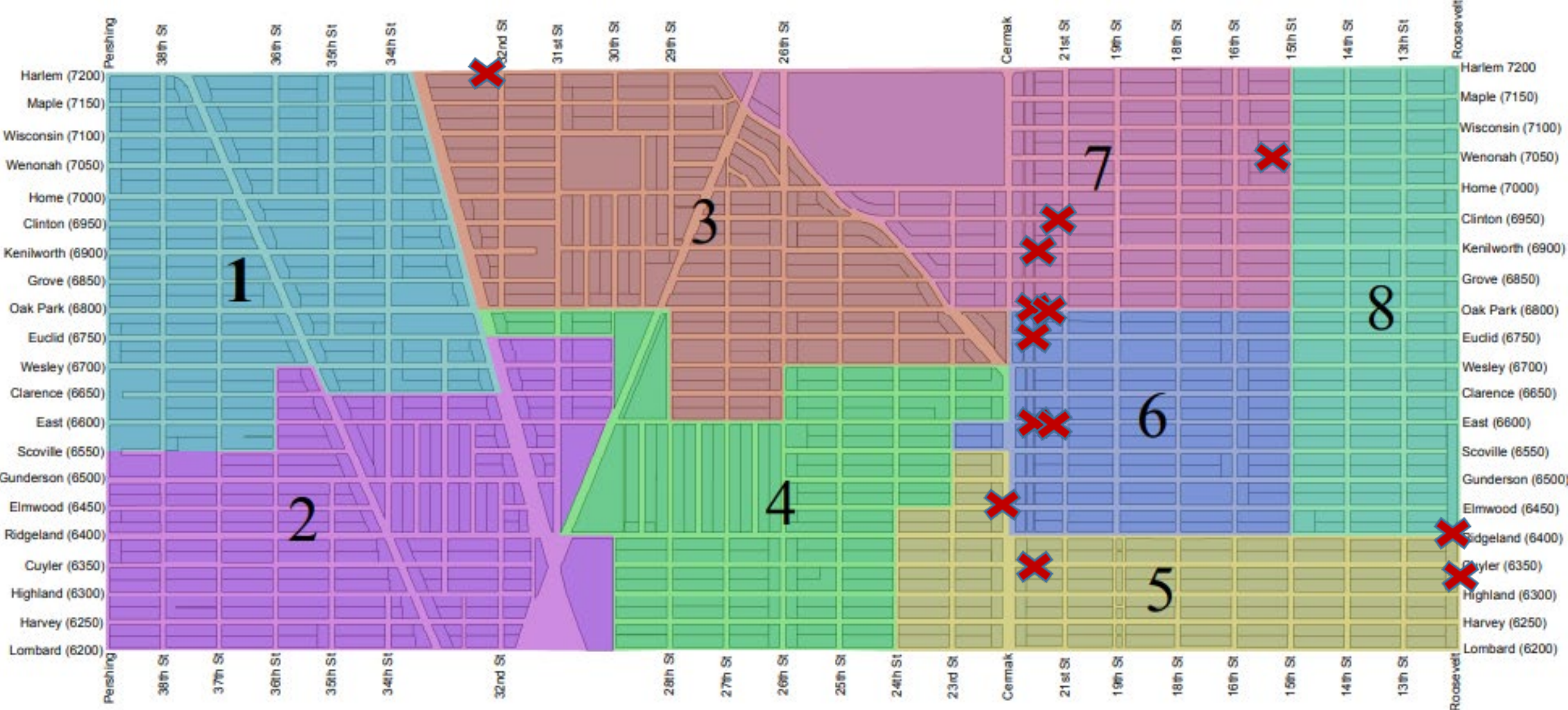

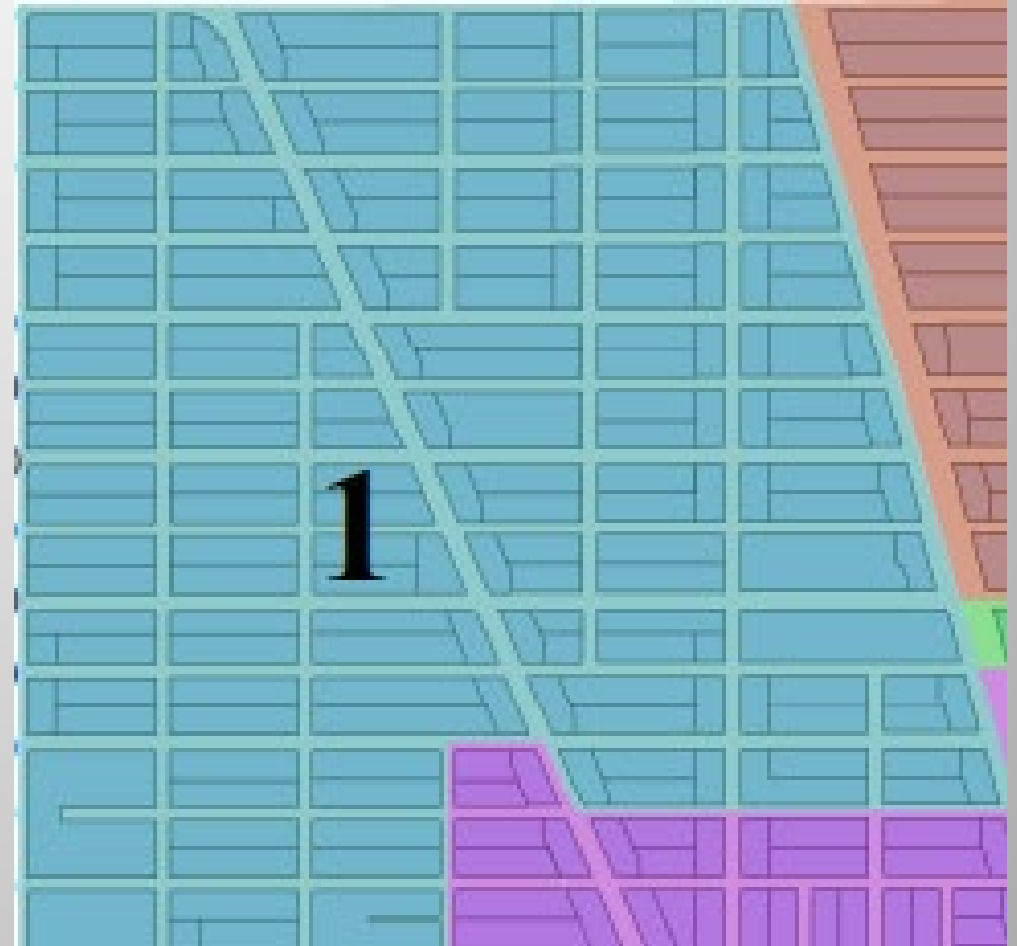

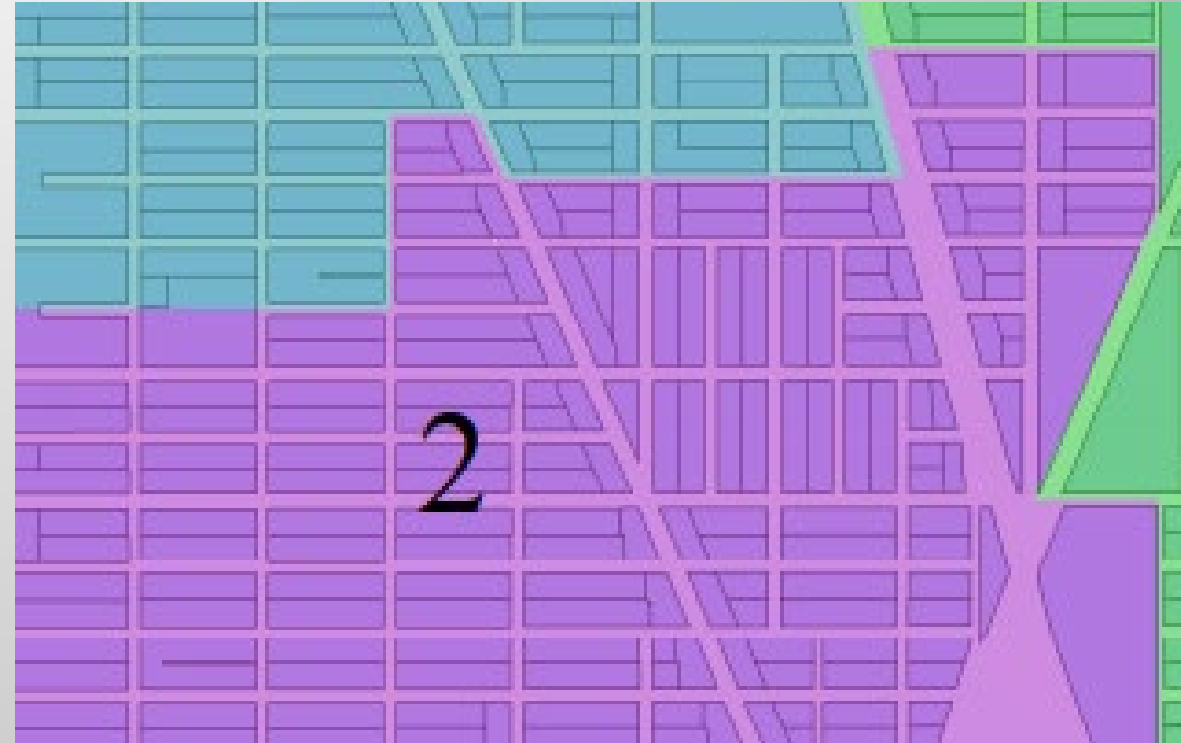

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 3RD WARD

Disturbance/Street Takeover – 4/18/2026

Taquito del Oro (3205 Harlem Ave.) – 7:53 p.m.

Berwyn Dispatch received multiple calls for loud noise coming from cars revving their engines in the parking lot at Taquito del Oro. Upon arrival, responding Tactical Detectives conducted surveillance on the area at which time they observed approximately 50-60 vehicles in and around the parking lot. During the surveillance, officers observed one (1) male subject directing vehicles in and out of the parking lot. Said subject was later identified and admitted to being one of the organizers of the event. Officers also observed several vehicles playing excessively loud music, revving their engines, and leaving at high rates of speed in all directions from the establishment. Officers entered the establishment and met with the owner and event organizer. Both subjects were subsequently issued Local Ordinance citations. Nothing further at this time.

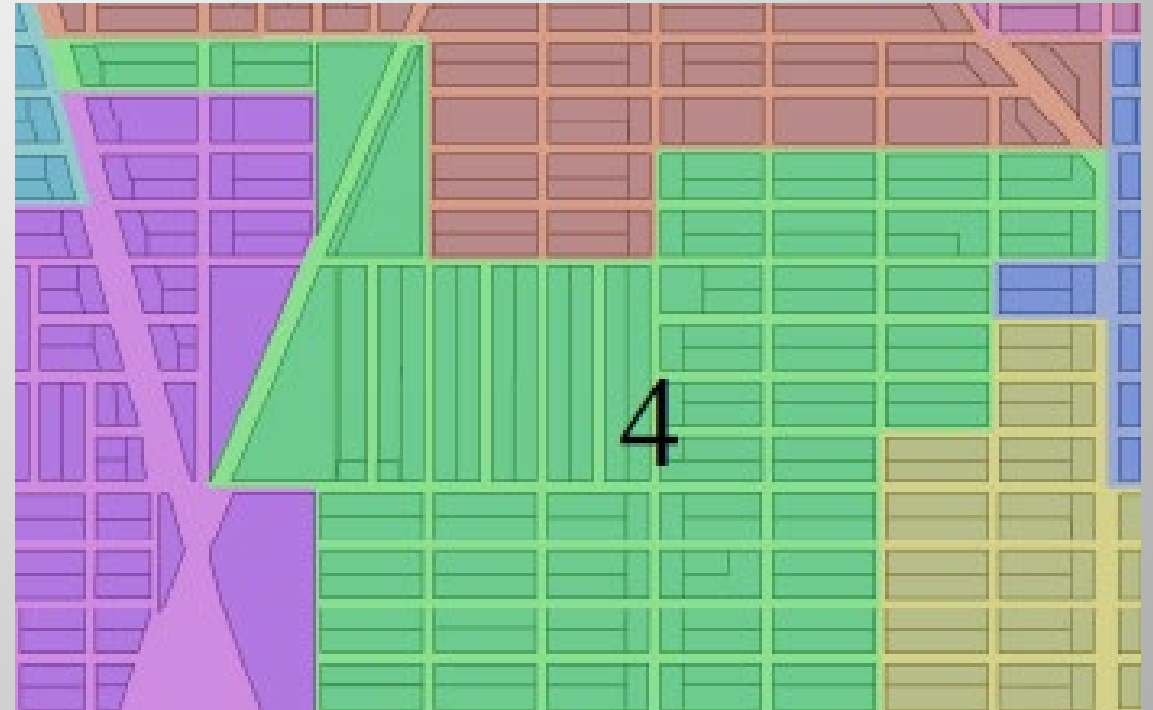

Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 4/17/2026 **Cuyler Ave./Vacin – 7:45 a.m.**

While on patrol, a Berwyn Police Officer observed a Honda vehicle parked near Cuyler Ave./Vacin with its front driver's side window broken out and airbag missing. Officers made contact with the owner of the vehicle, who indicated they wished to sign a complaint. This investigation is ongoing.

Battery – 4/17/2026 **Mike's Place Sports Bar & Grill (6319 Roosevelt Rd.) – 10:50 p.m.**

Officers responded to a report of a disturbance at Mike's Place Sports Bar and Grill. Upon arrival, officers met with bar security, who related that they escorted two (2) female subjects out of the establishment after they deployed pepper spray on the bartender (victim). The two (2) female subjects then stomped on the hood of the victim's vehicle and damaged the windows. The offenders fled the scene prior to officer arrival. The victim refused medical treatment. This investigation is ongoing.

Aggravated Unlawful Use of a Weapon/Aggravated Assault – 4/18/2026 **Cermak Rd./Elmwood Ave. – 3:09 a.m.**

While on patrol in the area of Elmwood Ave./Cermak Rd. an officer was flagged down by victims in reference to a subject with a gun. The victims related that a Male Hispanic subject in a black in color SUV, approached them as they were leaving Jardin Restaurant, and brandished a firearm. The offender then fled the scene Southbound on Ridgeland Ave. from Cermak Rd. prior to officer arrival. Officers recovered one (1) live round from the ground where the offender's vehicle was previously parked. Officers conducted a check of the area and located an SUV, matching the description of the offending vehicle, that crashed into a garage on the 2400 block of Scoville Ave. Said vehicle was positively identified by the victims as the offending vehicle. The victims described the offender as Male Hispanic, 6' tall, 20-30 years old, with short, curly hair, wearing black pants, black button up shirt, and black boots. Pursuant to further investigation, the offender was taken into custody on 4/25/2026 and subsequently charged accordingly. Case closed by arrest.

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 6TH WARD

Battery – 4/17/2026 East Ave./Vacin – 1:24p.m.

Officers responded to East Ave./Vacin for a report of a fight. Upon arrival, responding officers separated the involved parties. Officers ascertained that the fight stemmed from a road rage incident between the driver of a vehicle and two (2) pedestrians. Officers met with one (1) witness who stated the male subject (pedestrian) struck the female subject (driver) first. Said male subject was placed in custody and subsequently charged accordingly. Medical refusals were signed by all involved parties. Nothing further at this time.

Burglary to Motor Vehicle x3 – 4/17/2026 Euclid Ave./Vacin – 7:34 a.m.

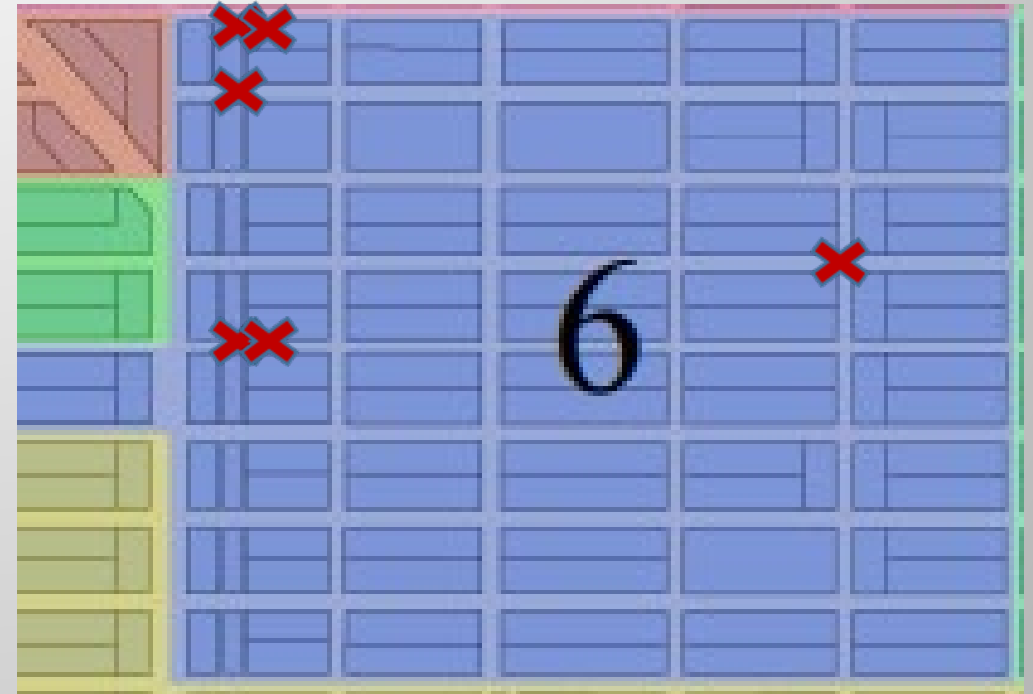
Berwyn Police responded to the Euclid Ave./Vacin for a report of two (2) vehicles with broken windows. Upon arrival, the responding officer met with the victims who related at approximately 7:30 a.m., they discovered their family's three (3) vehicles, all Hondas, with broken windows and the driver's side airbags missing. The victims further related that all three (3) vehicles were parked in the vacin and that they believed the burglaries occurred sometime overnight. This investigation is ongoing.

Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 4/17/2026 **Oak Park Ave./Vacin – 8:20 a.m.**

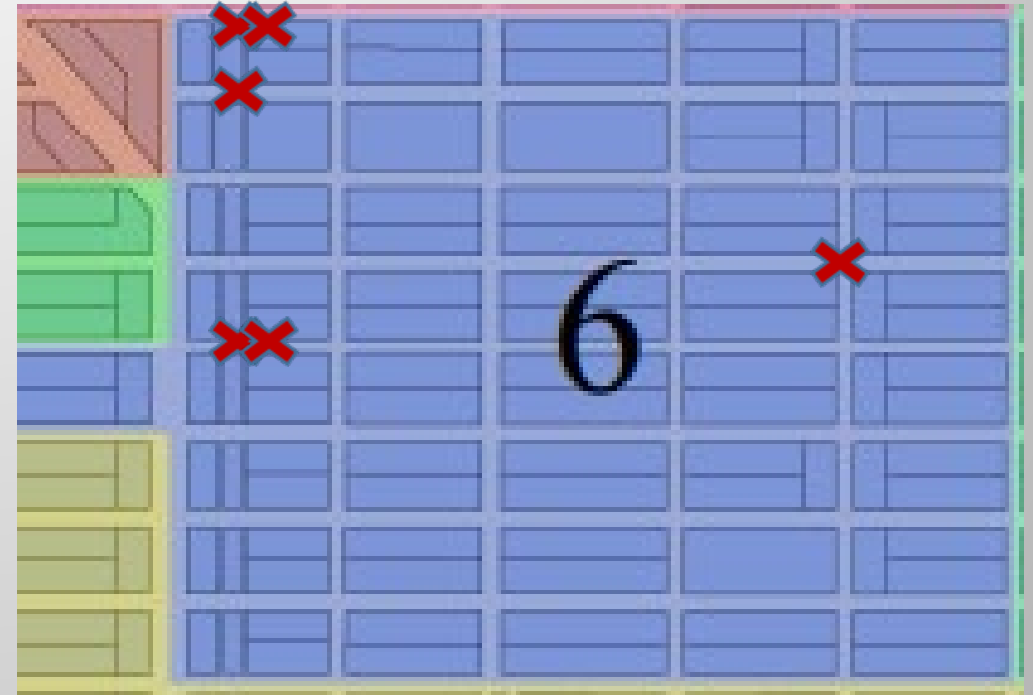

Battery (JUVENILE) – 4/12/2026

Jefferson Park (1537 Wenonah Ave.) – 5:00 p.m.

Officers took a delayed report on 4/13/2026 for a juvenile incident that occurred at Jefferson Park on 4/12/2026. Officers met with the juvenile victim and his mother, who related that the male juvenile was in Jefferson Park when two (2) female juveniles approached him and stated, “Get on your knees and say sorry.” The victim further related that he refused and ran away, at which time the female subjects displayed gel blaster guns (a.k.a. “Orby” guns) and fired several shots at the victim. The victim advised officers that both female offenders attended the same school as him. The victim’s mother related that the reason for the delayed report was due to her son (victim) not informing her of the incident when it occurred. The victim’s mother also refused medical treatment for her son’s injuries. The victim’s mother stated she did not wish to pursue criminal complaints. Nothing further at this time.

Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 4/17/2026

Officers responded to the 2100 block of Clinton Ave. for a report of a Burglary to Motor Vehicle. Upon arrival, officers met with the victim (vehicle owner) who related they discovered the front passenger’s side window broken and airbag missing from their vehicle (Honda). The victim signed a complaint refusal. Nothing further at this time.

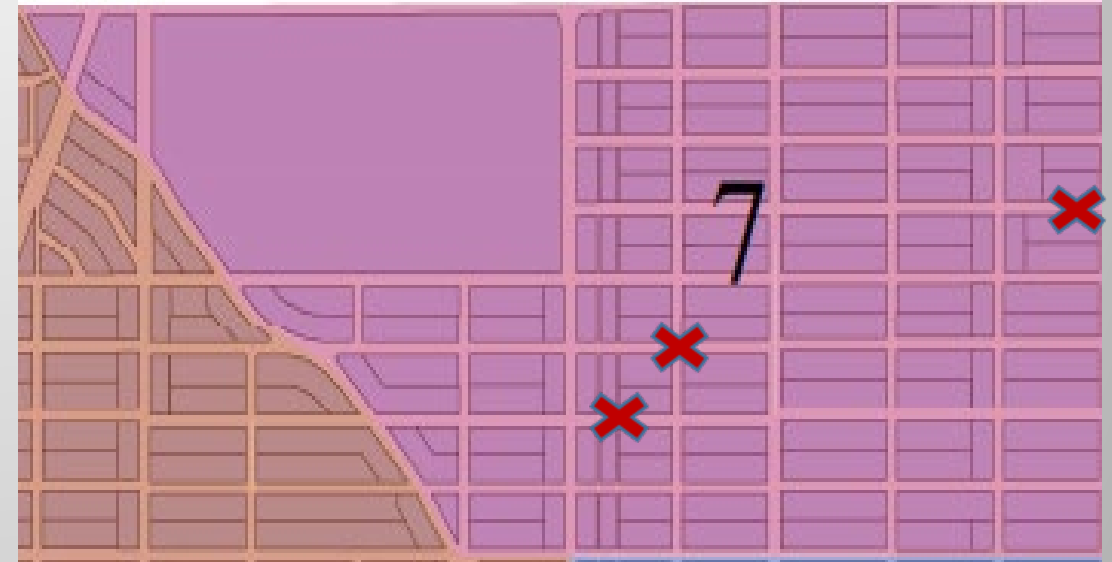
Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 4/17/2026

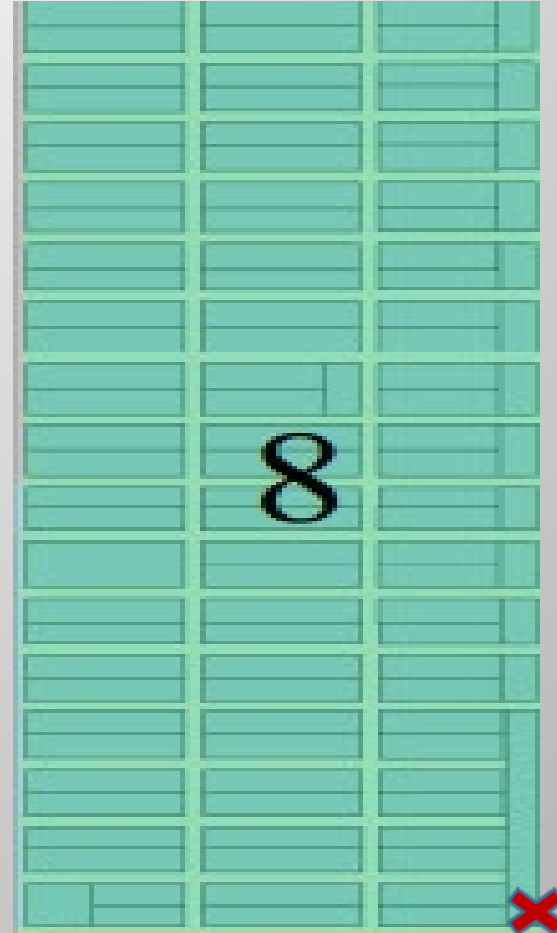
Battery – 4/16/2026

Upon arrival, Berwyn Police Officers met with two (2) male victims who related that they were approached inside the gas station by four (4) unknown Male Black subjects, where a physical altercation began and traveled outside into the parking lot. During the duration of the fight, the victims' car keys and cell phone were dropped on the ground and picked up by the offenders. The victims related that no weapon was displayed. Victim #1 related that he did not wish to sign complaints. Victim #2 related that he would like to sign complaints for Battery. Both Victims refused medical attention on scene. This investigation is ongoing.

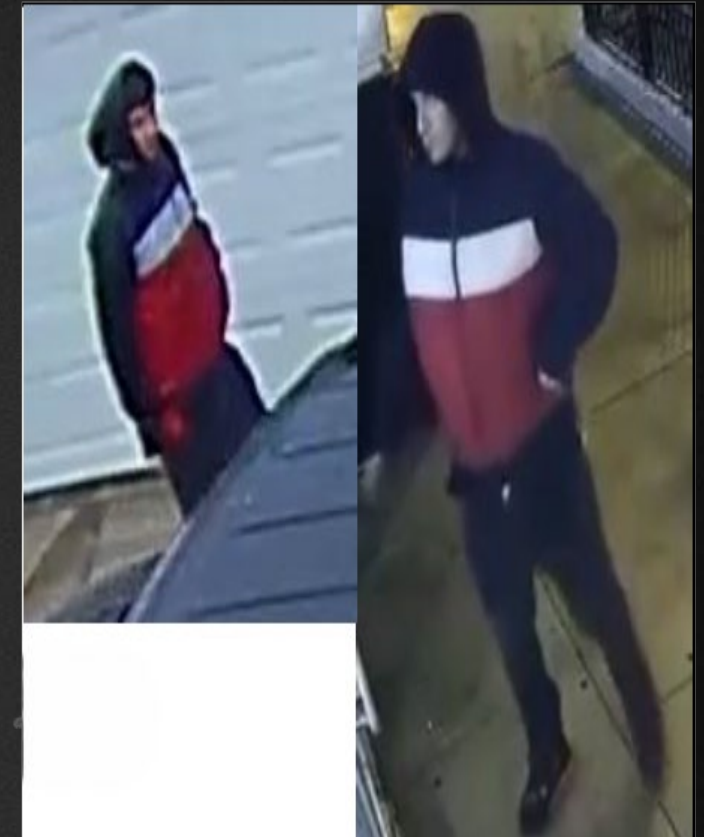

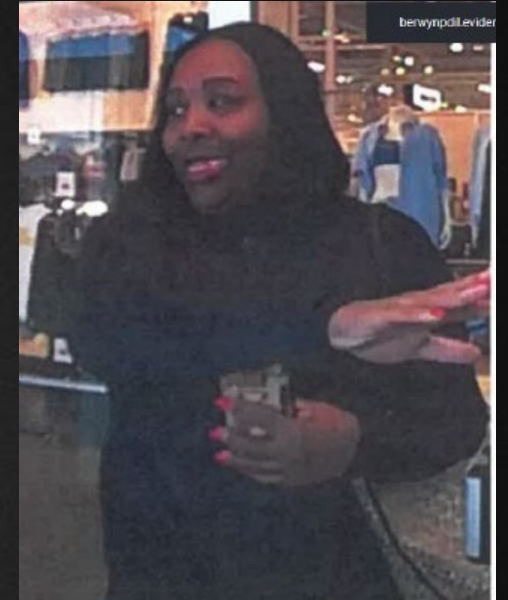
