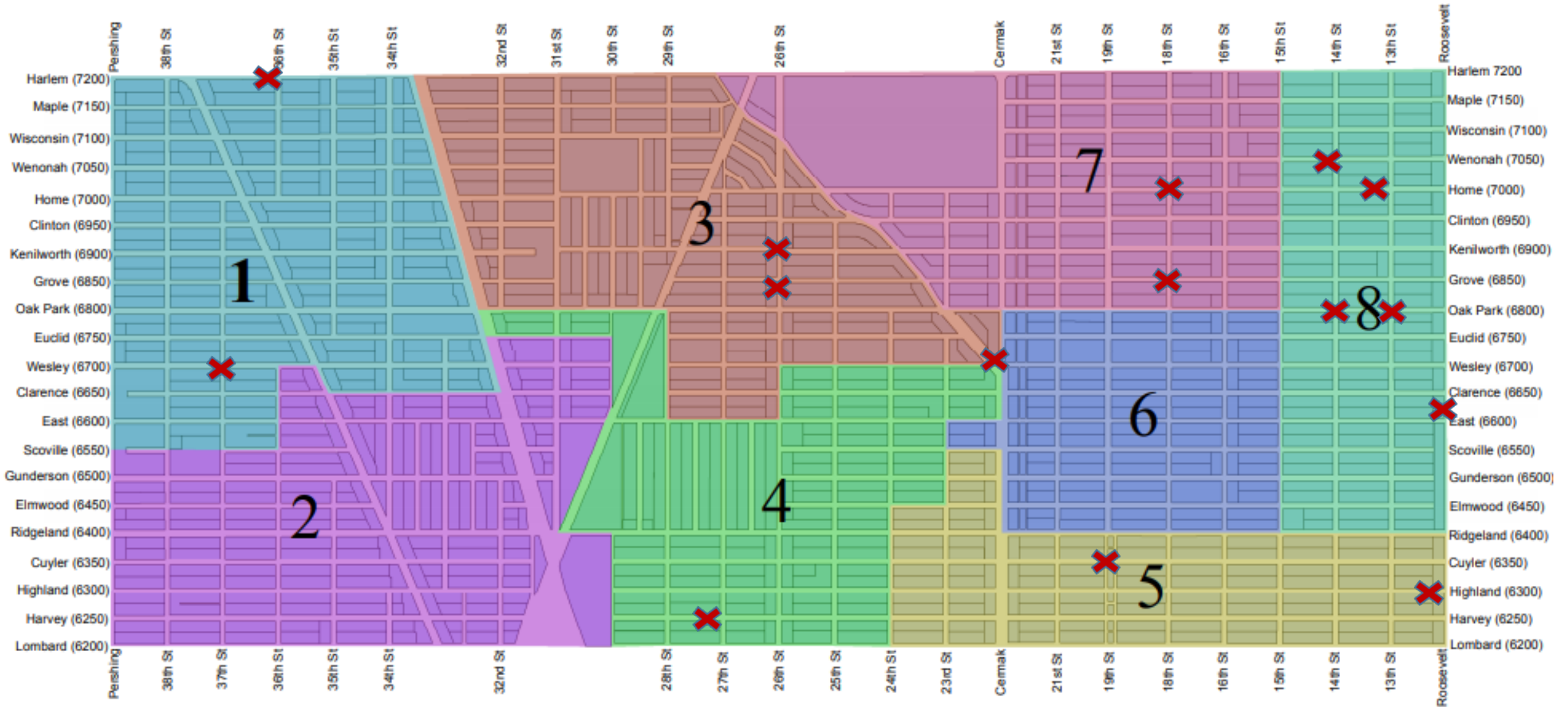

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 1ST WARD

FOR WEEK OF 8/14/2023

Criminal Damage to Property — 8/16/2023 **The Grove (3601 S. Harlem Ave.) — 12:03a.m.**

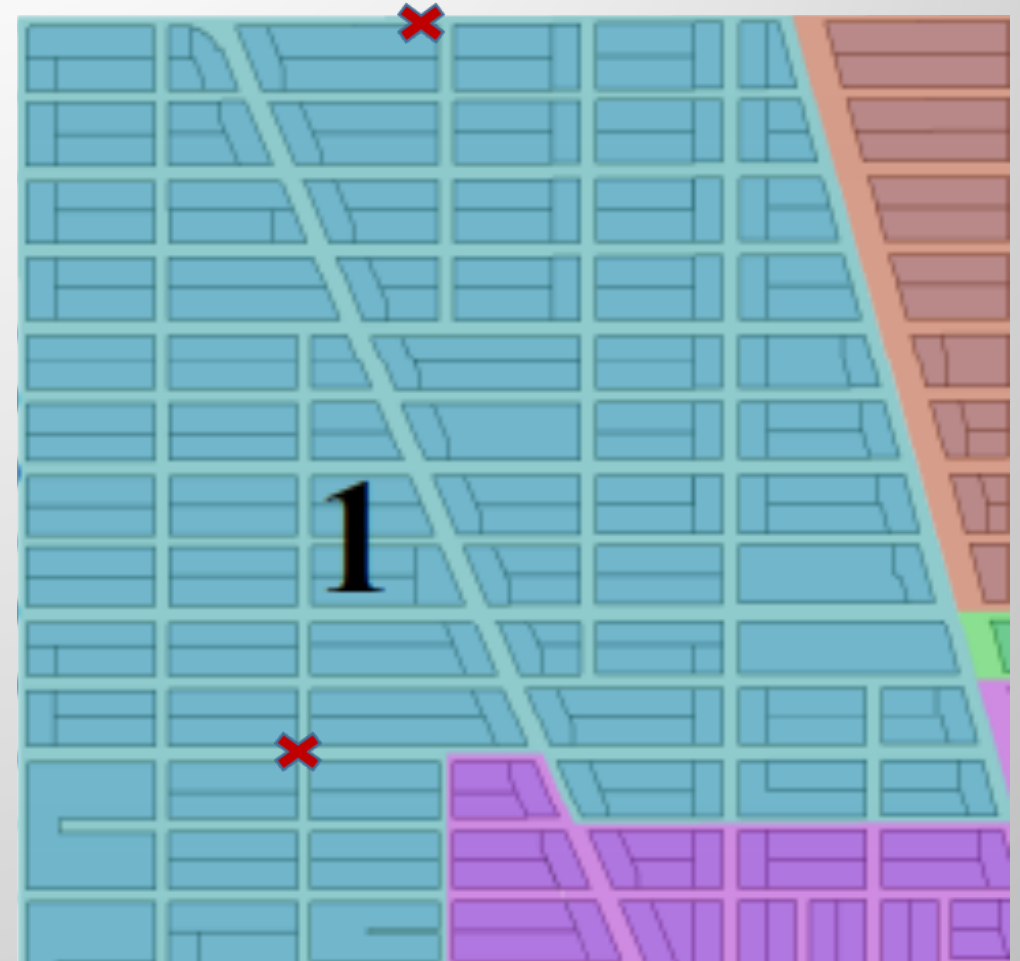
Units responded to The Grove for an employee displaying erratic behavior and refusing to leave the premises. Upon arrival, the Staff Supervisor advised officers that the male subject was asked to leave for the night after he arrived at work intoxicated. Officers further learned that the subject had broken an electronic glass door, turned over desks, and damaged several computers. Units made contact with the male subject who was found bleeding from his hand. Said subject became uncooperative with the police and fled Southbound on Harlem Avenue on foot. As the scene was being processed, said subject returned and was taken into custody without incident. The subject was first transported to Mac Neal Hospital for treatment and then to the Berwyn Police Department for processing. The subject was subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Criminal Damage to Property. Case closed by arrest.

Residential Burglary — 8/20/2023 **37th Street/Wesley — 10:45a.m.**

Berwyn Dispatch received a call from a male subject who related that while riding his bike, he believed he observed the offender who was responsible for burglarizing his garage on 6/4/2023. Responding officers conducted a check of the area and located the offending vehicle. A traffic stop was conducted and the driver was taken into custody for the Residential Burglary incident that occurred on 6/4/2023. The offender was transported to the Berwyn Police Department and subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Residential Burglary. Case closed by arrest.

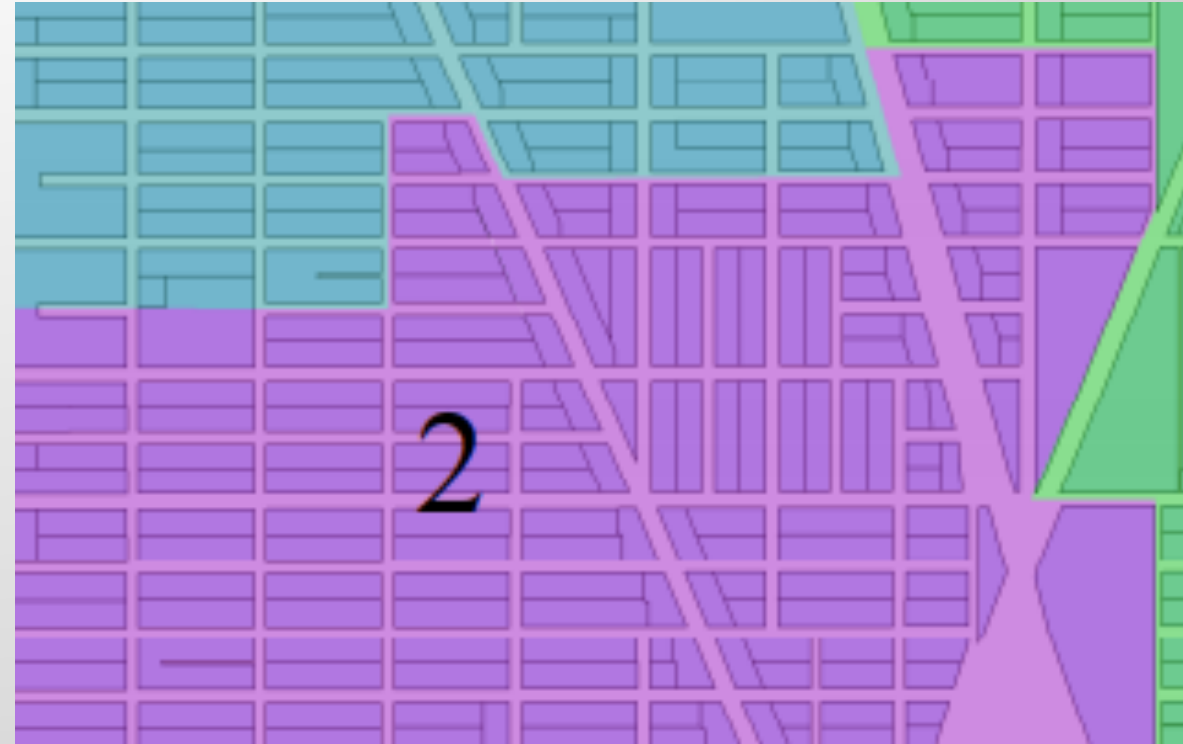

Battery — 8/19/2023

26th Street/Grove— 2:22a.m.

While on patrol, officers observed several subjects fighting outside after leaving Topsy's Tap (6802 W. 26th Street). The officer exited his vehicle in an attempt to stop the fight at which time several subjects fled on foot. The officer observed a battery victim who was highly intoxicated and unable to identify the offender. Berwyn FD transported the victim to Mac Neal Hospital for treatment. The victim refused to cooperate and provide any information surrounding the incident and advised he did not wish to sign any complaints.

Fight/Mob Action — 8/19/2023

26th Street/Kenilworth — 2:40a.m.

Berwyn Dispatch received a call of a large group of people fighting in the street in the area of 26th Street/Kenilworth. Responding officers observed several people fighting in the street and began separating subjects from the fight. One (1) officer was battered by a female subject as he was taking another female subject in custody. It was learned that the fight stemmed from an argument that occurred inside of Topsy's Tap. Multiple subjects were taken into custody and charged accordingly.

Male Subject #1 was charged with one (1) count of misdemeanor Mob Action

Male Subject #2 was charged with one (1) count of misdemeanor Obstructing a Police Officer and one (1) misdemeanor count of Resisting Arrest

Male Subject #3 was charged with one (1) count of misdemeanor Mob Action

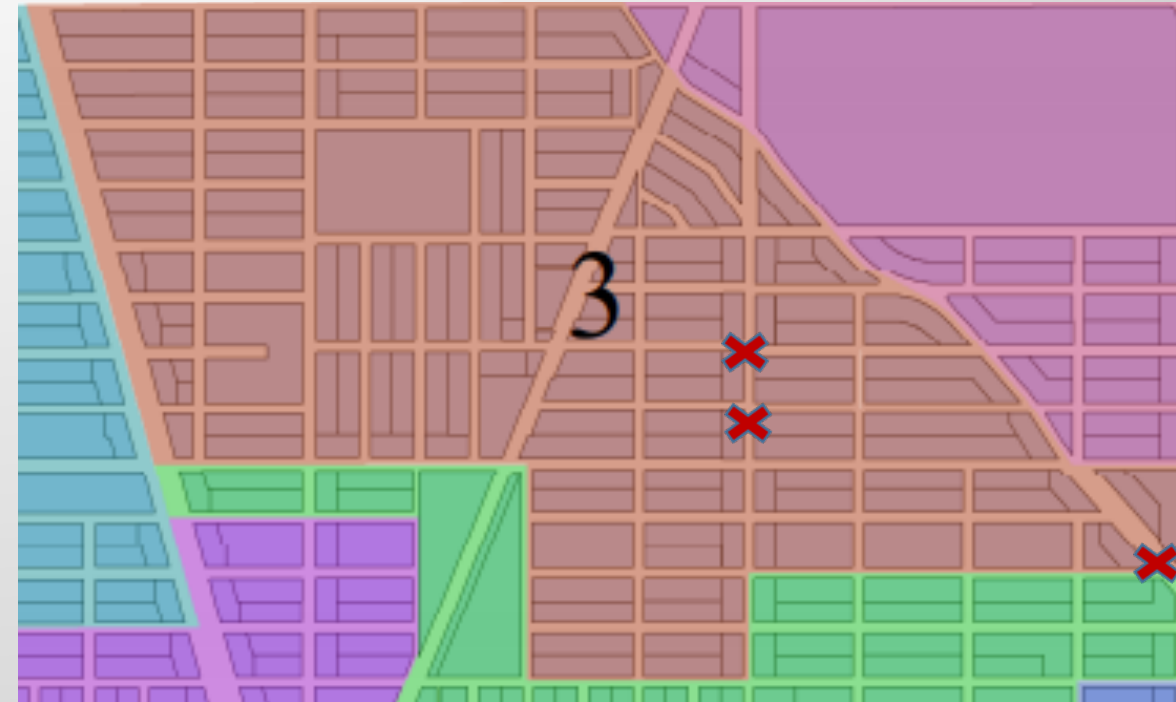
Male Subject #4 was charged with one (1) count of misdemeanor Mob Action and one (1) count of misdemeanor Resisting a Police Officer

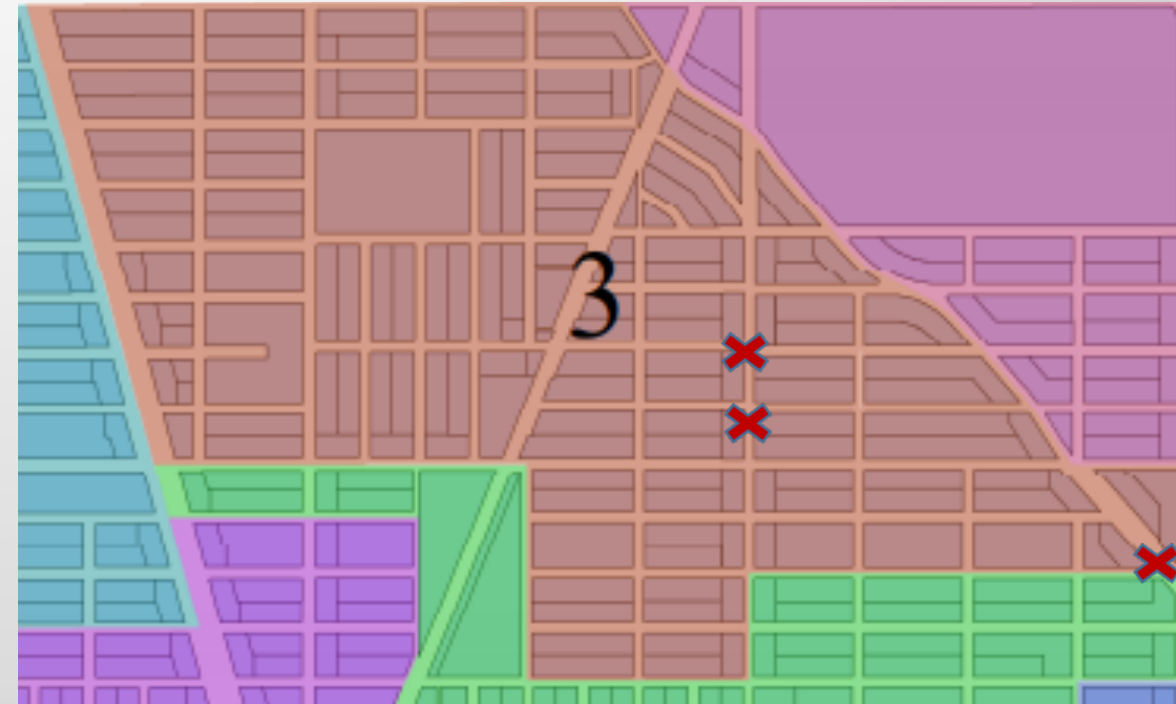

Armed Robbery — 8/20/2023 Cermak/Wesley — 12:13a.m.

Officers responded to a report of an Armed Robbery that had just occurred in the area of Cermak/Wesley. Responding officers met with the 63 year old male victim who was bleeding from his right arm. The victim stated he had just left the BP Gas Station (Cermak/Wesley) and was walking home when he observed a dark in color, SUV pull up to his location. The victim further related that three (3) Male Black subjects wearing masks and all brandishing hand guns, approached and surrounded him, demanding his money while pointing the handguns in his face. The victim stated that he complied and the offenders fled on foot back into their vehicle and left the area. The victim was transported to Mac Neal Hospital for medical treatment. This investigation is ongoing.

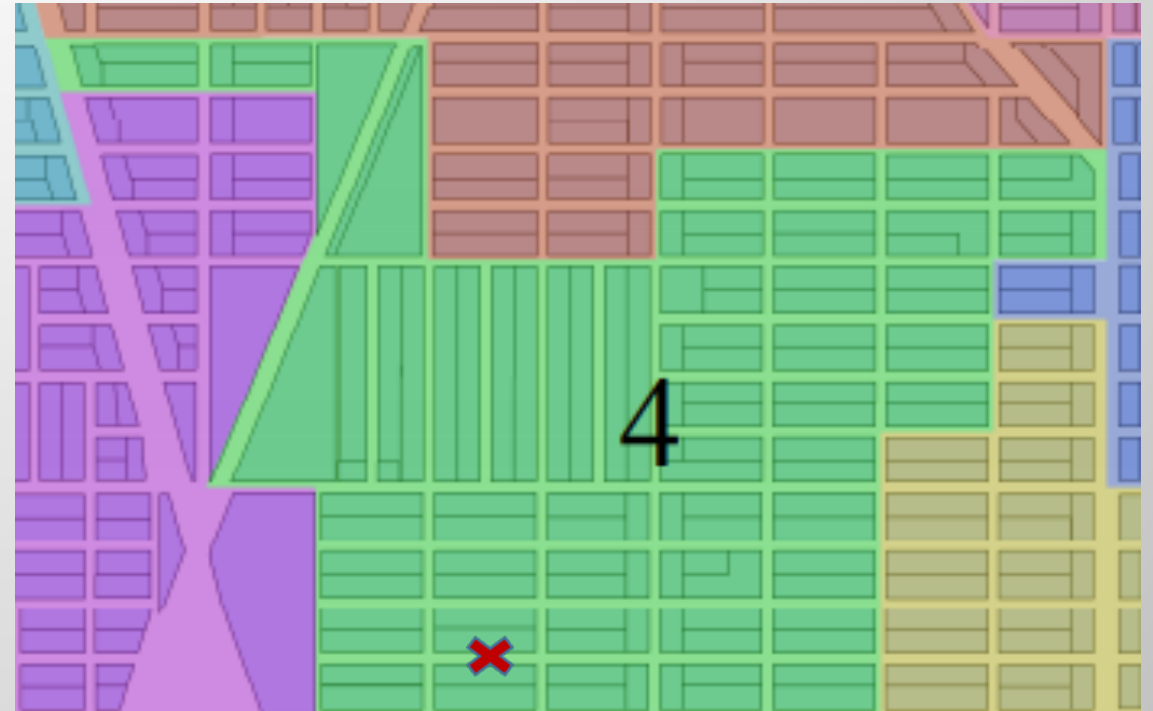

House Fire — 8/18/2023 2700 block of Harvey — 12:50p.m.

Officers responded to the 2700 block of Harvey for a report of a house fire. Berwyn Police Officers blocked off the area for vehicle and pedestrian traffic. Berwyn FD, along with assisting agencies, extinguished the fire. The family of four (4) were not harmed and Red Cross responded for assistance in placement for the displaced family. Berwyn FD is conducting an investigation.

Recovered Stolen Auto — 8/18/2023 **1200 block of Highland — 2:44a.m.**

Berwyn Dispatch received a call from a female subject reporting she just heard glass break on the 1200 block of Highland and then observed a dark colored truck (or possibly van) flee from the alley along with a dark colored sedan following it. Responding officers located one (1) empty parking space on the 1200 block of Highland with broken glass on the ground, consistent with motor vehicle thefts. An extensive search was done to locate a possible owner to determine what vehicle was taken, but met with negative results.

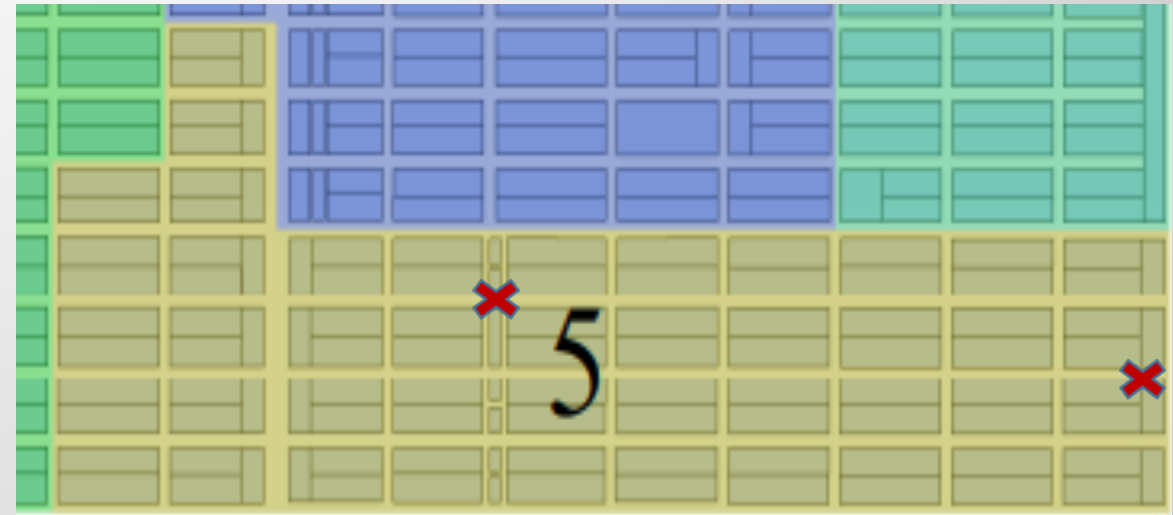
Later in the shift, a victim called to report her black in color vehicle (Hyundai) had been stolen. The victim further advised that she had a tracker on the vehicle. Units located the vehicle in Chicago parked behind an apparent abandoned building. This investigation is ongoing.

Shots Fired (Unfounded) — 8/18/2023 **19th Street/Cuyler — 2:44a.m.**

Berwyn Dispatch received multiple calls from concerned callers who reported they heard shots fired in the area of 19th Street/Cuyler and Cuyler/Vacin. All reporting parties stated they heard the shots but did not see anything. Officers canvassed the area but were met with negative results for any property damage, shell casings, or reported victims.

Criminal Trespass to Motor Vehicle/Resisting a Peace Officer 1800 block of Grove — 8/16/2023 — 3:06a.m.

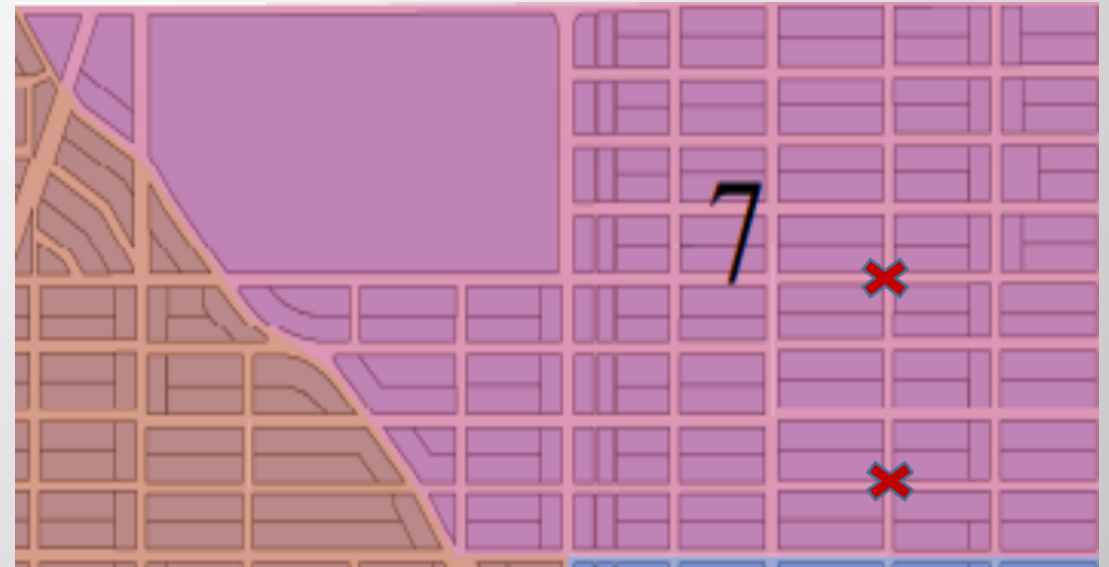
Officers responded to the 1800 block of Grove for a report of a group of teenagers jumping on cars. Responding officers made contact with a Male Black juvenile subject who was observed reaching inside of a parked vehicle. When officers asked the subject who's car he was in, said subject fled on foot. Following a short foot pursuit, officers caught the juvenile subject on the 1800 block of Kenilworth at which time he resisted arrest. The subject was ultimately taken into custody and transported to the Berwyn Police Department for further investigation. During the investigation, officers made contact with the registered owner of the vehicle who confirmed he did not know the juvenile subject in custody and did not give permission for him to enter his vehicle. Nothing was reported missing from the vehicle. The juvenile subject was subsequently charged with Criminal Trespass to Motor Vehicle and Resisting a Police Officer. Case closed by arrest.

Aggravated Assault — 8/17/2023 18th Street/Home Ave. — 8:37a.m.

Berwyn Officers responded to 18th Street/Home Ave. for a report of an Aggravated Assault. The victim advised she stopped her vehicle at a posted stop sign at 18th Street/Home Ave. when a silver-in-color vehicle drove behind her at a high rate of speed and then pulled up beside her. The victim further advised that said vehicle was occupied by four (4) Male Black subjects all wearing ski masks. One (1) of the subjects displayed a pistol at her and then drove away. No shots were fired during this incident. The victim provided the police with the offending vehicle's registration, which officers learned was stolen out of Chicago and registered to a black-in-color SUV. This investigation is ongoing.

Stolen Auto — 8/16/2023 **Oak Park Ave/14th Street — 2:52a.m.**

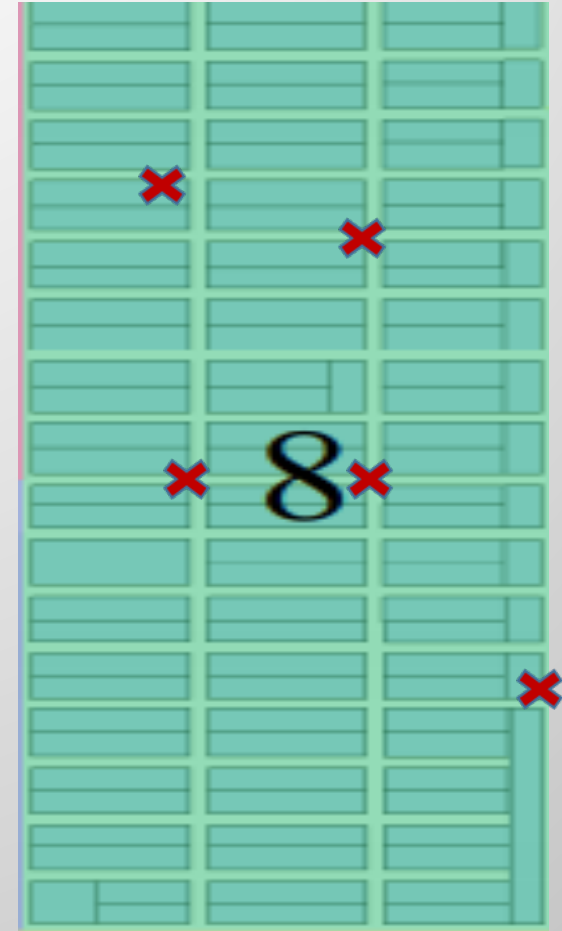
Officers attempted to make a traffic stop on a vehicle (Kia). The vehicle did not stop and then fled Northbound onto Highland (one-way Southbound). Officers terminated the pursuit shortly after and proceeded to the 2100 block of Kenilworth where they learned said car was registered to. Upon arrival on the 2100 block of Kenilworth, officers located broken glass on the street and later located the peeled steering column in the Kenilworth/Clinton alley. Owners of said vehicle were contacted and advised. Said vehicle was also entered into LEADS as stolen. On 8/17/23, officers located said stolen vehicle parked on the 1200 block of Clarence. Said vehicle was found with a broken window, peeled steering column, and gang-related insignia written with marker on the roof liner inside the vehicle. Said vehicle was removed from LEADS and towed for processing. This investigation is ongoing.

Attempted Catalytic Converter Theft — 8/16/2023 **1300 block of Home Ave. — 3:51a.m.**

Officers responded to the 1300 block of Home Ave. for a report of a Catalytic Converter theft that had just occurred. The reporting party stated she heard a “saw” like noise and looked out her window to see an unknown male subject holding a flash light and another male subject underneath a parked vehicle. The witness believed the subjects were in the process of sawing off a Catalytic Converter and so she yelled out the window at which time the subjects fled the scene in a dark colored vehicle. Responding officers conducted a check of said vehicle and observed that the Catalytic Converter was only cut off on one end and was still attached to said vehicle. Officers learned that the vehicle was registered to an owner out of Cicero, but were unable to make contact with the owners. The vehicle was subsequently towed for processing. This investigation is ongoing.

Battery — 8/17/2023

Fitzgerald's Bar (6615 W. Roosevelt) — 7:52p.m.

Officers responded to a report of a Battery at Fitzgerald's Bar. Upon arrival, officers learned that a female patron struck a male patron. A complaint was signed and no injuries were reported. The female patron was taken into custody without incident and subsequently charged with one (1) count of Battery. Case closed by arrest.

Attempted Stolen Auto — 8/18/2023

1400 block of Wenonah — 2:27a.m.

Officers responded to the 1400 block of Wenonah for a report of an Attempted Stolen Auto. Responding officers met with the victim who related she heard the sound of glass breaking outside and then observed an unknown male subject (possibly Hispanic or Black) with light skin, in his teens, wearing gloves, a black hooded sweatshirt and black colored pants. The reporting party further advised she saw said subject run to a black-in-color vehicle that was waiting at the end of the block, entered the vehicle, and then fled Southbound on Wenonah. Officers observed the rear driver side window broken out and the steering column peeled on the victim's vehicle. Additional units on scene conducted a check of the area for possible offender(s) but were met with negative results. This investigation is ongoing.

Victim reported they parked their vehicle in the area of Oak Park Ave/13th Street at 7:30p.m. on 8/17/23 and when they returned at 9:00a.m. on 8/18/23 they discovered their vehicle was missing. Berwyn Police entered the vehicle into LEADS as stolen. Said vehicle was located on 8/24/23 by Cicero PD. The vehicle was removed from LEADS and the owner was notified. This investigation is ongoing.
