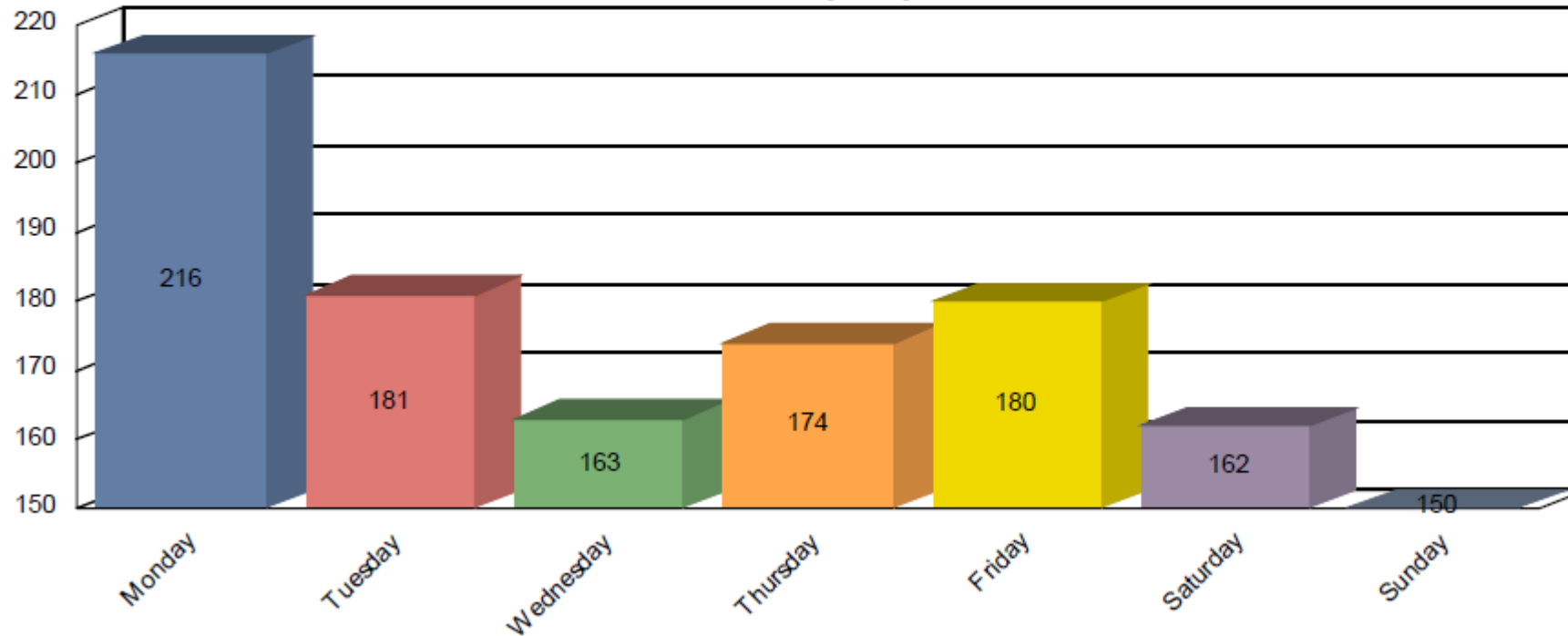

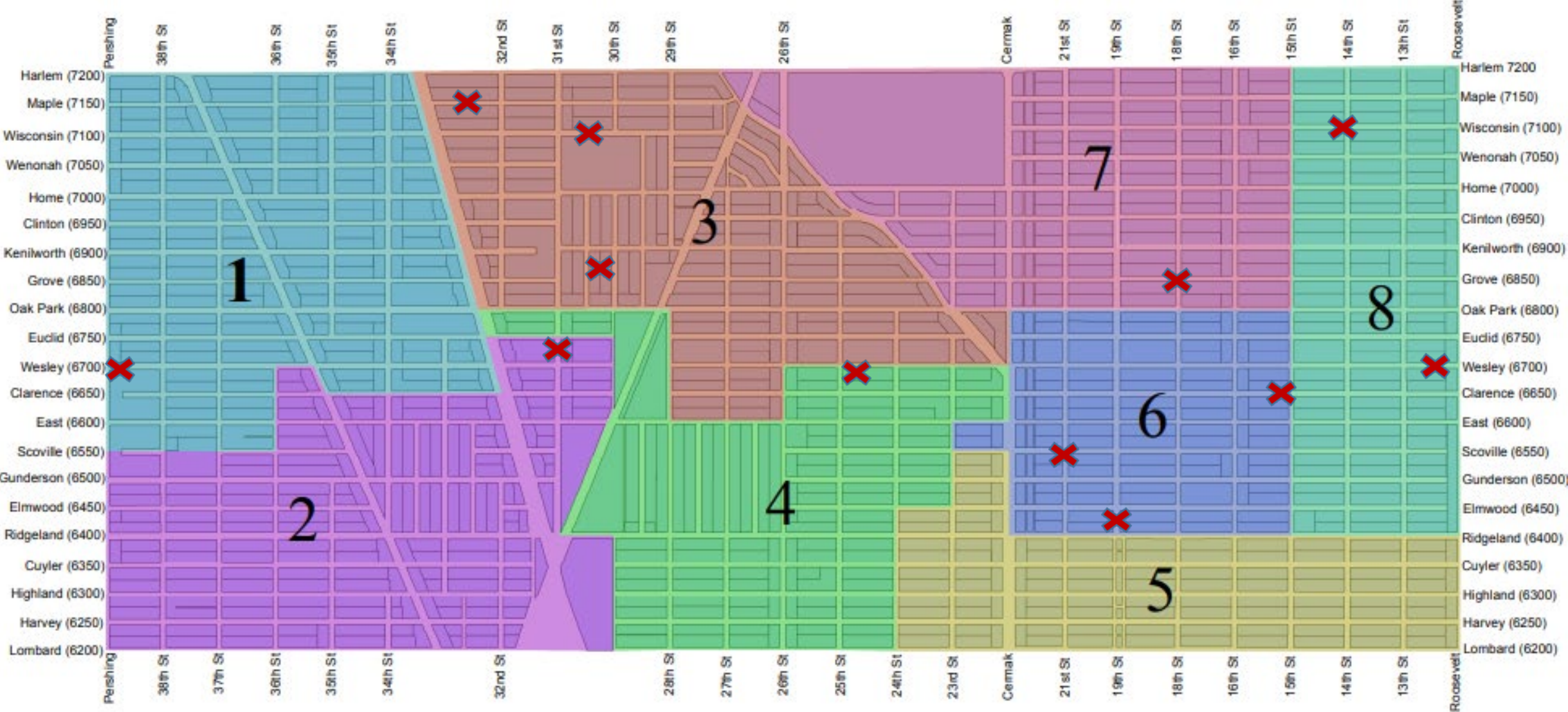

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 1ST WARD

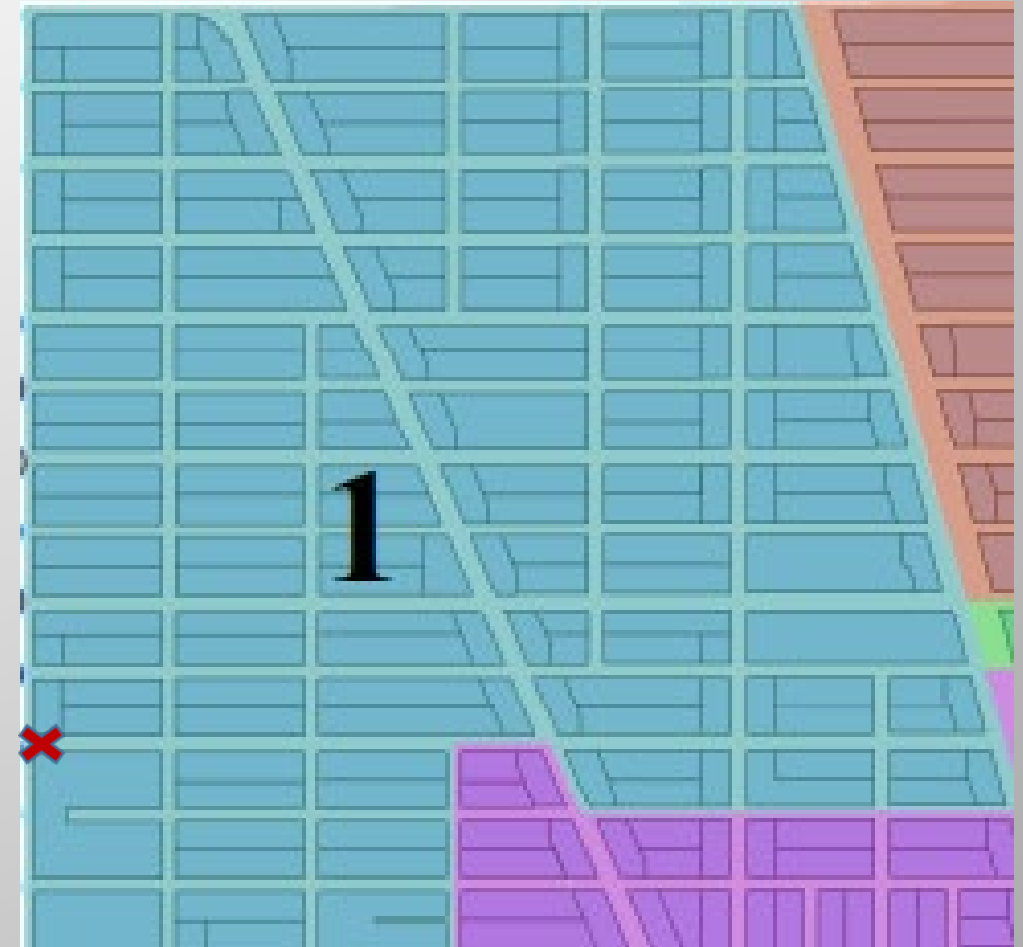
Attempted Armed Robbery (x2)/Armed Violence – 6/09/2024 Pershing Rd./Wesley Ave. – 2:21p.m.

BPD Dispatch received multiple 9-1-1 calls reporting a Black Male subject who displayed a handgun and demanded property from two (2) people near Pershing Rd./Wesley Ave. Witnesses related the offender was wearing a white shirt and black pants. Responding Officers were flagged down by a male subject and female subject who identified themselves as the victims of the Attempted Armed Robbery that had just occurred. The victims stated they were washing their vehicle outside of their residence on the 6700 block of Pershing Rd. when the offender approached them and demanded all of their money while displaying a handgun. When the victims did not have any money to give the offender, the offender began to flee on foot.

Units canvassed the area and observed a male subject matching the description near 37th Street/Wesley. When officers approached said male subject he began to flee on foot. Officers conducted a yard-to-yard search which revealed the offender hiding under a car parked inside of a garage on the 3600 block of Wesley Ave. Officers placed the subject in custody without further incident and transported him to the Berwyn Police Department. A firearm was recovered on the ground next to where the offender was located underneath the car. The offender was wearing an electronic monitoring device on his ankle and had multiple bags of Heroin on his person. The offender was subsequently charged with the following: one (1) felony count of Armed Violence – Class X, two (2) felony counts of Attempted Armed Robbery, one (1) felony count of Unlawful Possession of a Weapon by a Felon, one (1) felony count of Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance with Intent to Distribute, one (1) felony count of Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance, one (1) felony count of Criminal Trespass to Property. Case closed by arrest.

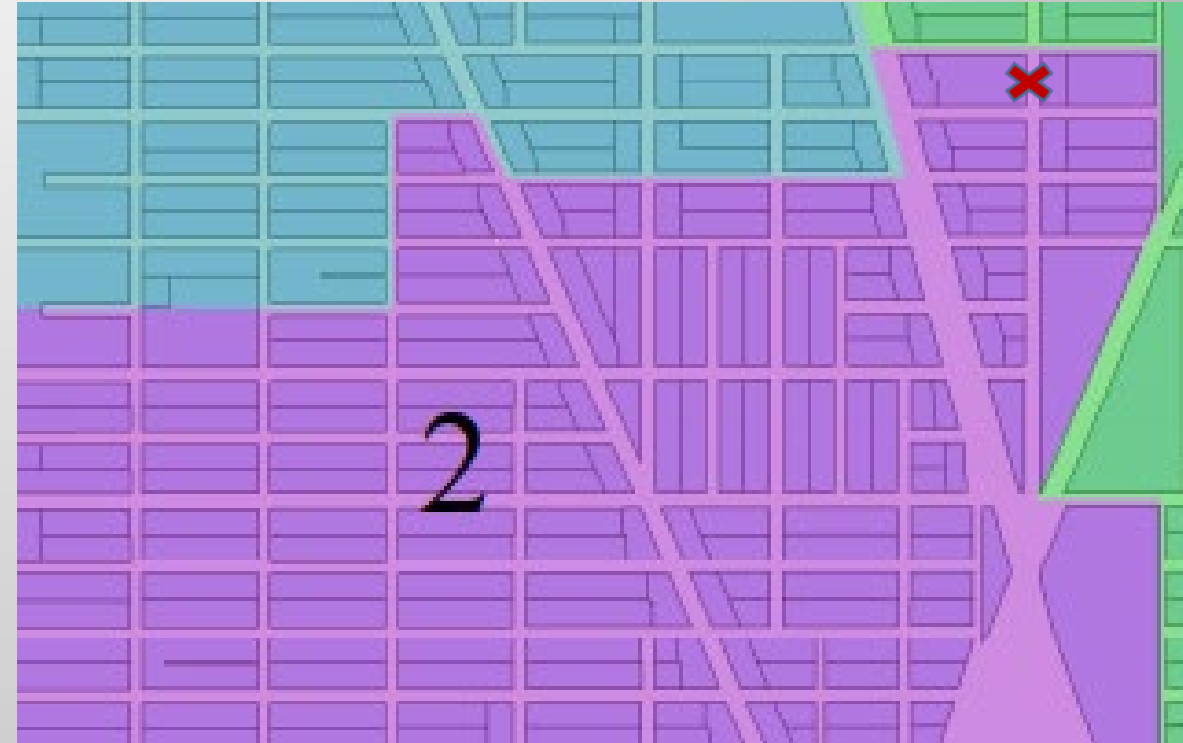

Officers responded to the 3000 block of Wisconsin Ave. for a report of a work van that was broken into. Responding officers met with the victim (vehicle owner) who stated he discovered the back doors left open and driver's side window broken on his van. The victim further related that he believed a power tool was missing from the van. This investigation is ongoing.

Burglary from Motor Vehicle and Garage – 6/09/2024 **3200 block of Maple Ave. – 4:05a.m.**

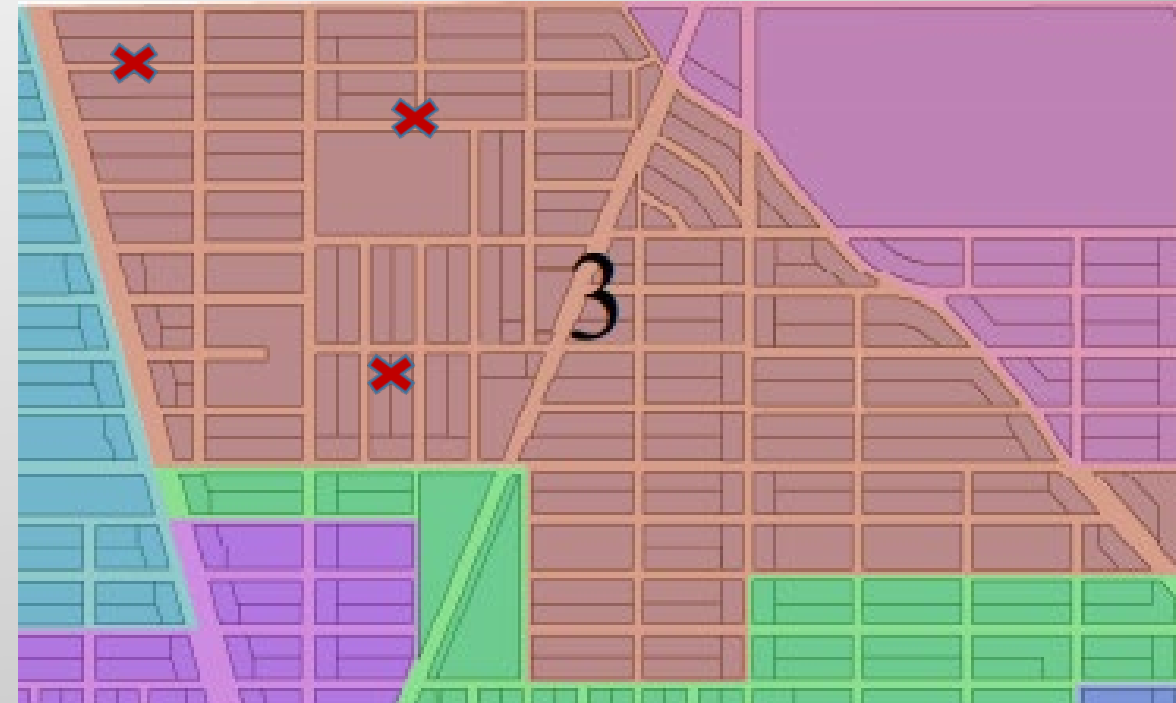
Officers responded to the 3200 block of Maple Ave. for a call of unwanted subjects in a backyard. Responding officers met with the reporting party who related that she observed multiple unknown subjects in her backyard who then entered a nearby neighbor's garage. The reporting party shared security video footage with officers which revealed three (3) subjects, dressed in all black, exit a black in color SUV in the alley and enter the reporting party's yard. The offenders then went to the neighbor's house where they entered the neighbor's vehicle and then used the garage door opener found inside said vehicle to enter the garage where an additional vehicle was parked inside. The offenders then ransacked the second vehicle. The offenders then fled the scene Southbound down 3200 block alley of Wisconsin Ave./Maple Ave. Attempts to make contact with the owners of the vehicle were met with negative results. This investigation is ongoing.

Units responded to the 6800 block of 30th Place for a report of a burglary to motor vehicle that occurred sometime over night. 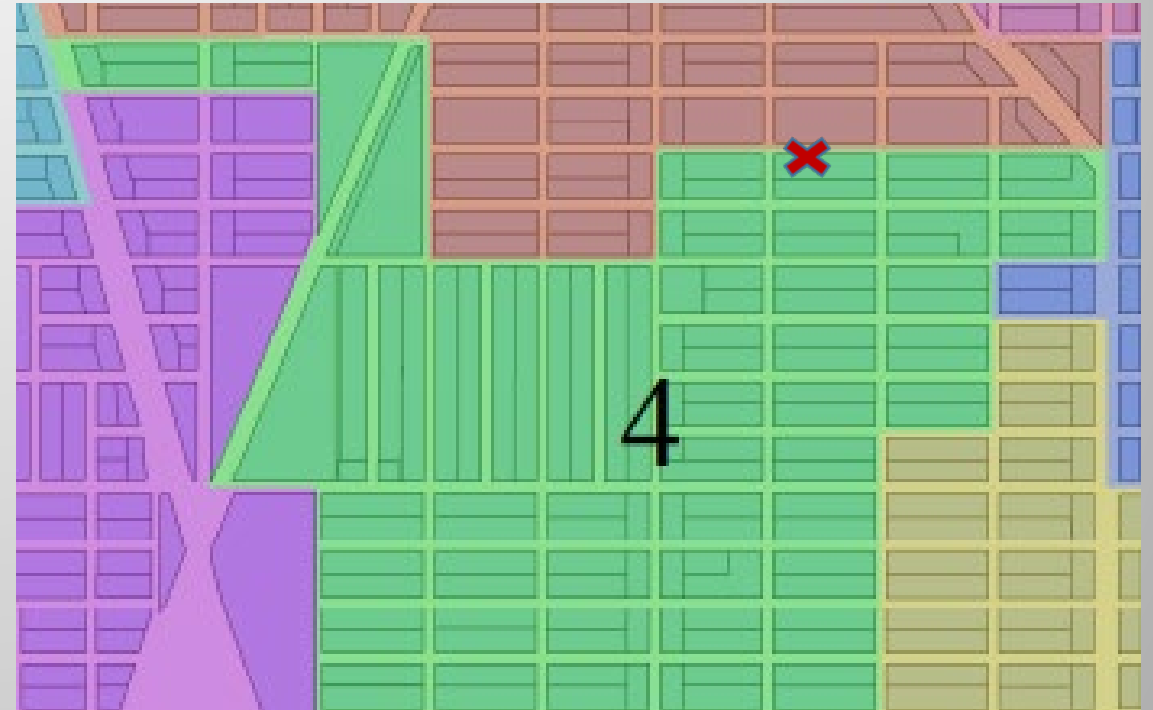

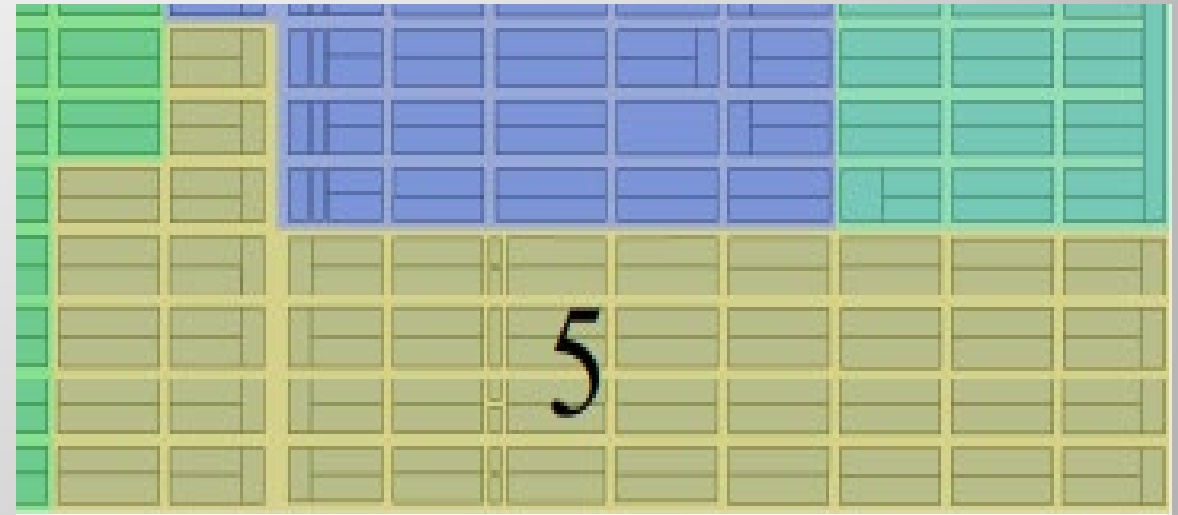

Criminal Damage to Property – 6/09/2024 **6400 block of 19th Street – 3:23a.m.**

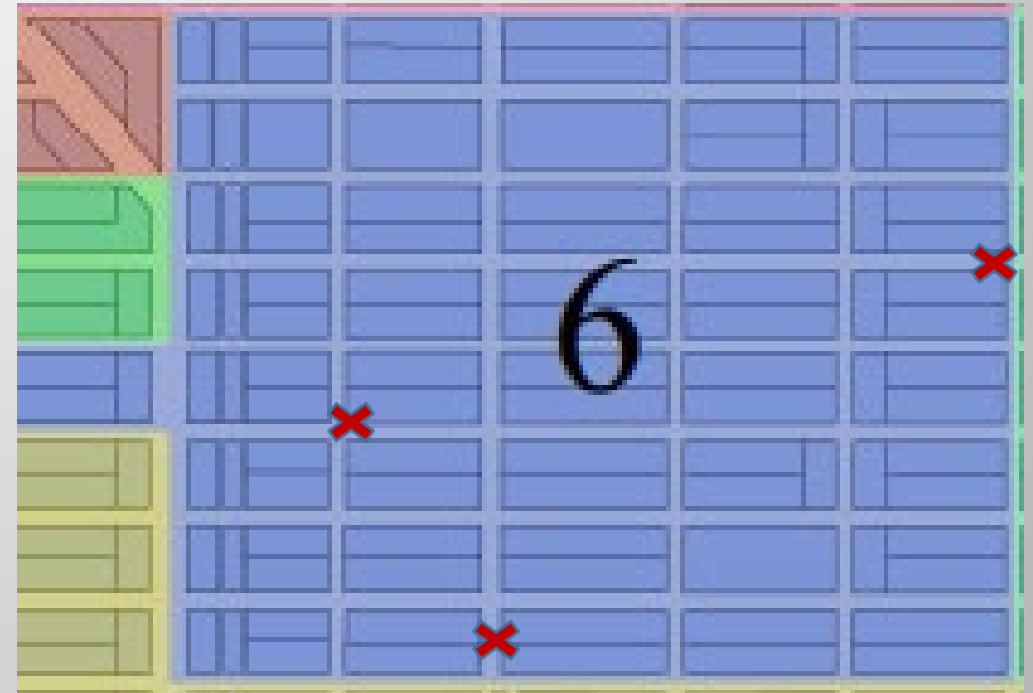

Reckless Discharge of a Firearm – 6/08/2024 **14th Street/Wisconsin Ave. –10:28a.m.**

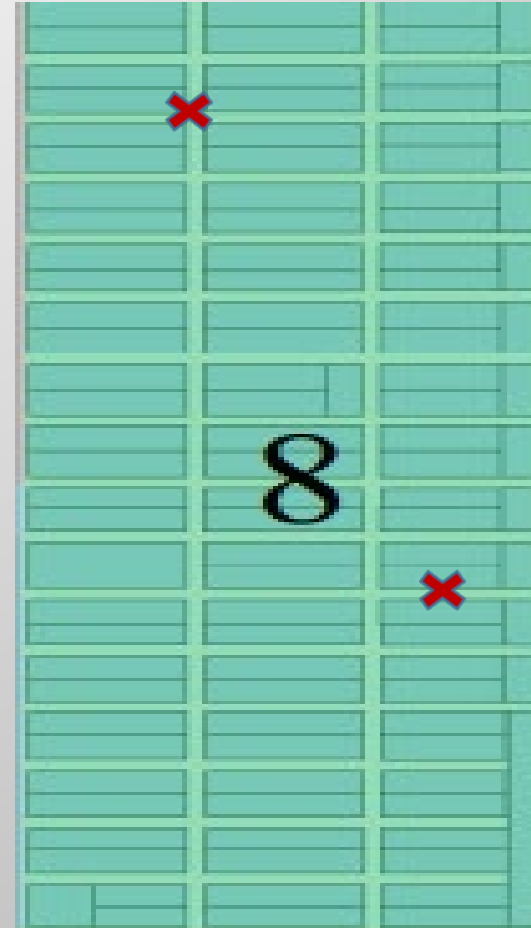
