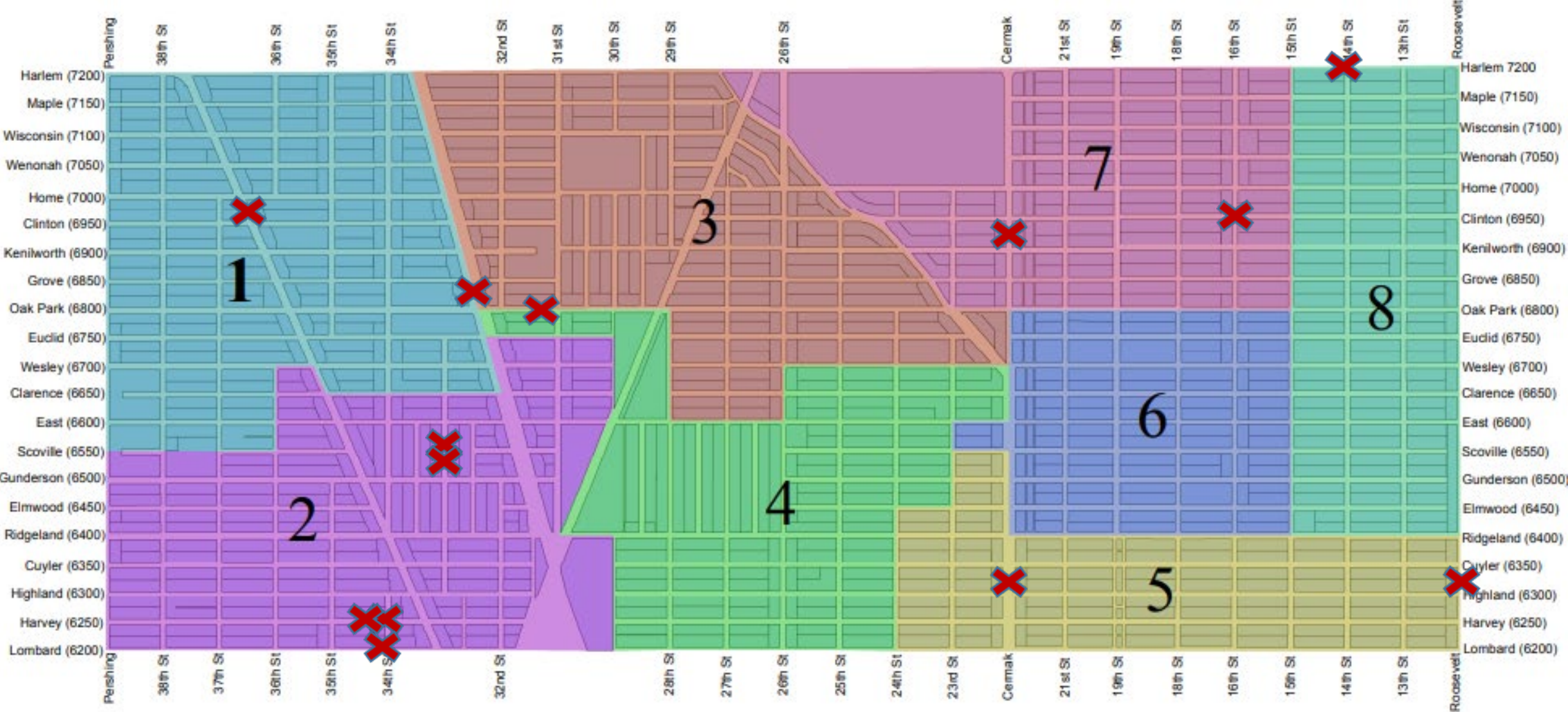

## **Burglary – 5/06/2026**

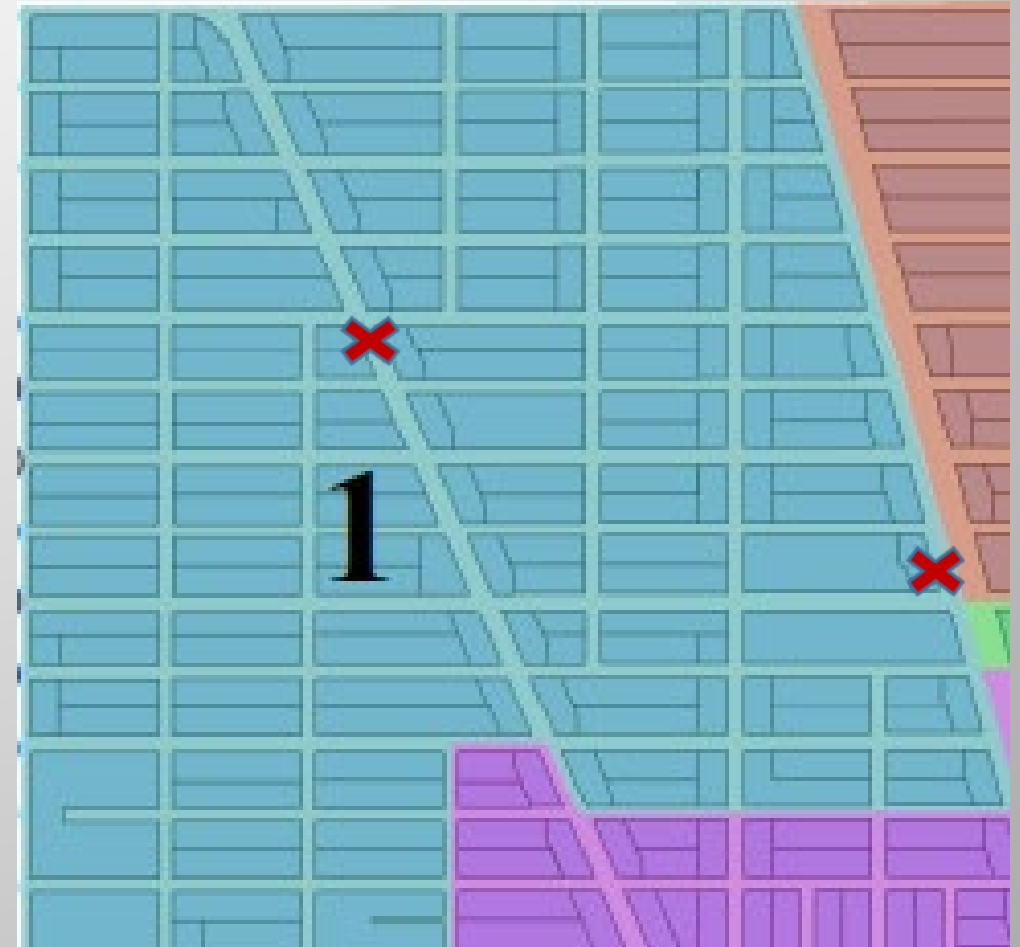
## **Aggravated Battery/Resisting a Peace Officer – 5/09/2026**

**6500 block of Sinclair Ave. – 6:51 a.m.**

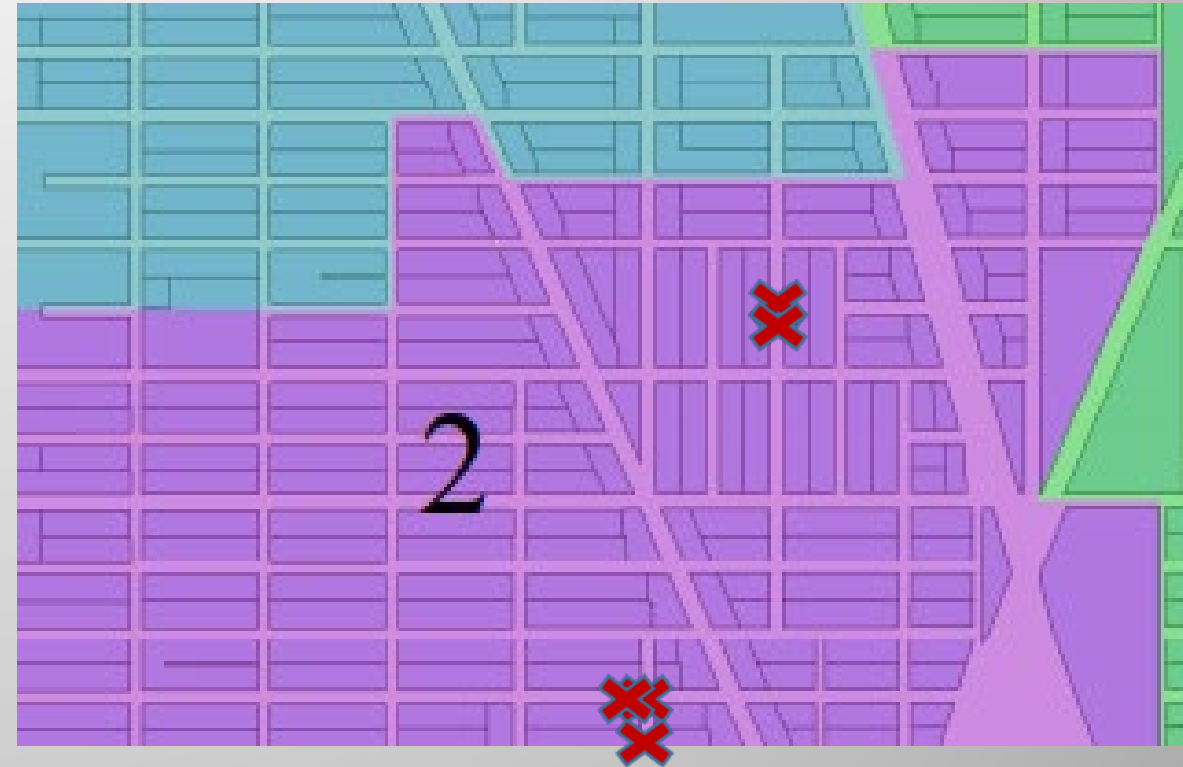

## **Suspicious Person(s) – 5/07/2026** **3400 block of Harvey Ave. – 7:29 a.m.**

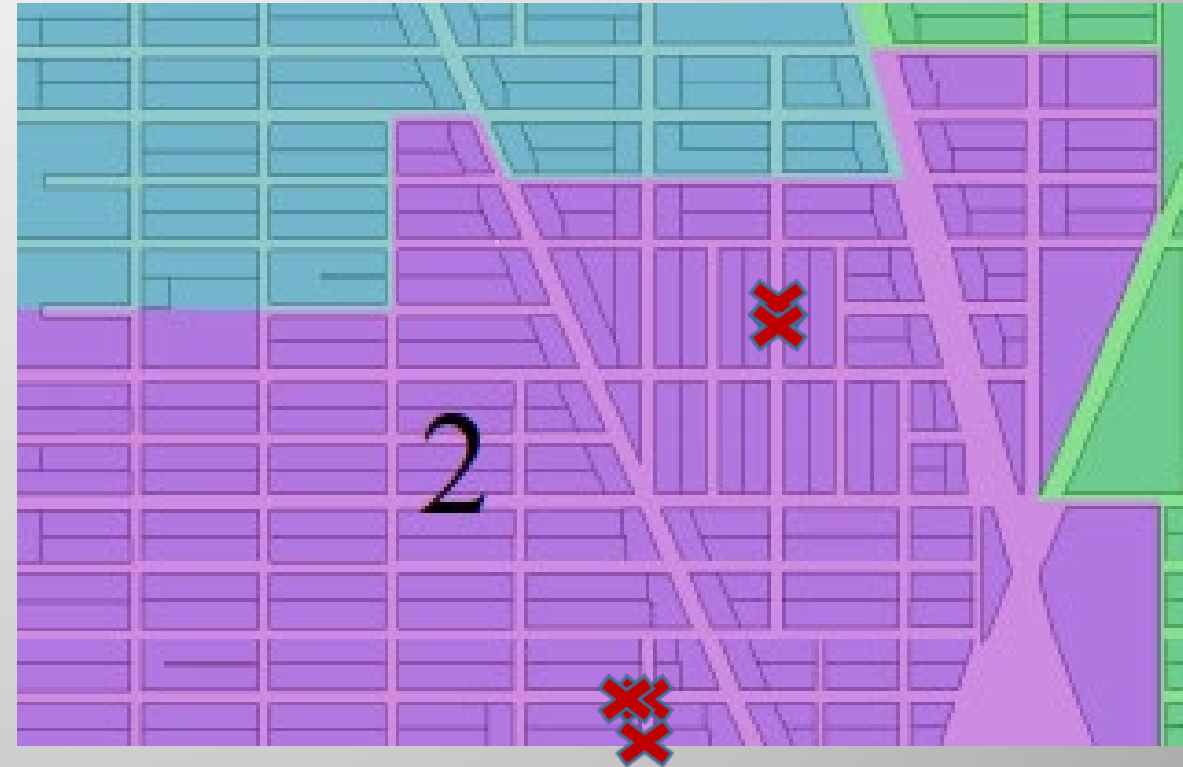

The victim further related that he continued walking into the alley at which time two (2) additional offenders approached the victim. One (1) of the offenders displayed a handgun and struck the victim in the head. The three (3) offenders took the victim's backpack and fled Southbound through the Lombard/Harvey alley. 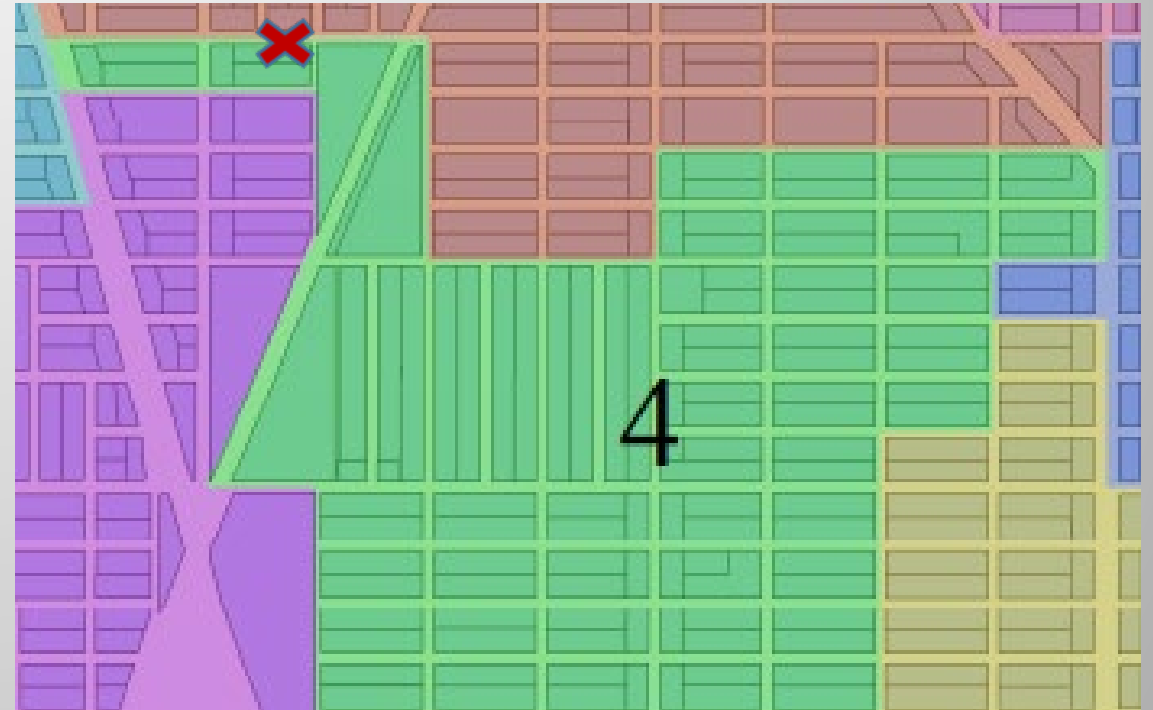
## Disorderly Conduct – 5/06/2026

Upon arrival, responding officers observed the bus stopped, and all passengers had evacuated. Officers met with PACE staff members who related that they ordered one (1) male passenger off the bus after he poured lighter fluid inside the bus. Officers entered the bus and immediately identified a strong odor of lighter fluid. Officers also observed a large puddle of liquid on the floor and an open bottle of lighter fluid on the floor of the bus. Berwyn FD arrived on scene and washed down the bus to prevent the floor from igniting. Officers located the offender near Oak Park Ave./Stanley Ave., where he was positively identified and placed into custody. The offender was transported to the Berwyn Police Department and charged accordingly. Case closed by arrest.

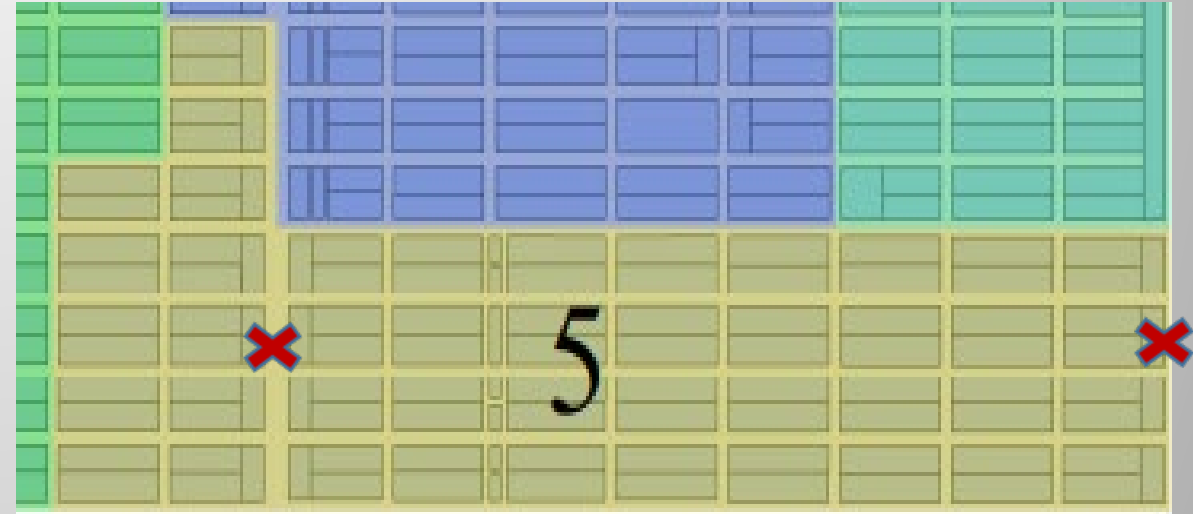
## **Battery – 5/06/2026**

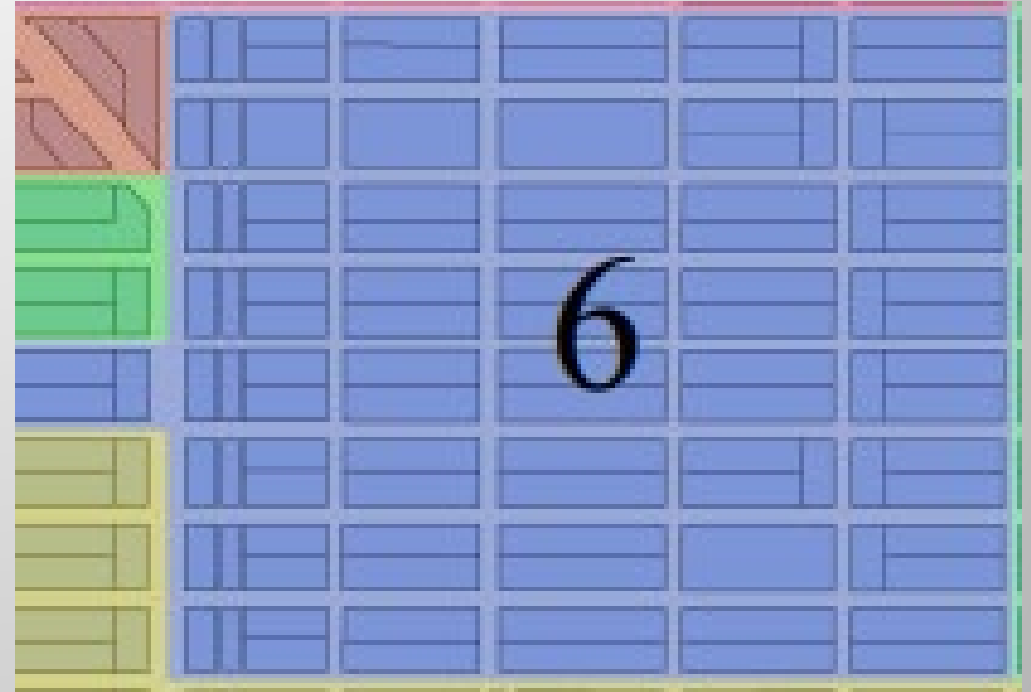

Officers responded to the 6900 block of Cermak Rd. for multiple anonymous calls of several subjects fighting and shots being fired. Upon arrival, responding officers located one (1) male subject and two (2) female subjects, who were uncooperative. All three (3) subjects were detained pending further investigation. The male subject became aggressive and attempted to leave the scene. Officers subsequently placed the subject in custody. Officers canvassed the area and located small droplets of blood inside an apartment building. The search yielded negative results for any shell casings, victims, or property damage. The male subject was transported to the Berwyn Police Department and charged accordingly. Case closed by arrest.

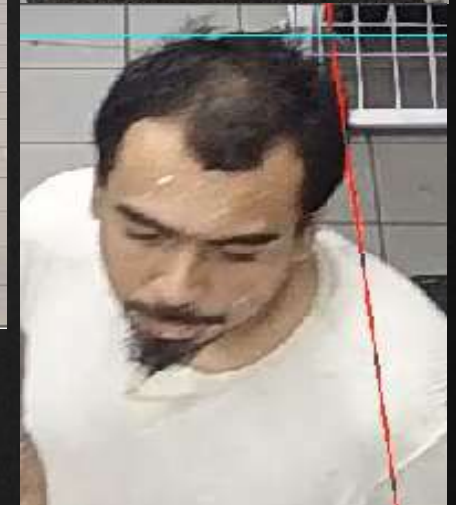

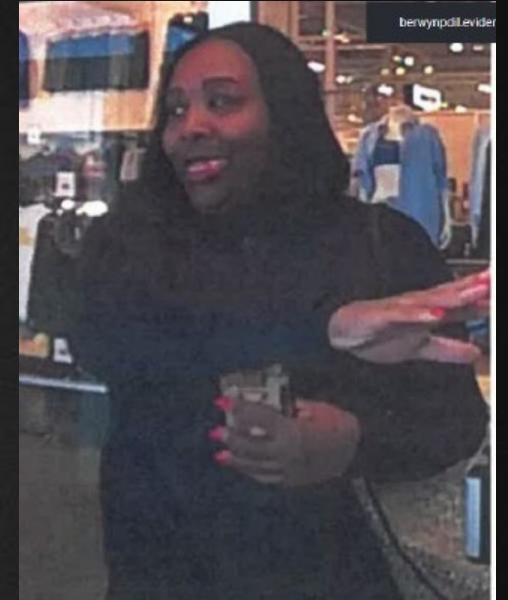
