## **Criminal Damage to Property – 2/21/2026**

**6200 block of 26<sup>th</sup> St. – 1:24 p.m.**

Officers responded to the 6200 block of 26<sup>th</sup> Street for a report of Criminal Damage to Property. Upon arrival, responding officers met with the victim who related that they observed one (1) Male Black and one (1) Female Black pushing a shopping cart Westbound on 26<sup>th</sup> Street. The victim further related that they observed said subjects push the shopping cart into a glass door, which caused it to shatter. The subjects fled the scene prior to officer arrival. A check of the area revealed negative results for the offenders.

Note: After further investigation, officers determined the same offender was also responsible for two (2) additional Criminal Damage to Property incidents on 2/21/26. Said offender was taken into custody at 2:28 p.m. and charged accordingly.

# SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 5<sup>TH</sup> WARD



## Aggravated Unlawful Possession of a Firearm – 2/21/2026 6200 block of Roosevelt Rd. – 6:08 p.m.

Officers conducted a traffic stop near the 6200 block of Roosevelt Rd. During the stop, officers detained both female occupants while a search of the vehicle was conducted. Officers recovered one (1) loaded firearm and two (2) plastic bags containing a green leafy substance (suspect Cannabis) with a total weight of 15 grams from inside the vehicle. One (1) subject (passenger) was released without charges. A check in LEADS revealed that the driver possessed a valid FOID but did not have a CCL. The driver was taken into custody, transported to the Berwyn Police Department, and charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Unlawful Possession of a Weapon. Case closed by arrest.

## **Criminal Damage to Property – 2/21/2026**

**6500 block of Cermak Rd. – 1:44 p.m.**

Officers responded to the 6500 block of Cermak Rd. for a call of a broken glass entry door. Responding officers met with the reporting party who related they observed an unknown Male Black subject wearing all white clothing walk towards said door and shortly after they heard a loud noise of glass crashing. The witness further related that said male subject was last seen fleeing Westbound on foot.

Note: After further investigation, officers determined the same offender was also responsible for two (2) additional Criminal Damage to Property incidents on 2/21/26. Said offender was taken into custody at 2:28 p.m. and charged accordingly.


## **Criminal Damage to Property – 2/21/2026**

**Lilly's Slots (6512 Cermak Rd.) – 2:28 p.m.**

Officers responded to Lilly's Slots for a call of a male subject who broke the business window. Responding officers located a male subject matching the given description and attempted to make contact, however, the subject fled Westbound on foot. Following a short foot pursuit, officers successfully placed the male subject in custody without incident. Said subject was positively identified by a witness and transported to the Berwyn Police Department for processing. After further investigation, officers determined the offender was also responsible for two (2) additional Criminal Damage to Property incidents that occurred earlier that same day. The offender was subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Criminal Damage to Property > \$500. Case closed by arrest.
