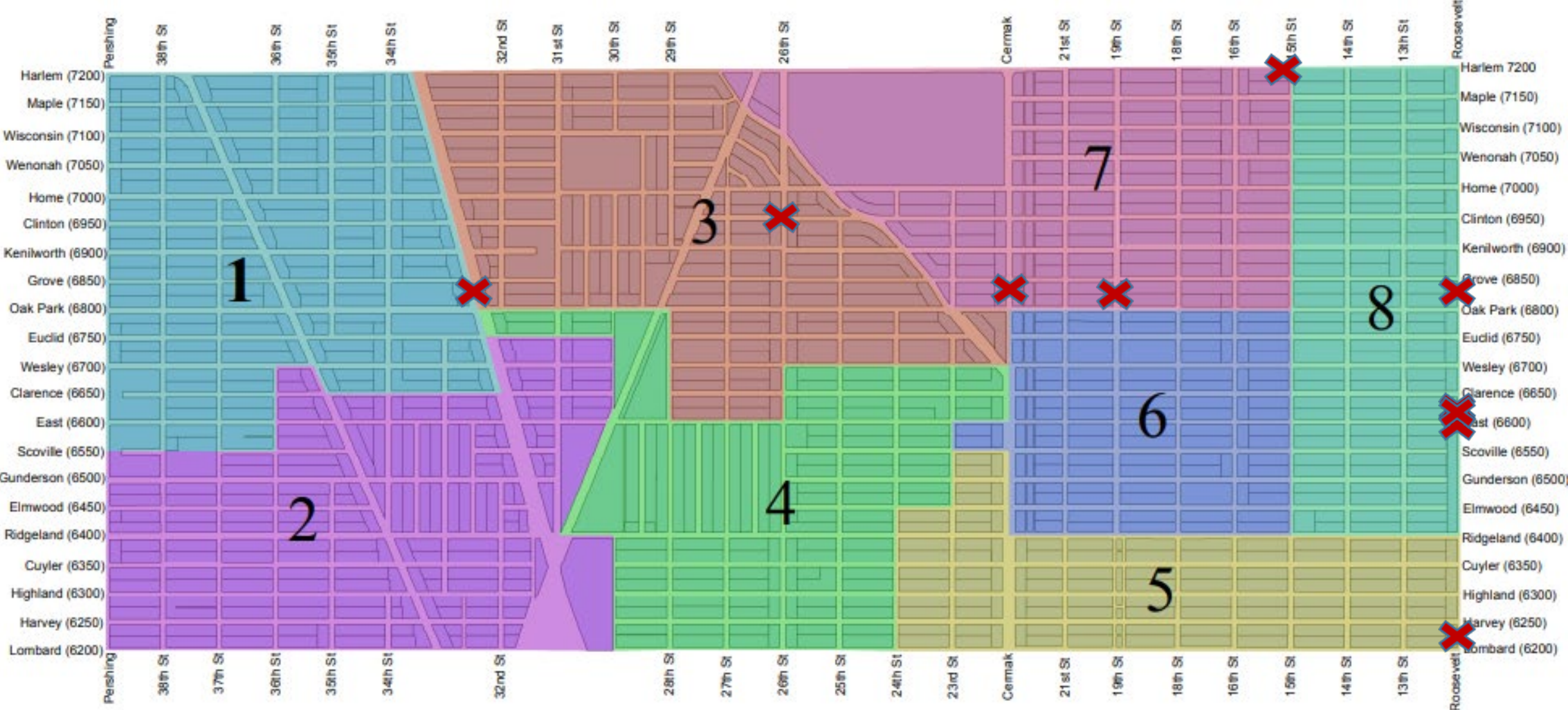

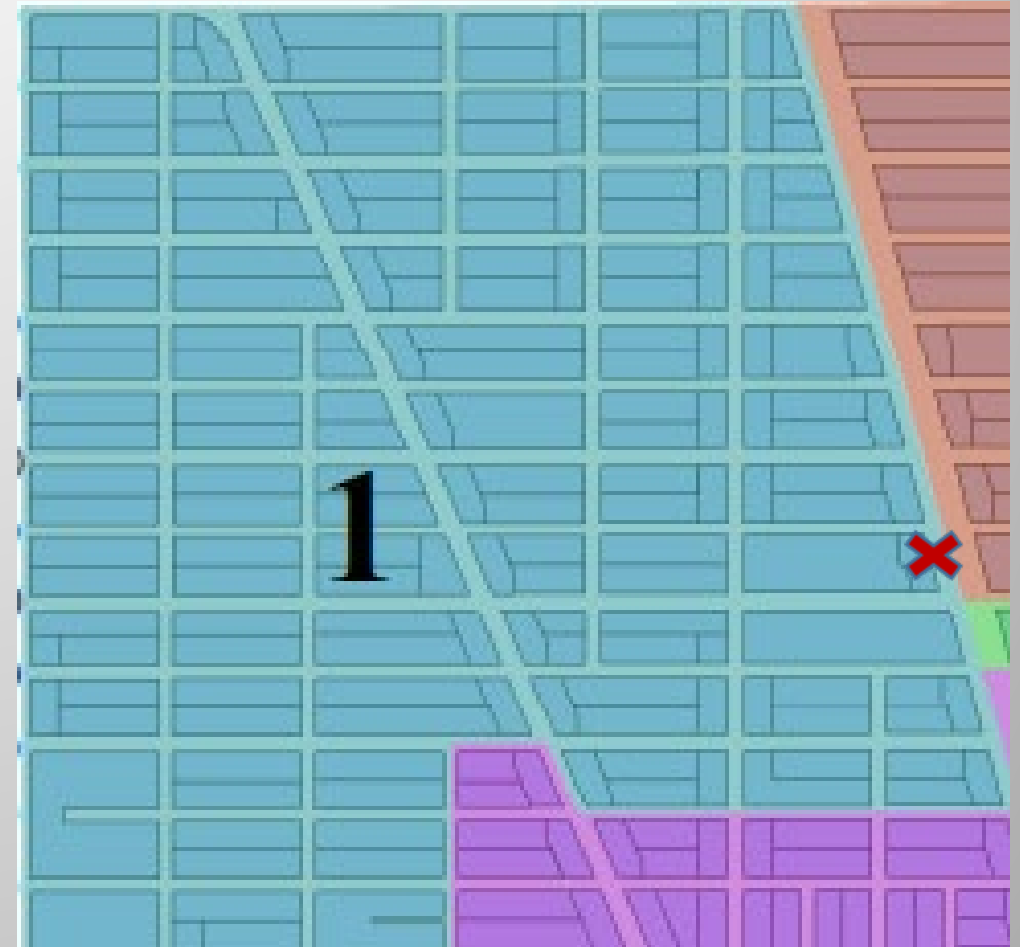
Recovered Firearm – 3/28/2026

Officers responded to Aura Lounge for a report of a male subject who attempted to enter the establishment with a firearm. Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon – 3/24/2026 **6800 block of 26th St. – 3:44 p.m.**

Officers responded to 26th St./Clinton Ave. for a report of a road rage incident, which involved a person with a knife. Responding officers met with the female victim, who related that a male subject who was driving another vehicle became upset with her near the area of 26th St./Oak Park Ave. The victim further related that the male driver followed her to the area of 26th St./Clinton Ave., where he exited his vehicle and approached the driver's side of her vehicle, where she was seated. The victim stated that the male subject was enraged and shouted several obscenities at her while holding a knife. Officers also met with the offender, who admitted to approaching the victim's vehicle with the knife in hand. Officers recovered said knife and placed the male subject in custody. The offender was transported to the Berwyn Police Department and charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon. Case closed by arrest.

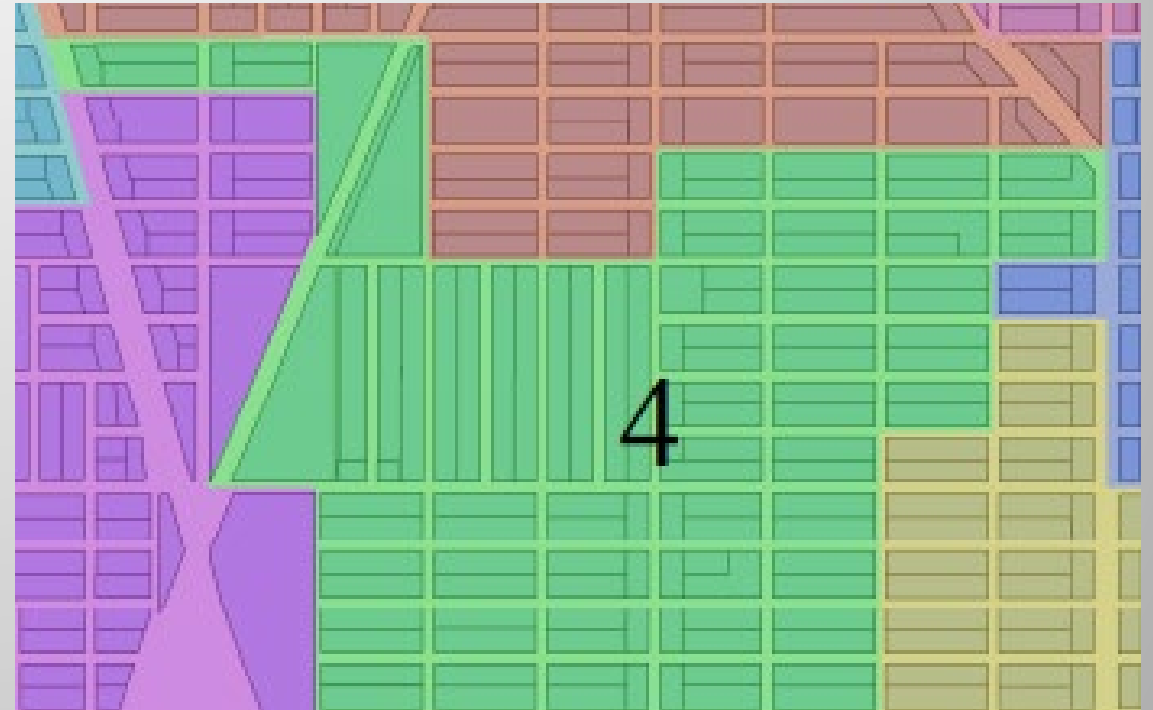

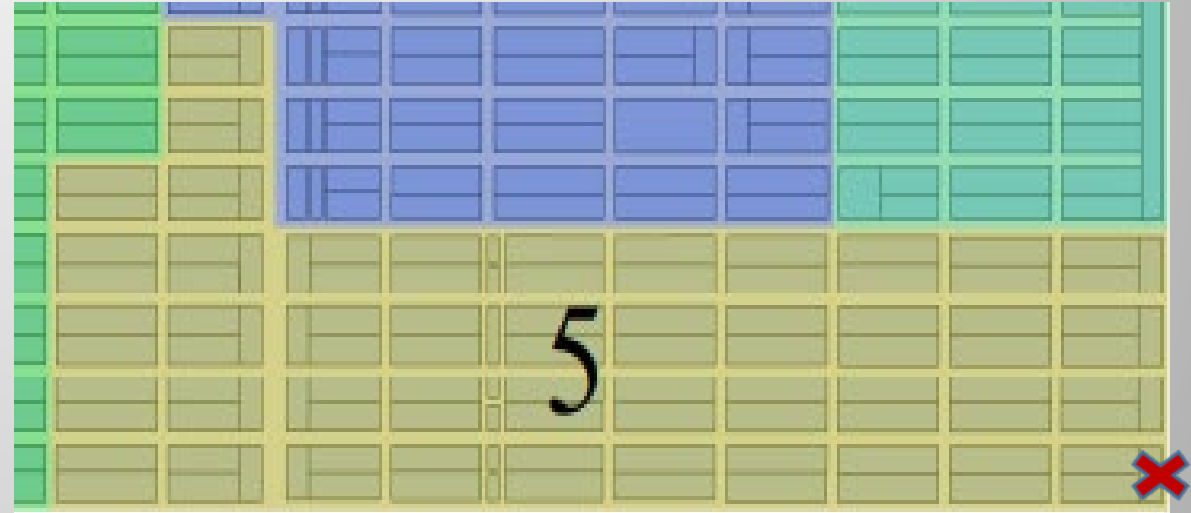
Loud Noise Complaint– 3/28/2026

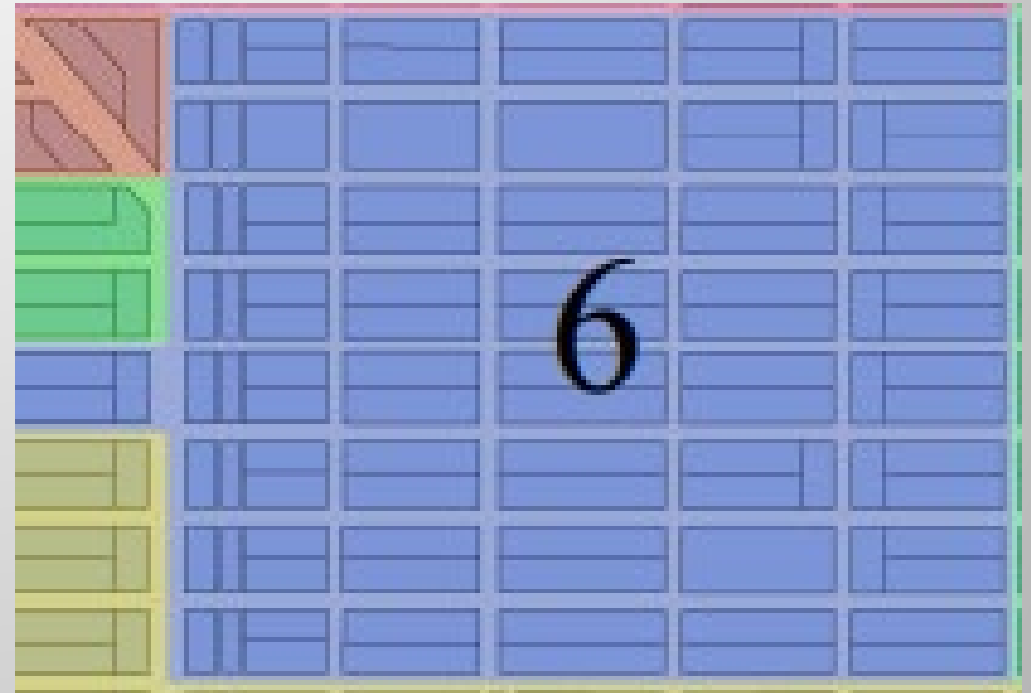

Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer/Aggravated DUI – 3/26/2026 **1500 block of Harlem Ave. – 12:46 a.m.**

Berwyn Police conducted a traffic stop on the 1500 block of Harlem Ave. During the course of the traffic stop, the male driver was placed in custody for DUI and transported to the Berwyn Police Department for processing. While in custody, the male subject battered a booking officer. The subject was subsequently charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer and one (1) felony count of Aggravated DUI. Case closed by arrest.

Disturbance – 3/29/2026 **16th Street Liquors (6808 16th St.) – 2:48 a.m.**

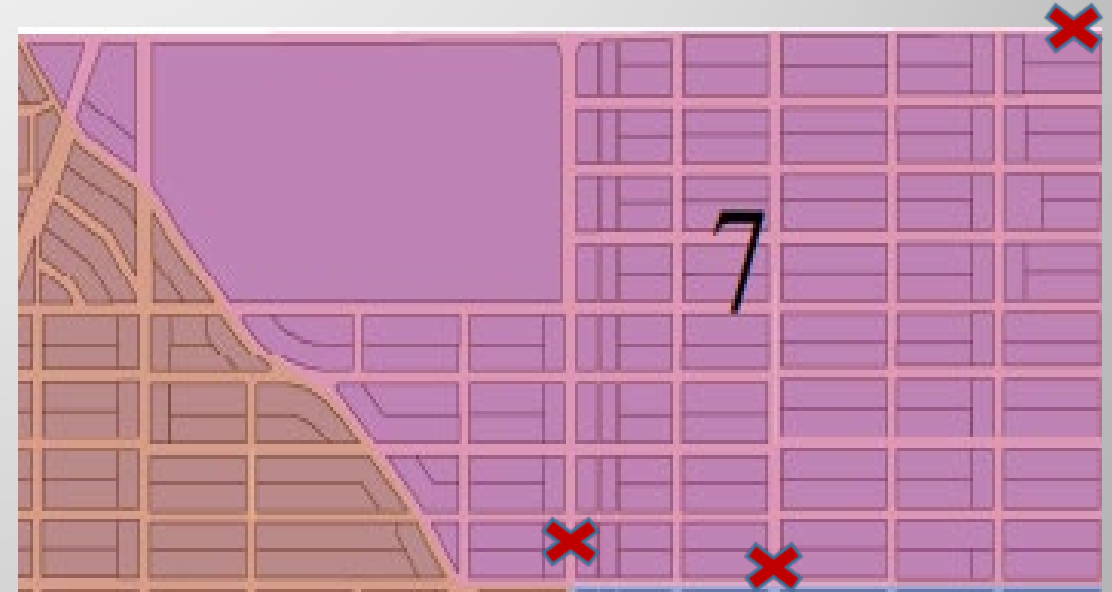
Officers responded to 16th Street Liquors for a report of a disturbance. Upon arrival, responding officers did not observe any active disturbance. Officers met with the bar manager, who related that a fight ensued amongst a group of patrons, at which time the involved parties were escorted outside of the establishment by the manager. All involved parties left the scene prior to officer arrival. Nothing further at this time.

Disturbance – 3/28/2026

Officers responded to Monse's Tapas Bar for a report of a disturbance inside the establishment. Upon arrival, responding officers did not observe any signs of an active fight on scene. Officers met with the restaurant manager, who stated that two (2) patrons were involved in a dispute and left the scene prior to officer arrival. Nothing further at this time.

Officers responded to Distro Music Hall for a report of four (4) female subjects fighting outside of the establishment. Upon arrival, responding officers did not observe any signs of an active disturbance. Officers met with one (1) female victim who related that she was struck in the face by an unknown female subject following a verbal altercation. The victim did not have any visible signs of injury and refused medical treatment. Officers met with the manager, who related that the said females were escorted out of the establishment, at which time one (1) of the subjects left the scene prior to officer arrival. The victim further related that she wished to sign a complaint against the offender. This investigation is ongoing.

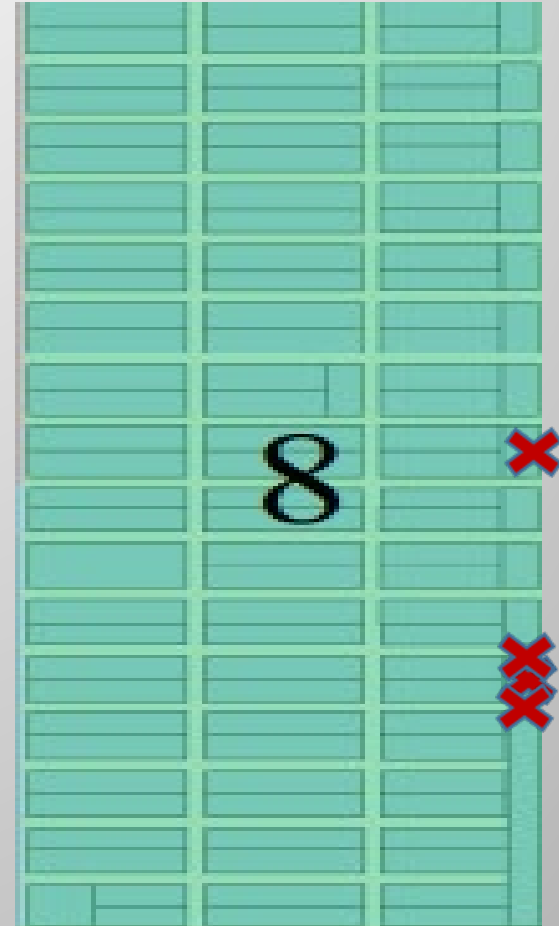
Aggravated Battery – 3/29/2026

Police Officers were dispatched to the 1200 block of East Ave. for a call of two (2) male victims that were battered by an unknown subject. Upon arrival, responding officers met with the victims who related that they observed an unknown Male Hispanic subject in their backyard. The victims further related that after a verbal altercation, said subject left the property, but returned accompanied by another Male Hispanic. A physical fight ensued, and one (1) of the offenders struck one (1) of the victims in the head with a brick. Both offenders fled the scene prior to officer arrival. One (1) of the victims was transported to a local area hospital for treatment. This investigation is ongoing.

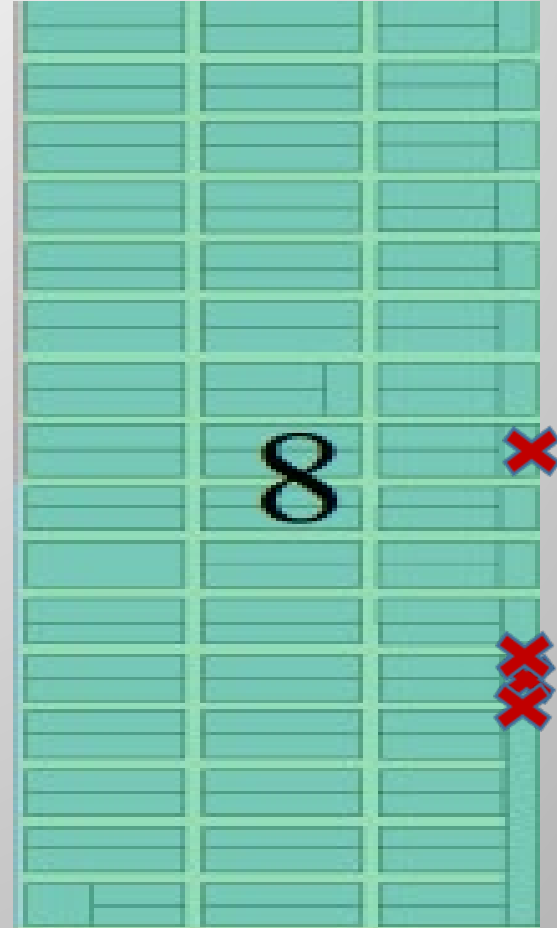
Burglary – 3/28/2026
