



Financial Exploitation of a Disabled Person/Deceptive Practice 2400 block of Kenilworth — 8/27/2023 — 12:01p.m.

Officers responded to the 2400 block of Kenilworth for a report of a Deceptive Practice incident. The victim's disabled son was previously contacted by an unknown male who attempted to deposit a check for a large amount of money in his bank account. On 8/27/23, a Male Black subject arrived at the victim's residence in attempt to recover the money. The victim's father attempted to intervene at which time the subject fled leaving his vehicle, cell phone, and shoes behind. The offender was described as a Male Black subject with dreadlocks, wearing a white t-shirt, grey joggers, and no shoes. The subject fled on foot Southeast from said location. This investigation is ongoing.

Aggravated Battery/Unlawful Use of a Weapon — 8/27/2023 7100 block of Riverside Drive — 1:25a.m.

Berwyn Officers responded to a residence on the 7100 block of Riverside Drive for a report of a gunshot victim. Upon arrival, responding officers learned a domestic dispute occurred between a male and female subject inside of the residence. During the dispute the female subject fired one shot at the male subject and struck him in the face. The victim was transported to a local area hospital for treatment. The female subject surrendered herself to police and was taken into custody without incident. This investigation is ongoing.











Unlawful Use of a Weapon-Knife/Aggravated Assault — 8/22/2023 McDonald's (Cermak/Ridgeland) — 1:36a.m.

Officers responded to McDonald's (Cermak/Ridgeland) for a report of an assault that had just occurred. Responding officers learned that a Male Black subject was making loud and derogatory comments inside of the restaurant when he was approached by a female patron who told him to stop. The male subject continued to cause disruption in the restaurant when a male patron became involved at which time a verbal altercation ensued among all three (3) parties. The offender then pulled a folding knife out of his front pocket and displayed an open blade in the direction of the male and female subjects. The offender attempted to move in the direction of the patrons with the knife in his hand. The offender disobeyered verbal commands from officers to stand down and an officer subsequently deployed his taser, striking the victim in the back, and ultimately eliminated the active threat. The offender was taken into custody and transported to the Berwyn Police Department and subsequently charged accordingly. Case closed by arrest.

Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Felon — 8/22/2023 16th Street/Highland — 9:22p.m.

Officers responded to a call of a man with a gun in the area of 16th Street/Highland. The caller stated a Hispanic Male subject, wearing black shorts and no shirt, displayed a handgun at her when she was driving. Officers located a male subject matching that description in the rear of a residence on the 1500 block of Highland. Said male subject had a loaded firearm next to where he was sitting when officers arrived. Positive identification on said subject as well as the firearm was made by the victims. Officers learned that the offender does not have a valid FOID or CCL. Officers placed the offender in custody and transported him to the Berwyn Police Department for processing. The subject was charged with one (1) felony count of Unlawful Use of a Weapon by a Felon. Case closed by arrest.

Said subject was taken into custody and subsequently processed on the outstanding warrant. Case closed by arrest.

Catalytic Converter Theft — 8/25/2023 2300 block of Highland — 7:12a.m.



This investigation is ongoing.

Vehicle Takeover/Reckless Driving Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer — 8/27/2023 Cermak/Ridgeland Ave. — 12:44a.m.

Berwyn Dispatch received numerous calls in reference to multiple vehicles obstructing the intersection at Cermak/Ridgeland Ave. Responding Officers observed approximately 60+ vehicles attempting to take over the intersection by placing a flare in the middle of the intersection and circling around it. Officers were able to successfully block off the intersection and divert the traffic Eastbound on Cermak.

During this incident, officers observed a vehicle traveling Eastbound on Cermak at a high rate of speed. Officers conducted a traffic stop, however, the driver was uncooperative with officers. Officers took said driver into custody at which time the male subject spit in the face of the arresting officer. The subject was transported to the Berwyn Police Department and subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Battery to a Police Offier. Case closed by arrest.

Catalytic Converter Theft — 8/25/2023 1900 block of Elmwood — 6:28a.m.






