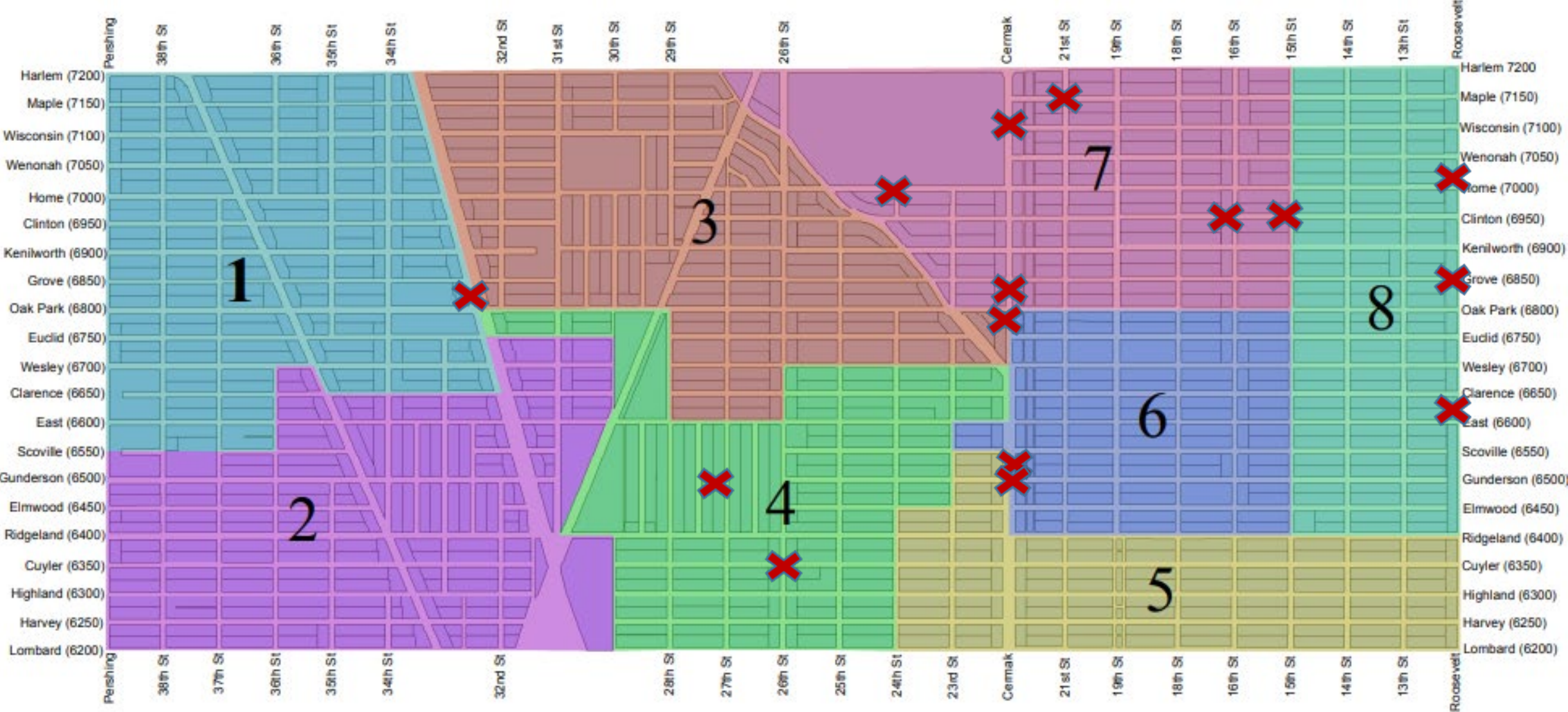

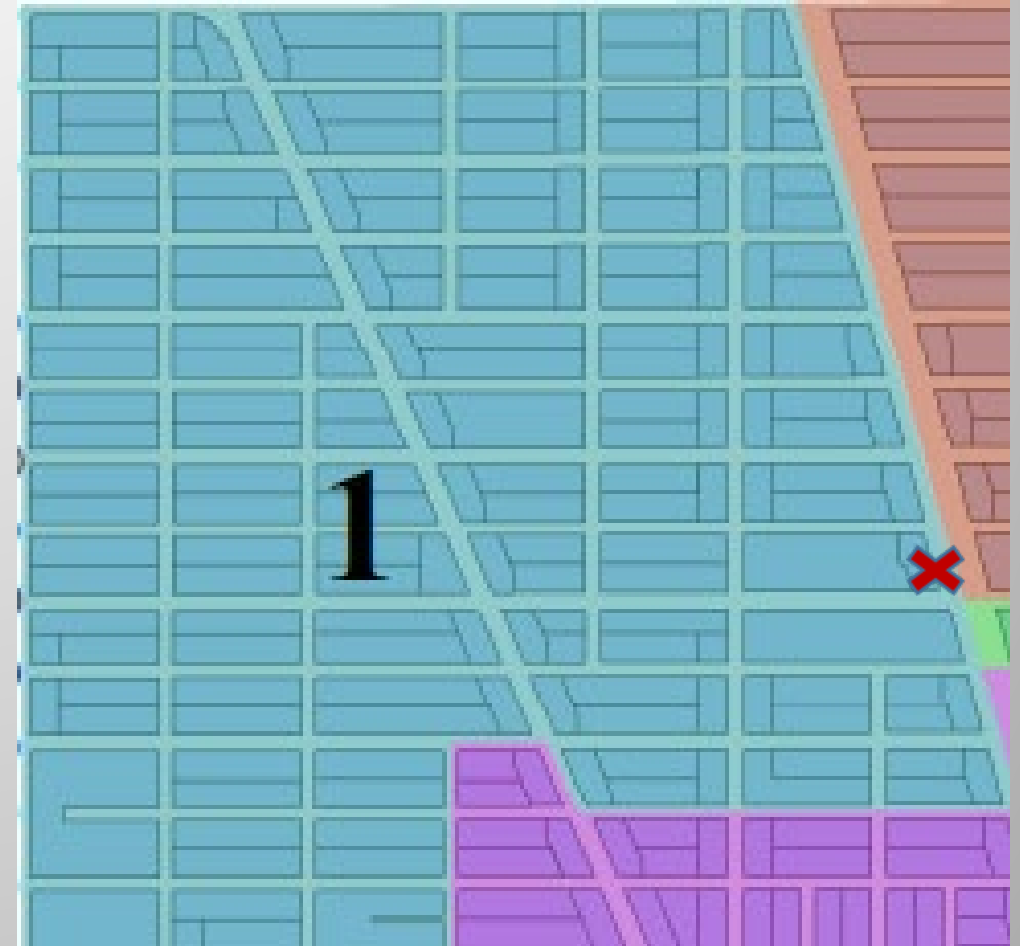
Disturbance/Battery – 6/13/2026

Aura Lounge (6814 Windsor Ave.) – 2:32 a.m.

Officers observed a disturbance between a female subject and security staff in front of Aura Lounge. Responding officers made contact with Aura Lounge's security who related the female subject was escorted out of the establishment after battering a security staff member. Officers observed the female subject to be intoxicated and made several attempts to re-enter the establishment. The female subject disregarded several orders to leave the area and struck one (1) police officer. The offender was placed in custody and subsequently charged with one (1) misdemeanor count of Battery. Case closed by arrest.

Commercial Burglary – 6/13/2026

Waldo Cooney's Pizza (6733 Oak Park Ave.) – 4:43 a.m.

Berwyn Dispatch received a report of a Commercial Burglary at Waldo Cooney's Pizza. The caller advised dispatch that three (3) or four (4) Male Black subjects exited a grey colored sedan and forced entry into the business by breaking the glass doors. Upon arrival, responding officers observed damage to the two (2) front doors and a window. Officers conducted a check of the interior of the business which yielded negative results for any possible suspects. Officers observed damage to one (1) gaming machine, and the cash box was missing. This investigation is ongoing.

Catalytic Converter Theft – 6/11/2026 **6500 block of 27th Place – 7:42 a.m.**

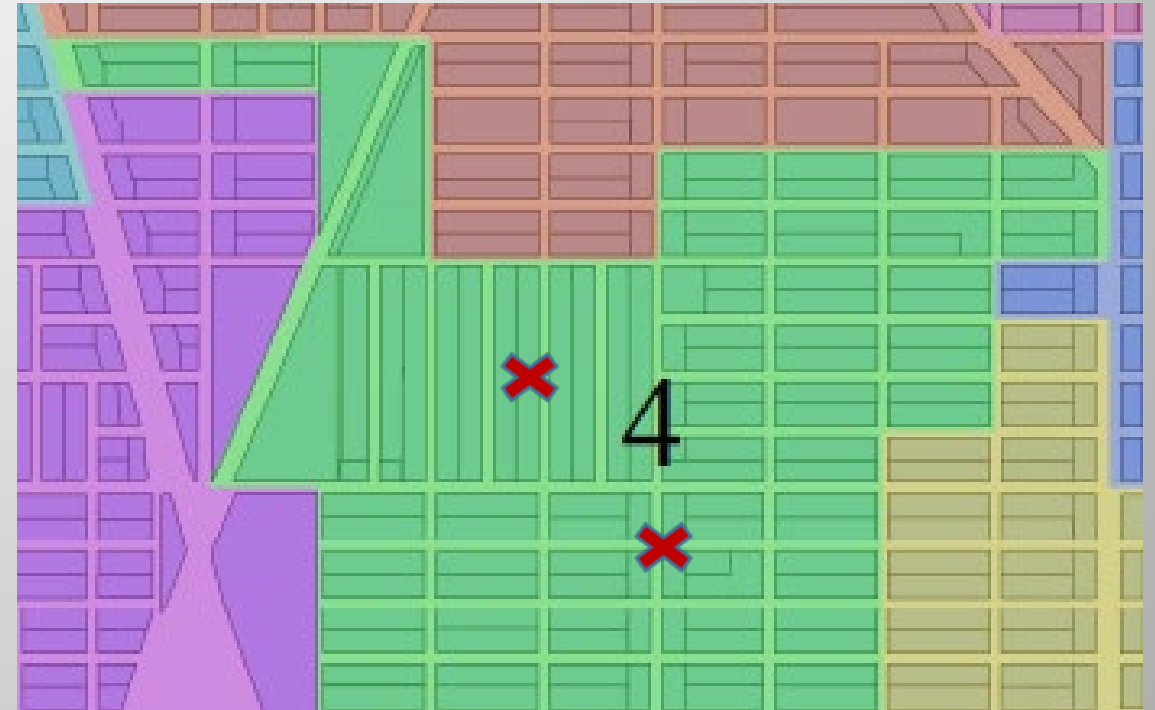
Officers responded to the 6500 block of 27th Place for a report of a catalytic converter theft in progress. Upon arrival, responding officers met with a witness who related that they observed three (3) male subjects wearing ski masks underneath a blue vehicle. The witness further related that the subjects entered a white SUV and fled the scene Westbound. Officers observed that the catalytic converter was missing from said vehicle. Contact was made with the vehicle's owner, who stated he wished to sign a complaint. This investigation is ongoing.

Aggravated Battery-Use of a Firearm – 6/14/2026 **26th St./Cuyler Ave. – 2:52 a.m.**

Berwyn Dispatch received notification from Cicero Police that they located a male gunshot victim on the 2700 block of Lombard Ave. The victim related that he was walking Eastbound on 26th St. when an unknown male subject and an unknown female subject approached and shot him. The victim sustained two (2) gunshot wounds to the lower abdomen and was transported to Loyola Hospital for treatment. The victim described the male offender as Hispanic, approximately 5'8", medium build, wearing a black hoodie and black pants. The female offender was described as White or Hispanic, wearing blue and black clothing. A canvass of the area revealed eight (8) spent shell casings on the 6200 block of 26th St. This investigation is ongoing.

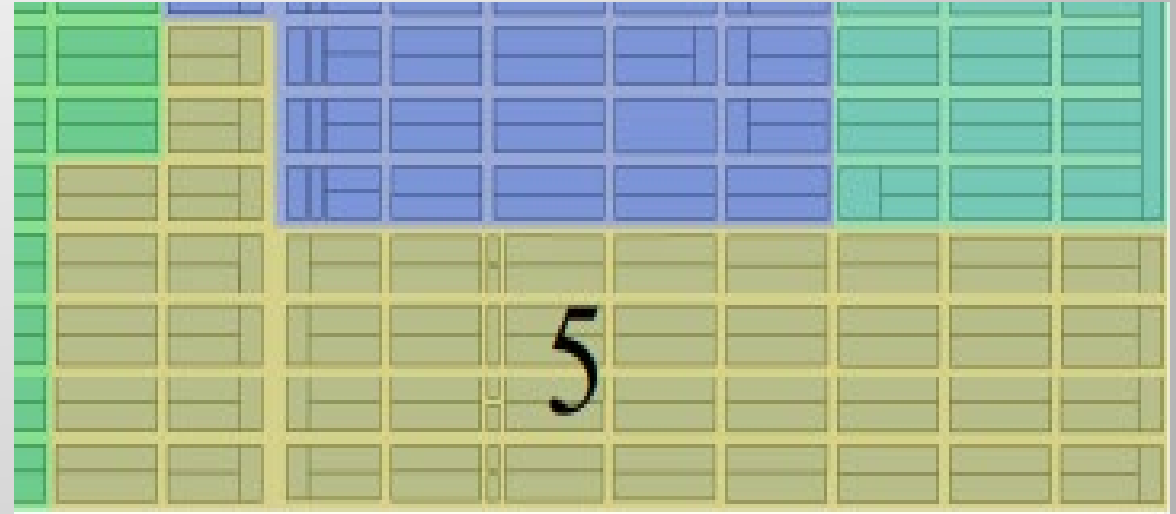

Commercial Burglary – 6/09/2026

Flight 22 Wine Bar (6518 Cermak Rd.) – 3:11 a.m.

Officers responded to Flight 22 Wine Bar for an activated alarm. Upon arrival, responding officers observed damage to a window. Officers cleared the establishment and observed damage to four (4) gaming machines and three (3) cash boxes were missing. This investigation is ongoing.

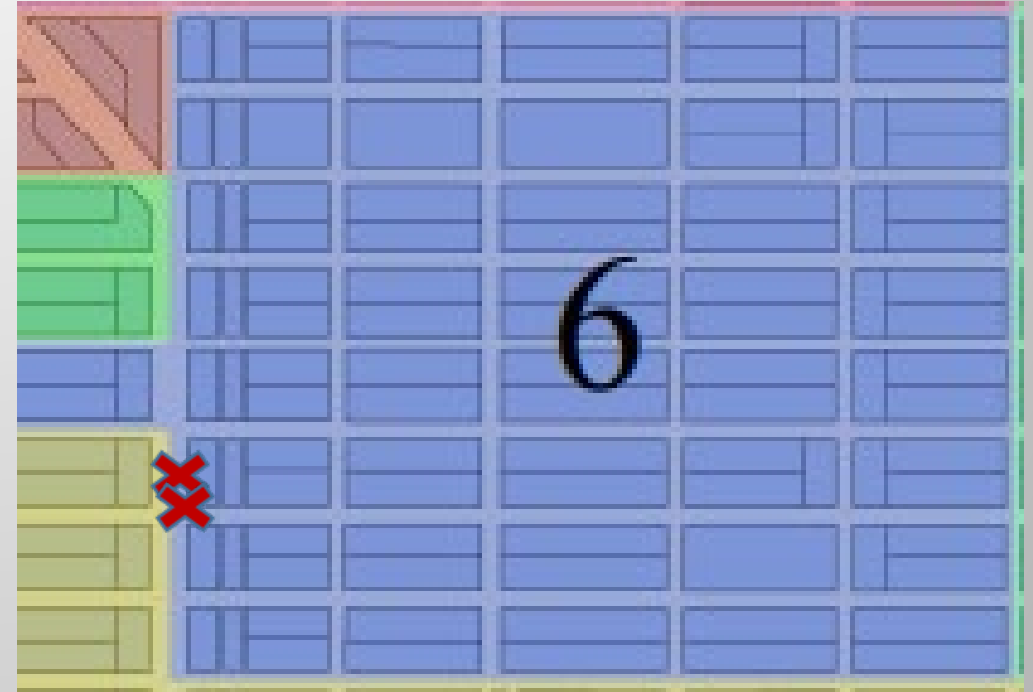
Commercial Burglary – 6/11/2026

Tina's Place (6513 Cermak Rd.) – 4:54 a.m.

Officers responded to Tina's Place for a report of a Commercial Burglary. Upon arrival, responding officers met with a witness who stated they observed five (5)-six (6) Male Black subjects flee the scene Southbound on Elmwood in a white vehicle. Officers observed signs of forced entry through the front door of the establishment. While clearing the inside of the establishment, officers observed damage to five (5) gaming machines, and all five (5) cash boxes were missing. This investigation is ongoing.

Commercial Burglary – 6/09/2026

Encanto Cantina & Pizzeria (6825 Cermak Rd.) – 3:13 a.m.

Berwyn Dispatch received a report of a burglary at Encanto Cantina & Pizzeria. The caller related that they observed three (3) male subjects break into the business from a window and then flee the scene in a silver-colored vehicle. Upon arrival, responding officers cleared the establishment and observed damage to one (1) gaming machine with the cash box missing. This investigation is ongoing.

Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer – 6/09/2026

Walgreens (7113 Cermak Rd.) – 8:20 a.m.

A Berwyn Police Officer was flagged down at Walgreens by an employee. The staff member related that a male offender, who was wanted for battery to a staff member from the previous day, had just left the store and was currently walking through Cermak Plaza. The officer located and took the offender into custody. While entering the squad car, the offender spat in the officer's face. Officers learned that the offender also had an active warrant out of Kendall County for Aggravated Assault. The subject was transported to the Berwyn Police Department and subsequently charged accordingly. Case closed by arrest.

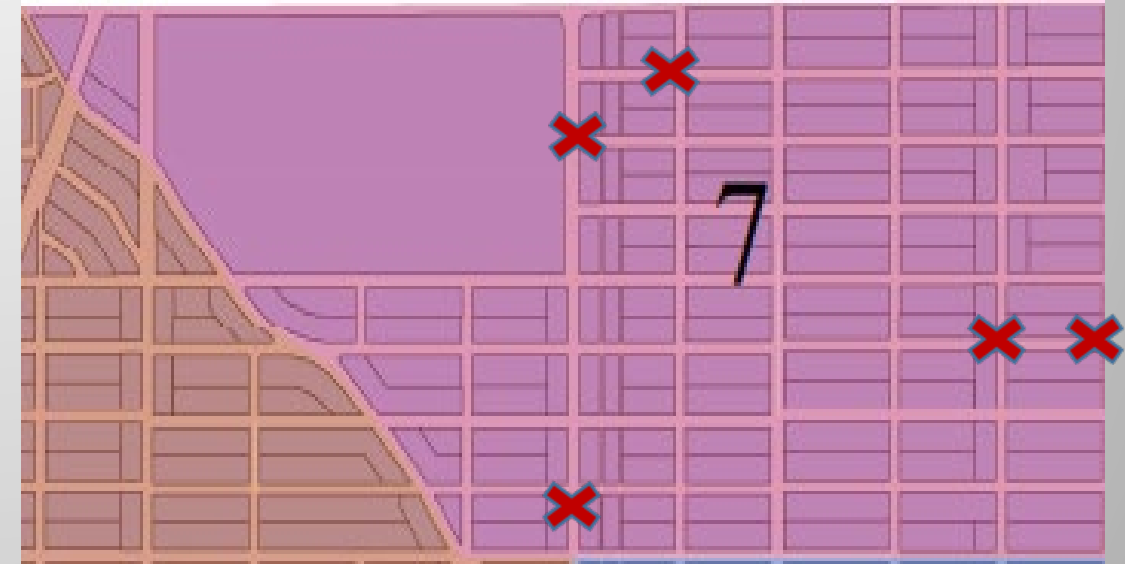
Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 6/11/2026

2100 block of Maple Ave. – 5:58 a.m.

Officers responded to the 2100 block of Maple Ave. for a report of Burglary to Motor Vehicle. Upon arrival, officers met with the victim who related his work van was broken into and that approximately \$3,000 worth of tools were missing. Officers observed damage to the front passenger window of the van. This investigation is ongoing.

Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 6/11/2026 **1500 block of Clinton Ave. – 11:09 a.m.**

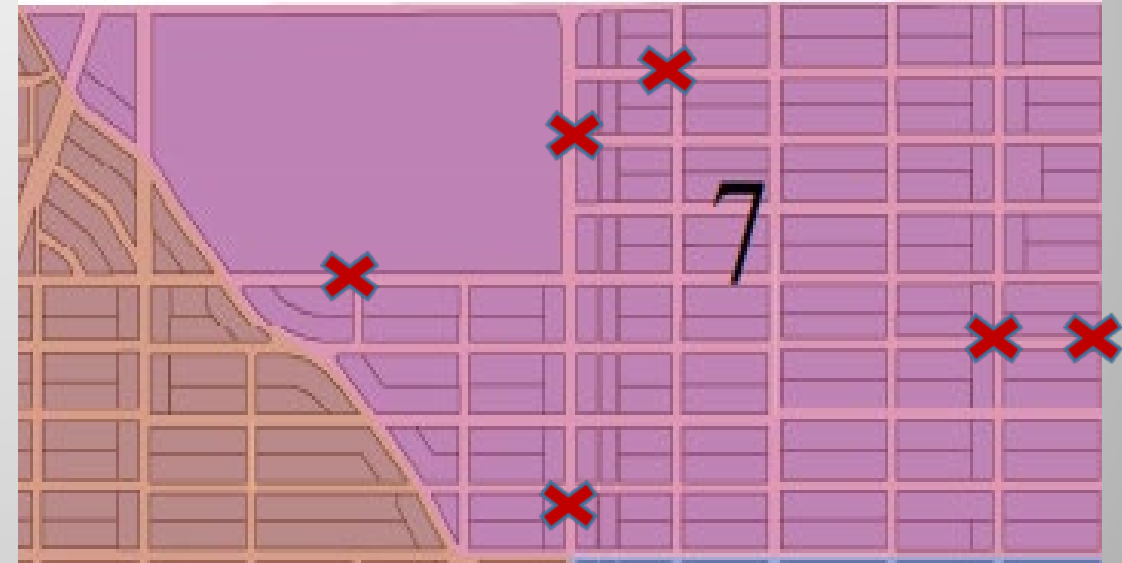
Officers took a walk-in report of a burglary to motor vehicle on the 1500 block of Clinton Ave. Officers met with the victim, who stated several tools were missing from his work van. The victim further related that the recent storm caused damage to the van's windows, and he believed that is how access was gained to his van. This investigation is ongoing.

Aggravated Battery – 6/14/2026 **Home Ave./24th St. – 9:16 p.m.**

Officers responded to Home Ave./24th St. for a call of a battery. Upon arrival, responding officers met with the female victim who related she was involved in a hit-and-run accident near Cermak Rd./Wenonah Ave. and followed the offending vehicle through Cermak Plaza when the vehicle came to a stop at Home Ave./24th St. The victim further related that when she confronted the driver and told him she was going to call the police, he struck her on the face with a closed fist several times. The offender then re-entered his black in color SUV and fled the scene prior to officer arrival. The victim described the offender as a Male Black, 5'8"-5'10", 150-160lbs., with long dreadlocks in a ponytail. The victim was transported to Loyola Hospital for treatment. This investigation is ongoing.

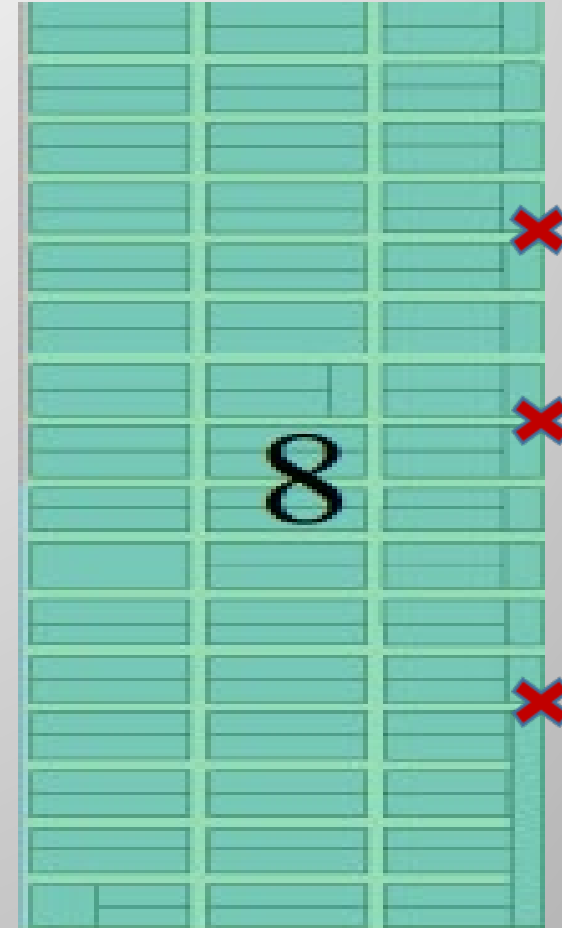
Aggravated Unlawful Possession of a Weapon-No CCL – 6/14/2026

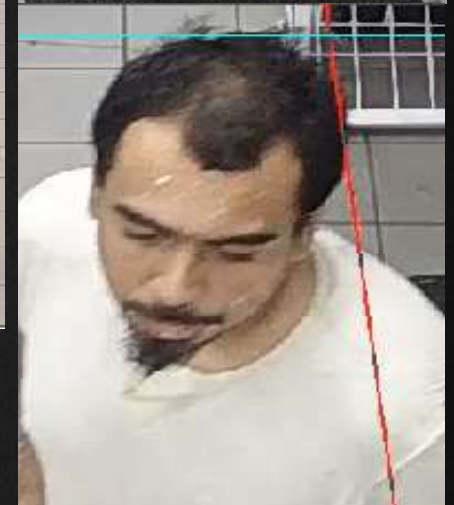

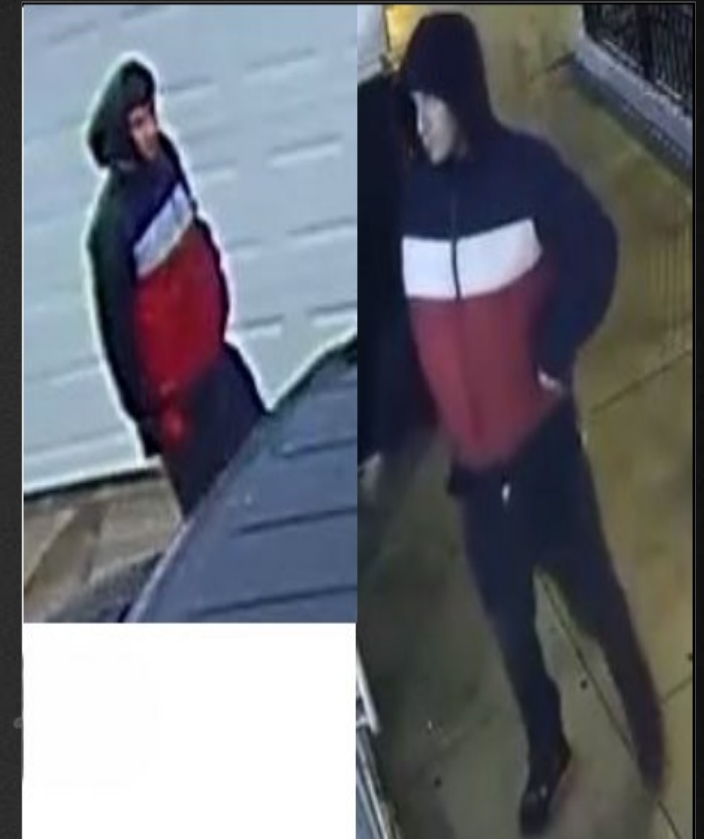

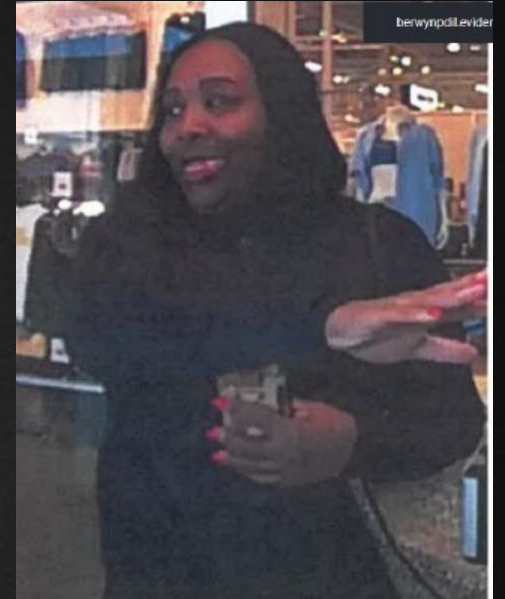
