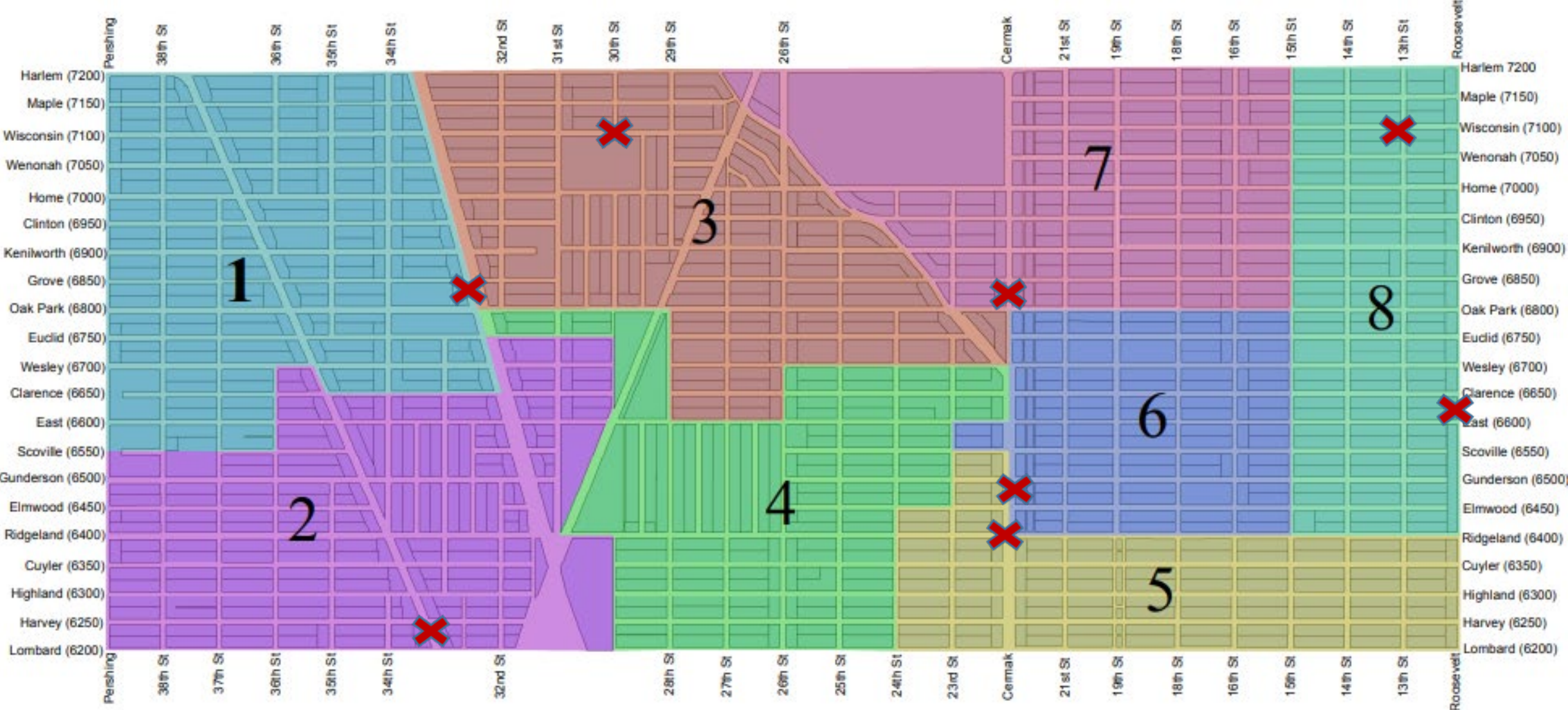

# SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 1<sup>ST</sup> WARD

FOR WEEK OF 3/09/2026

**Criminal Trespass to Real Property – 3/12/2026**  
**Aura Lounge (6814 Windsor Ave.) – 4:37 a.m.**

Officers responded to Aura Lounge in reference to a commercial alarm. Upon arrival, officers determined that the first set of doors to the business was unsecured, while the second set was secured. The business owner arrived on scene and provided officers with video surveillance footage of a subject forcing entry into the vestibule of Aura Night Club. Officers cleared the business, and the owner resecured the vestibule doors. This investigation is ongoing.

## **Burglary – 3/13/2026**

**Paisans Pizzeria (6226 Ogden Ave.) – 6:02 a.m.**

Officers responded to a call of suspicious subjects attempting to break into Paisans Pizzeria. Upon arrival, responding officers learned that the subjects forced entry through the front door into the restaurant. Officers met with employees who witnessed the incident and related that they observed approximately five (5) Male subjects, slim builds, dressed in all black, and wearing ski masks, force entry into the restaurant. Witnesses further related that the offenders entered one (1) white sedan and one (1) black sedan and fled the scene prior to officer arrival. Officers observed damage to several gaming machines inside of the establishment. This investigation is ongoing.

# SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 3<sup>RD</sup> WARD

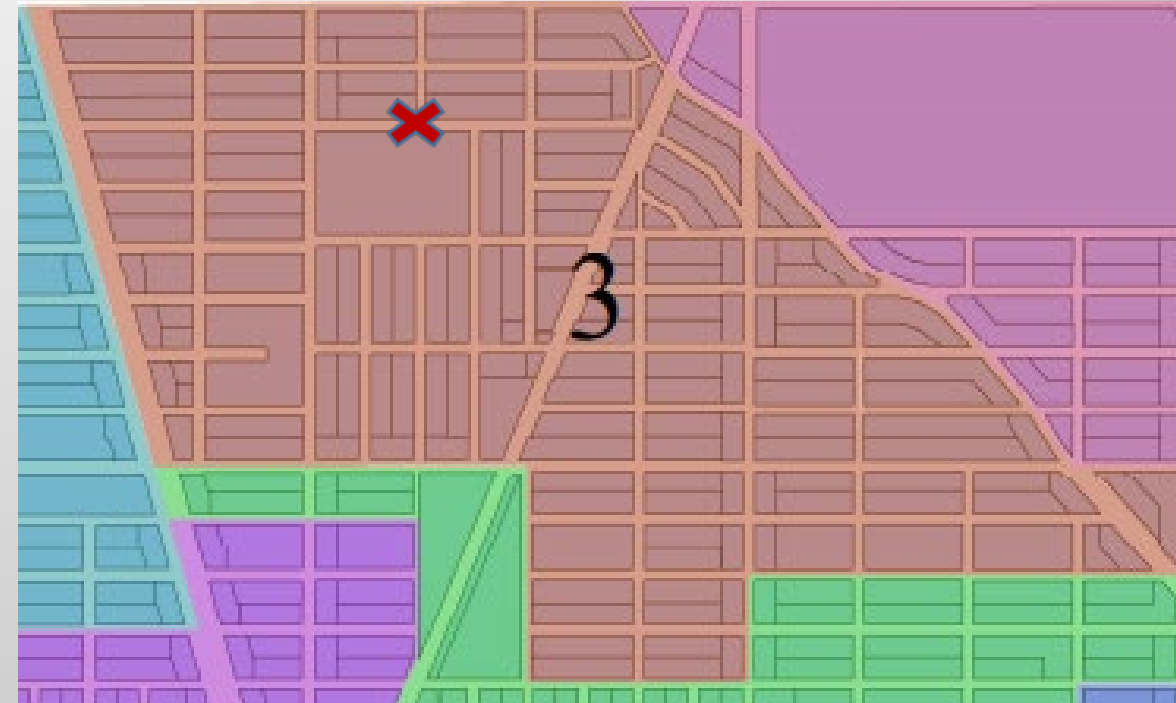

**Aggravated Battery to a Child <13 (x2) – 3/09/2026**  
**Proksa Park (3001 Wisconsin Ave.) – 6:36 p.m.**

While on patrol, officers were flagged down by a juvenile subject who stated an adult female subject was attempting to “jump” him and his friend. Officers observed one (1) Female Black subject chasing a second juvenile subject across the baseball fields. Said female subject was positively identified as the offender by the victims. One (1) of the juvenile victims also related that they had been pepper-sprayed by the offender. Officers subsequently placed said female subject in custody, at which time she struck one (1) of the officers multiple times. Officers recovered one (1) stun gun from the female offender’s person and one (1) canister of pepper spray from the creek in the park. The offender related that the incident stemmed from a dispute between her child and the two (2) victims. The offender was transported to the Berwyn Police Department and subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Resisting a Peace Officer, one (1) felony count of Criminal Damage to Government Supported Property, two (2) felony counts of Aggravated Battery to a Child <13, and one (1) felony count of Unlawful Possession of a Weapon. Case closed by arrest.

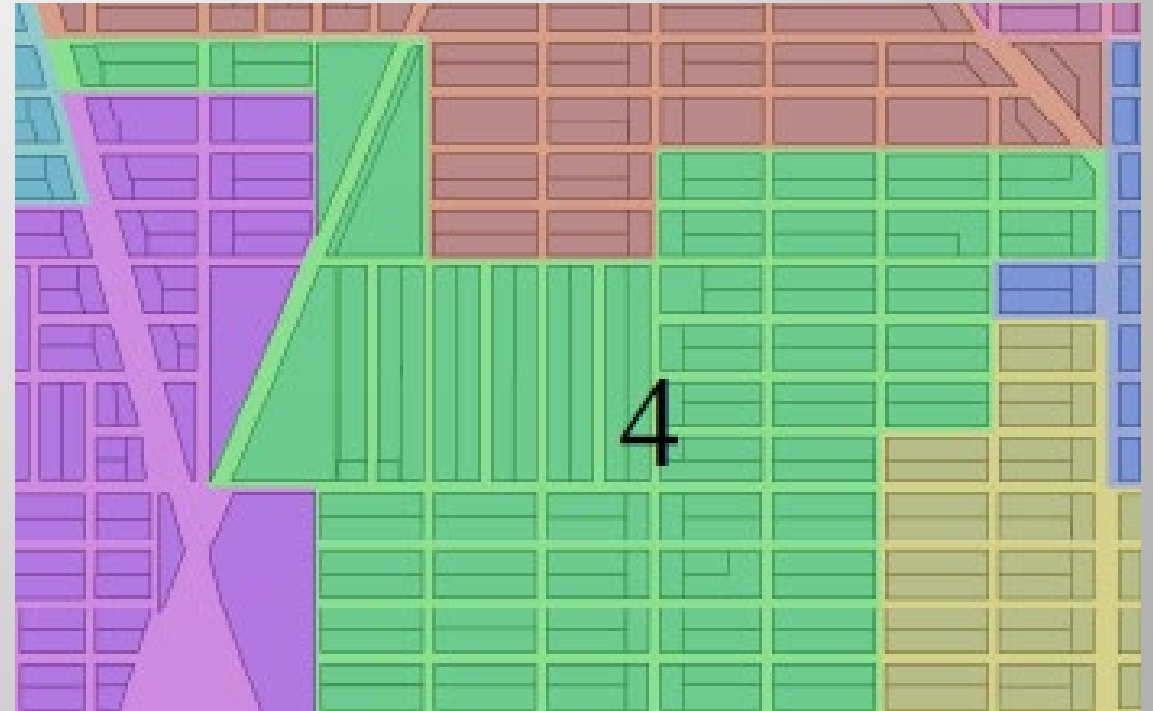

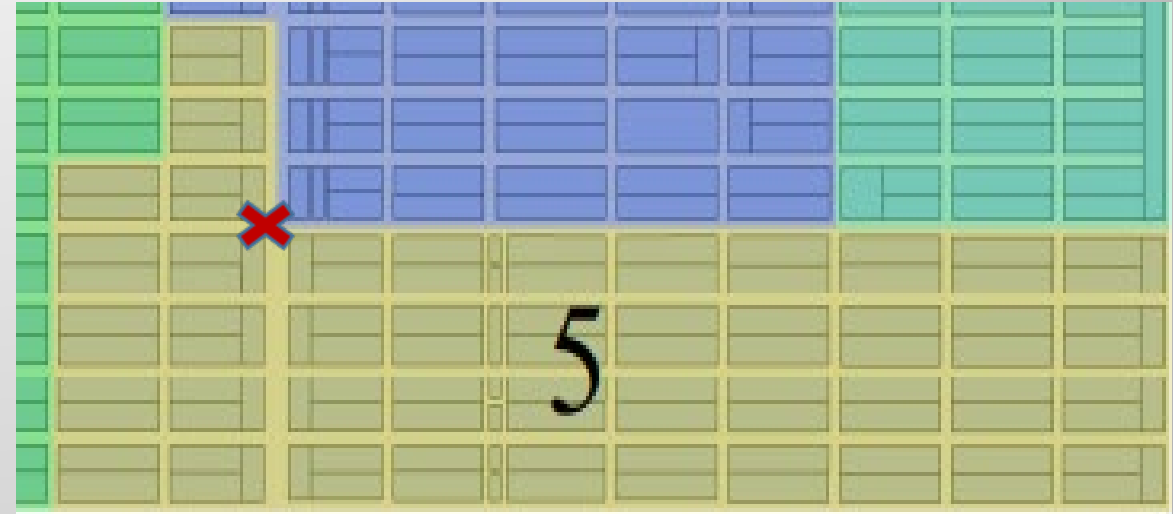

## **Aggravated Battery – 3/14/2026** **McDonald's (6401 Cermak Rd.) – 2:39 a.m.**

Officers responded to McDonald's for a report of an aggravated battery that occurred in the drive-through. Upon arrival, responding officers met with the male victim who related he was struck in the head several times by two (2) unknown Male Hispanics. The victim further related that his wife beeped the horn at the black sedan in front of them in the drive-through line, at which time two (2) unknown Hispanic Males exited said vehicle, and battered the victim. The offenders fled the scene prior to officer arrival. Officers observed a large gash on the victim's forehead. The victim was transported to a local area hospital for treatment. This investigation is ongoing.

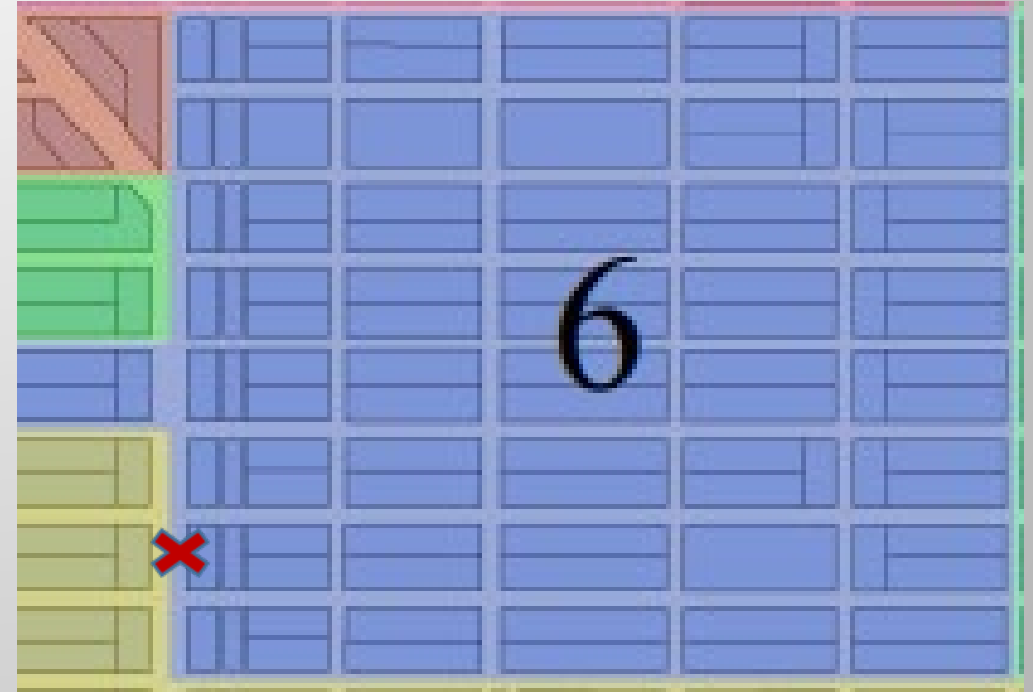

## **Disturbance/Aggravated Assault/Battery/Resisting a Peace Officer For Old Time's Sake Bar (6428 Cermak Rd.) – 3/15/2026 – 1:45 a.m.**

Officers responded to For Old Times Sake Bar for a report of a male subject that was causing a disturbance outside of the establishment. Upon arrival, responding officers made contact with the bar staff who related the male subject was escorted out of the bar after causing a disturbance and was now attempting to regain entry into the establishment and threatening to fight other patrons. The subject failed to comply with the officers' orders to leave the scene and became combative. Officers subsequently placed the subject under arrest. The offender resisted arrest and spat on officers while being taken into custody. The offender was transported to the Berwyn Police Department and charged accordingly. Case closed by arrest.

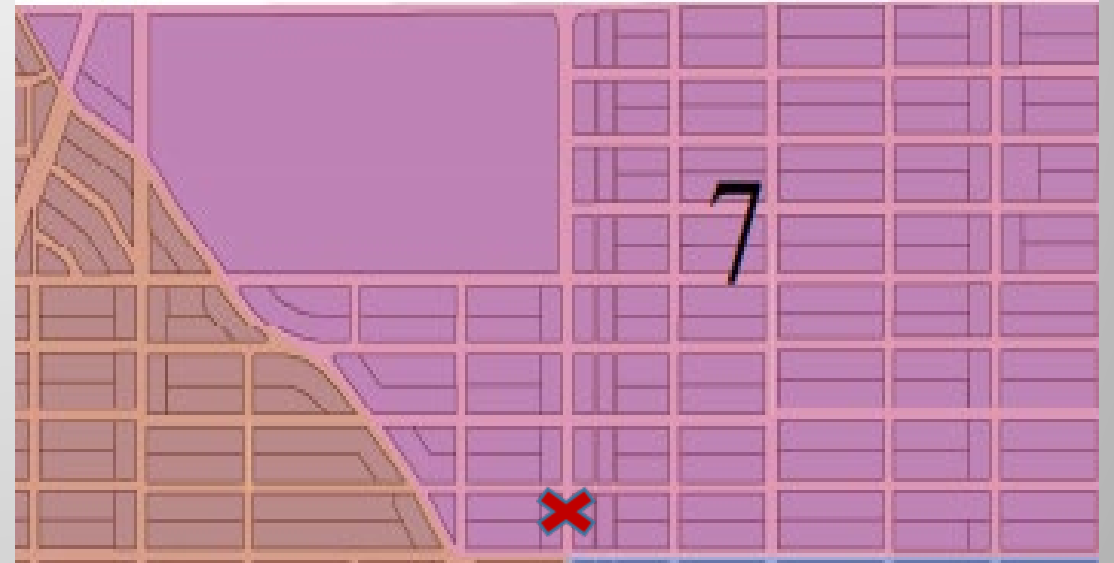
**Disturbance – 3/15/2026**

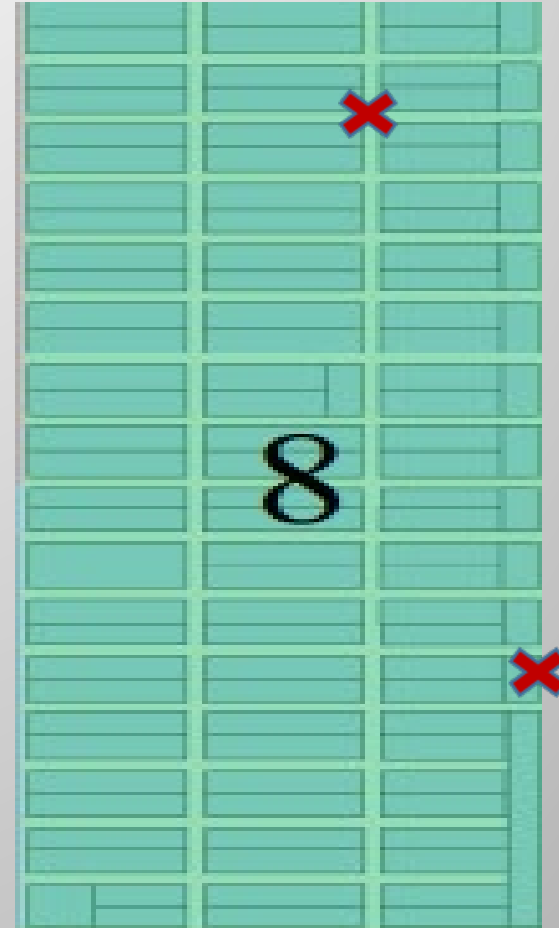
## **Battery – 3/14/2026**
