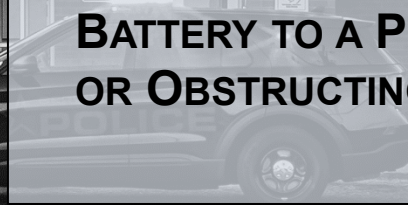

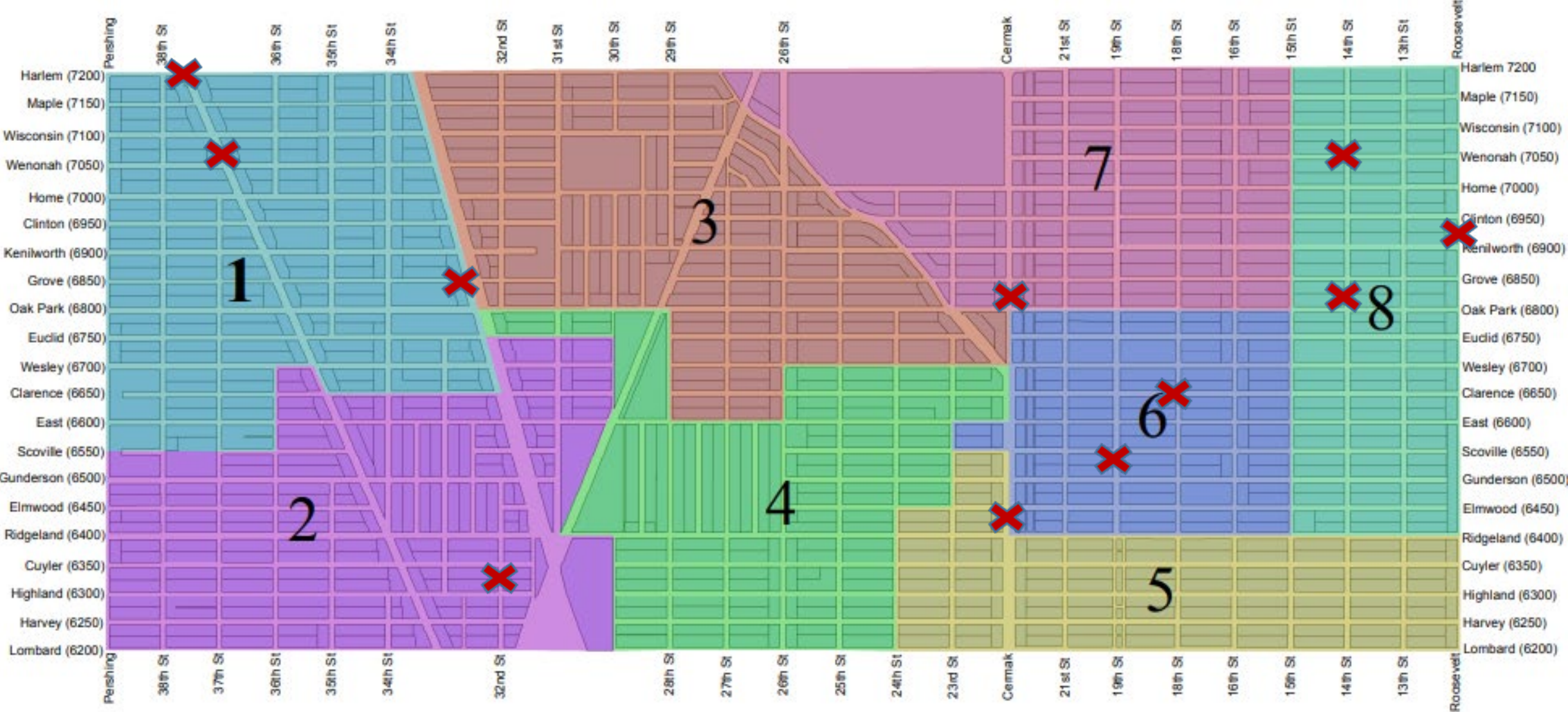

# SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 1<sup>ST</sup> WARD

FOR WEEK OF 4/06/2026

## **Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer Aggravated Assault (x2) – 4/10/2026 McDonald's (7031 W. Ogden Ave.) – 2:39 p.m.**

Officers responded to McDonald's for a report of a Male Black subject who was threatening staff with a knife. Upon arrival, responding officers located said subject near Home Ave./Ogden Ave. Officers made contact with said subject who then threw a knife into the street and began to flee on foot. Officers successfully caught up to the subject and placed him in custody. The offender actively resisted the arrest and struck the officer several times. Officers recovered one (1) knife from the scene. Upon meeting with the restaurant manager, officers learned that the offender had threatened the staff with a knife after being asked to leave the establishment. A positive show-up was conducted with two (2) of the victims, and the offender was then transported to the Berwyn Police Department for further investigation. The offender was charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer and two (2) felony counts of Aggravated Assault. Case closed by arrest.

## **Street Takeover/Reckless Driving – 4/12/2026 Harlem Ave./Ogden Ave. – 2:40 a.m.**

While on patrol near the area of Harlem Ave./Ogden Ave., a Berwyn Police Officer observed multiple vehicles doing "donuts" in the intersection with approximately 50-100 subjects gathered around watching said vehicles. Additional units arrived on scene and the crowd was dispersed without incident. All of the involved vehicles fled the scene Eastbound on Ogden Ave. Nothing further at this time.

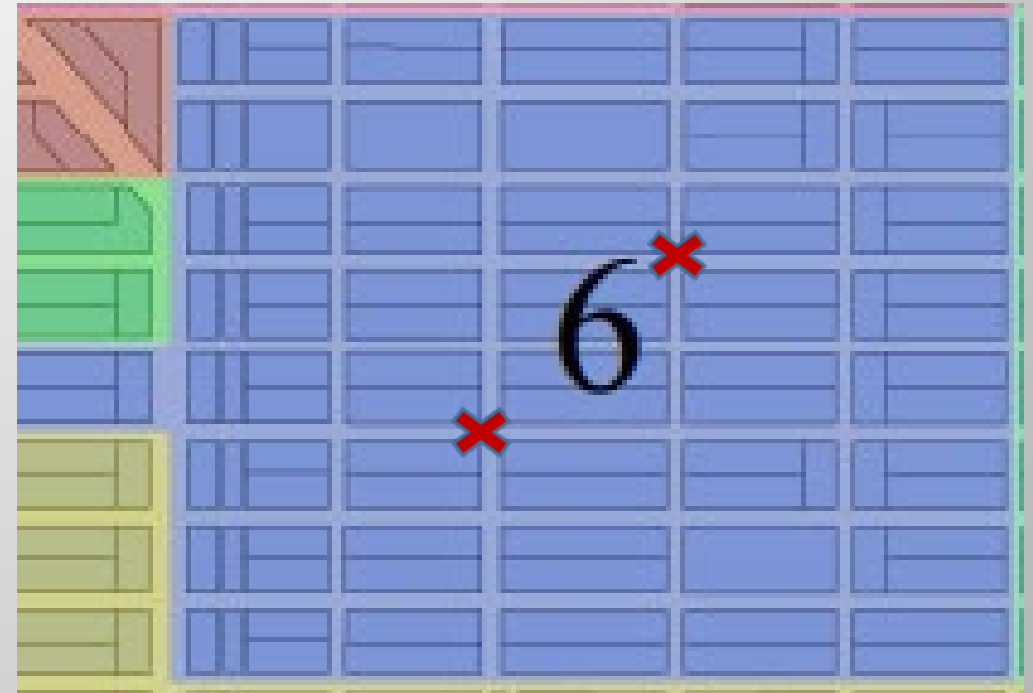
## **Shots Fired – 4/12/2026**

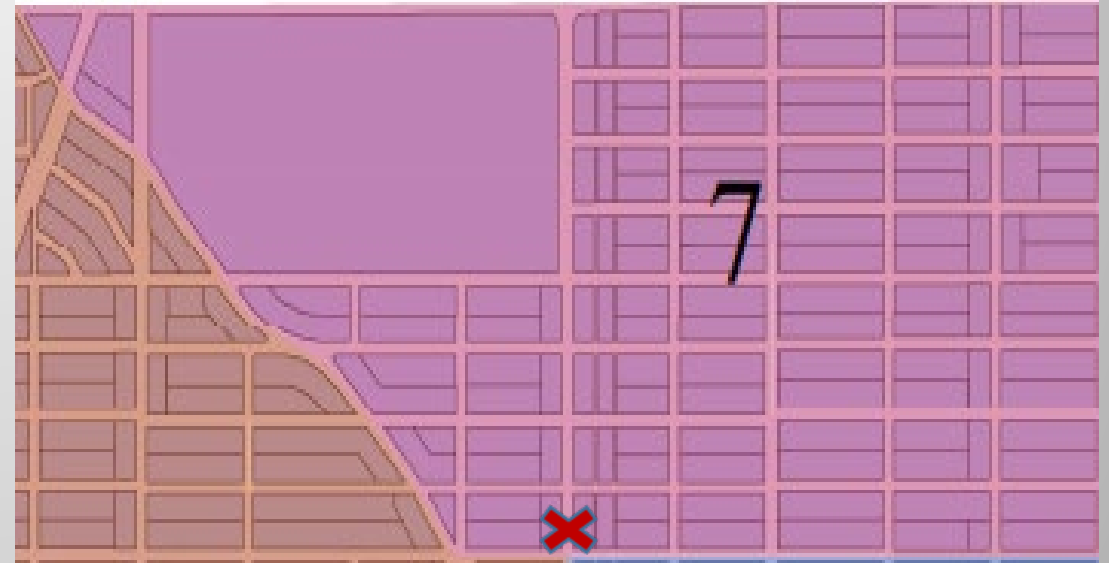
## **Battery– 4/06/2026**

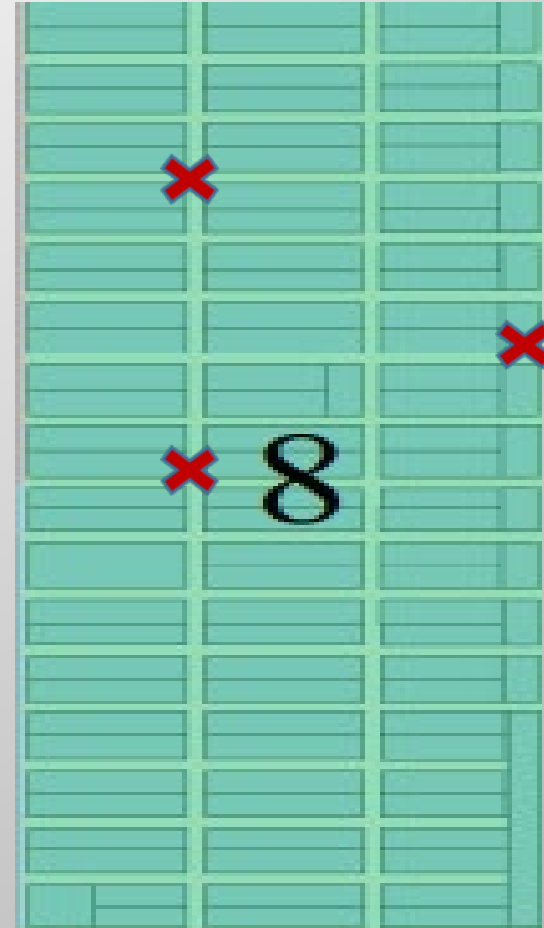
## **Disturbance – 4/11/2026**
