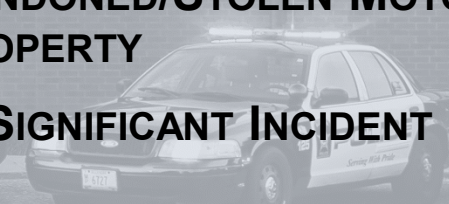
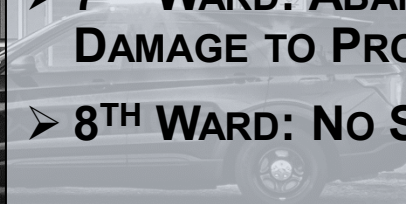

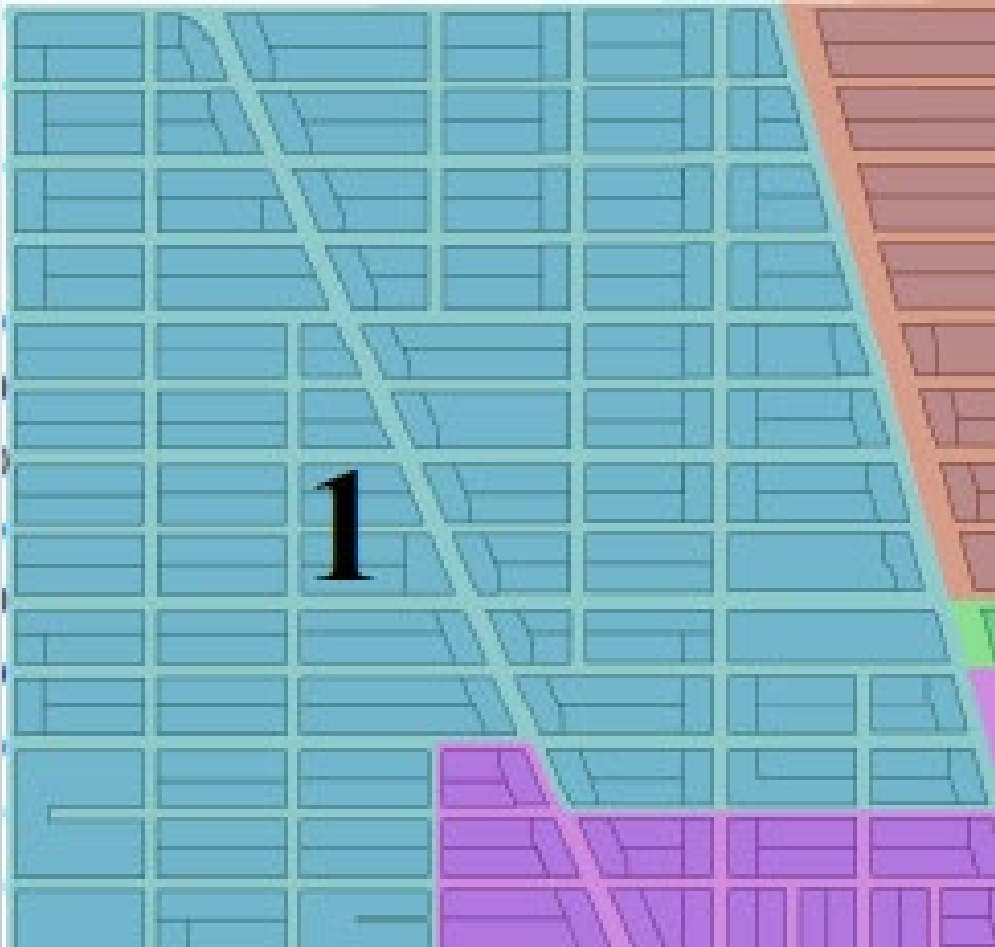

Battery – 7/18/2026

Metro Towing (3103 Ridgeland Ave.) – 12:20 p.m.

Officers responded to Metro Towing for a report of a battery. Upon arrival, responding officers met with a Metro Towing employee (victim) who related that he was struck by a male customer who fled the scene on foot prior to officer arrival. The victim described the offender as Male Black wearing a black shirt and black pants. Officers determined that the incident stemmed from a dispute over an I.D. issue when the offender attempted to retrieve his vehicle. This investigation is ongoing.

Stolen Catalytic Converter – 7/23/2026

Lavergne Education Center (3401 Gunderson Ave.) – 2:06 p.m.

Officers responded to the Lavergne Education Center for a report of two (2) stolen catalytic converters from school district vehicles. Upon arrival, officers met with the reporting party, who shared video surveillance of the incident with the officers. This incident was turned over to the detective bureau for further investigation.

Criminal Damage to Property – 7/24/2026

Officers responded to the 2700 block of Highland Ave. for a report of Criminal Damage to Property. Upon arrival, officers met with the vehicle owner (victim) who related that she discovered her vehicle had been damaged sometime overnight. Officers observed damage to the door handle and steering column. The victim stated that they wished to sign a complaint. This investigation is ongoing.

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 5TH WARD

Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer/Aggravated Resisting a Peace Officer 13th St./Ridgeland Ave. – 7/21/2026 – 1:31 p.m.

While on patrol, officers observed a male subject ripping flowers out of the ground from private property and tossing them into a nearby yard. Officers subsequently took the offender into custody. During the course of the arrest, the offender became aggressive and began to strike and spit at the officers. The offender was charged with one (1) felony count of Aggravated Battery to a Peace Officer and one (1) felony count of Aggravated Resisting a Peace Officer. Case closed by arrest.

Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 7/23/2026 1800 block of Ridgeland Ave.– 10:50 p.m.

Officers responded to the 1800 block of Ridgeland Ave. for a report of a theft from a motor vehicle. Responding officers met with the victim, who related that an electric scooter was stolen from the rear passenger cab of his pickup truck sometime overnight. This investigation is ongoing.

Burglary to Motor Vehicle – 7/24/2026 6300 block of Roosevelt Rd. – 7:57 a.m.

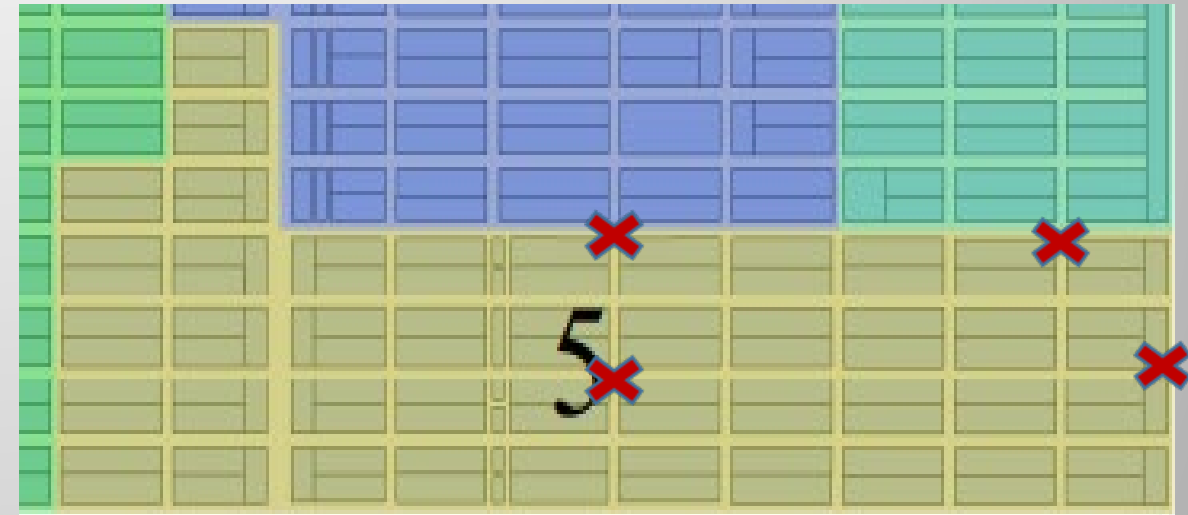
Officers responded to the 6300 block of Roosevelt Rd. for a report of a Burglary to Motor Vehicle. Upon arrival, responding officers met with the vehicle owner (victim) who related his work van was broken into sometime overnight and several tools were missing. The victim stated that he wished to sign a complaint. This investigation is ongoing.

Suspicious Person/Criminal Trespass to Real Property – 7/26/2026 1800 block of Highland Ave. – 7:05 a.m.

Officers responded to the 1800 block of Highland Ave. for a report of a suspicious person. Berwyn Dispatch advised officers that the victim reported an unknown Male Hispanic subject rang her doorbell and then struck the garage door. The victim further related that the garage door was now open and it was unknown if said subject was inside. Upon arrival, responding officers conducted a check of the garage, which yielded negative results for any possible suspects. Officers met with the victim, who described the offender as 5'5", thin build, wearing sunglasses, a black hooded sweatshirt, and jeans. The victim further related that they observed blood on the victim's hands and shirt. Officers conducted a check of the area, which yielded negative results for any suspects or further reports of property damage in the area. This investigation is ongoing.

SIGNIFICANT INCIDENTS IN 6TH WARD

Criminal Trespass to Motor Vehicle (JUVENILE) – 7/24/2026 **2100 block of Wesley Ave. – 5:05 a.m.**

Berwyn Dispatch received a call from a male subject who related he was sleeping inside his vehicle, which was parked in the 6600 block of the Vacin Fairway, when he awoke to an unknown Male Black subject pulling on his door handle. The caller further related that he exited his vehicle and observed three (3) unknown Male Black subjects enter an SUV and attempt to flee the scene northbound on the 2100 block of Wesley Ave., at which time the offending vehicle struck two (2) parked vehicles and rolled over. Upon arrival, responding officers met with witnesses who detained one (1) juvenile offender. Said juvenile was taken into custody and subsequently petitioned accordingly. Officers conducted a check of the area for the other two (2) offenders but were met with negative results. Officers learned that the offending vehicle was reported stolen out of Chicago. This investigation is ongoing.

Criminal Damage to Property – 7/24/2026 **6600 block of Vacin Fairway – 5:33 a.m.**

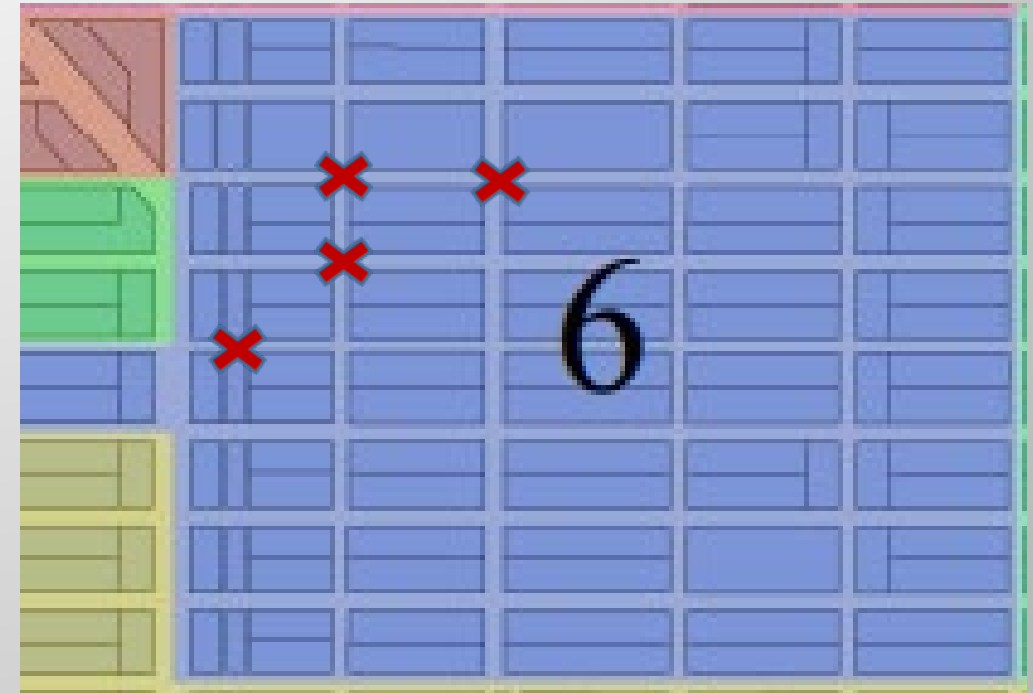
Officers located a parked vehicle on the 6600 block of Vacin Fairway with damage to the rear passenger window. Officers made contact with the owner, who stated he wished to sign a complaint. This investigation is ongoing.

Armed Robbery (JUVENILE) – 7/26/2026 **1900 block of Wesley Ave. – 12:48 a.m.**

Officers responded to the 1900 block of Wesley Ave. for a report of an Armed Robbery. Upon arrival, officers met with the Juvenile victim, who related that he made arrangements to sell some designer clothing items to a known juvenile subject. The victim further related that when he arrived at the location, another known juvenile subject (offender) appeared wearing a black ski mask. The victim further related that the offender displayed a handgun and demanded the items that the victim was selling. The offender then struck the victim in the face with the barrel of the handgun, took the victim's backpack, and fled the scene on foot. This incident was turned over to Youth Investigations.

The owner also reported their cell phone and driver's license were missing from the vehicle. This investigation is ongoing.
